Where do we eat his bread?



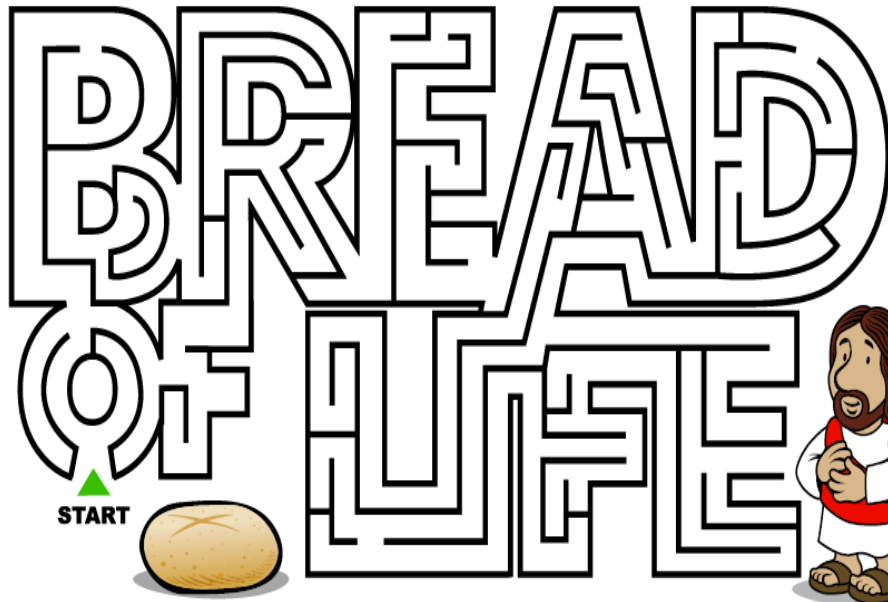
He gave us his life.

He gives us love. How do we feel Jesus' love in our lives?



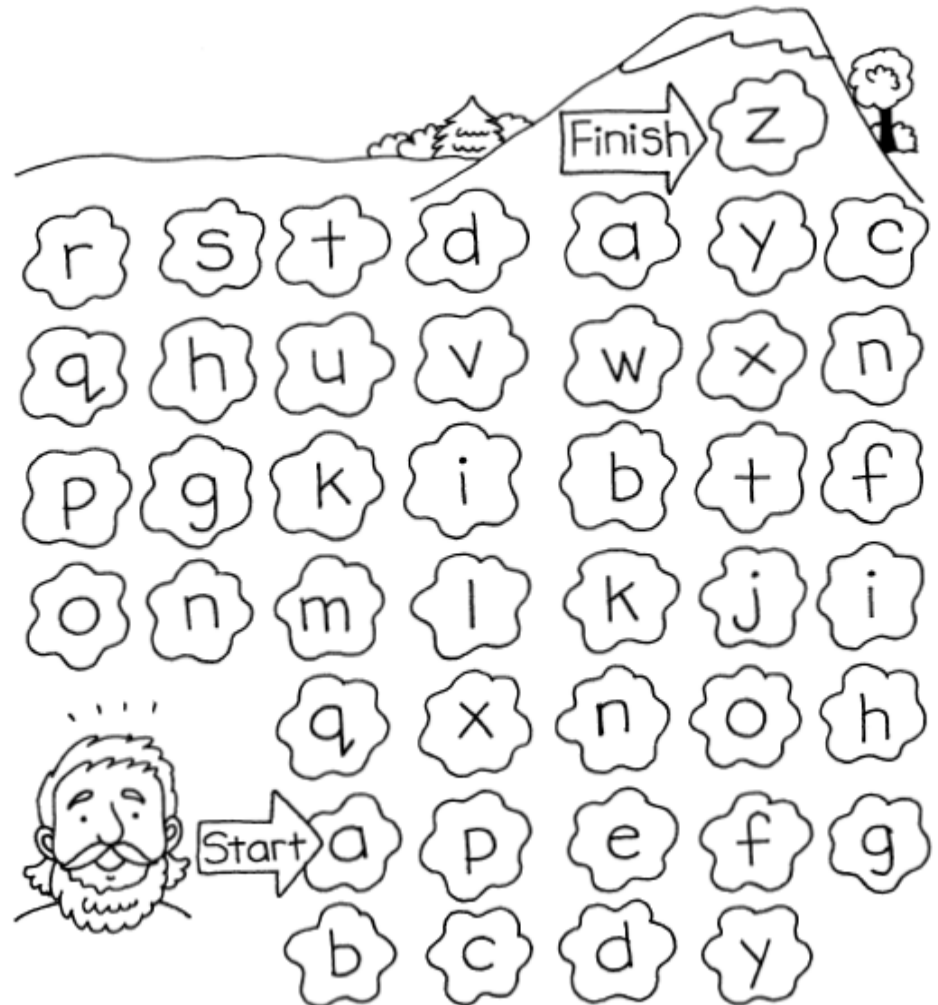
Can you make your way through the BREAD OF LIFE maze?
