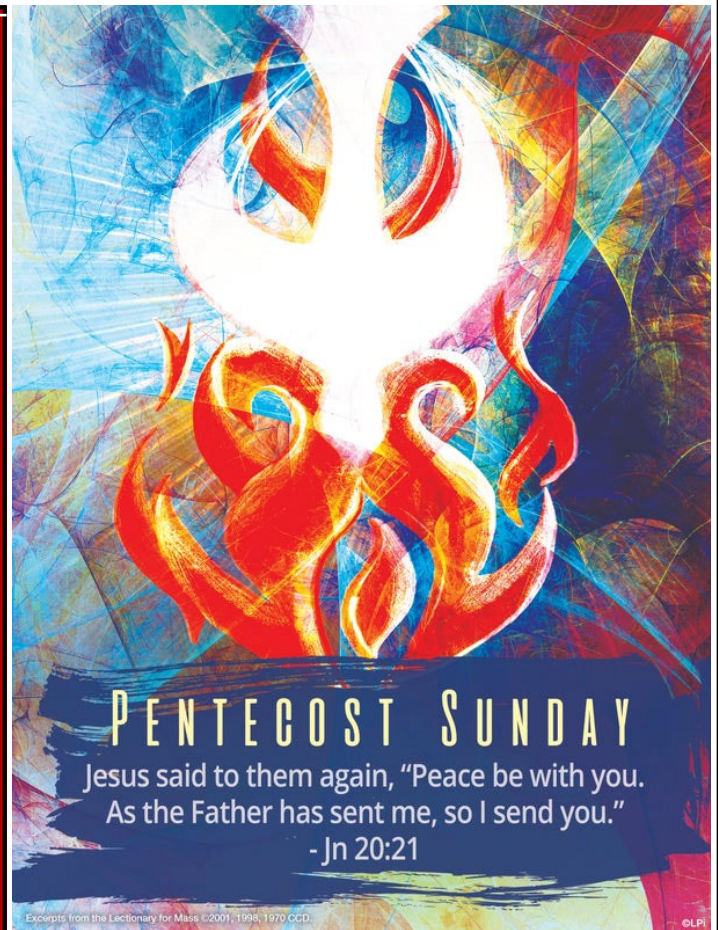

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

With Pentecost Sunday, we come to the end of the Easter Season. At Pentecost, of course we remember the arrival of the Holy Spirit upon the early Church, upon its Apostles, a spirit that we believe remains with us even today.

We Servites, like all Catholic priests and religious are asked to pray daily the Office of Readings, which always contain a Reading from Scripture, and then also a Reading from the Saints, the Church Fathers, or otherwise Church’s Magisterium or Sacred Tradition.

Since our celebration of the Ascension of the Lord, the second readings from the Office have focused on Holy Spirit. The Readings are worth looking up and reflecting upon even after our celebration of the Arrival of the Holy Spirit with Pentecost.

One can read these Readings daily in multiple languages including English and Spanish using the free iBreviary app. One can also look them up in English on universalis.com, divineoffice.org and liturgies.net and ofciodivino.com and liturgiadelashoras.github.io in Spanish.

This annual cycle of Readings offers daily a solid and often quite broadening reflection of the Liturgical concerns of the day always in the context of the part of the Liturgical Year in which we find ourselves in. I’d encourage all of you to keep the Divine Office in mind as an increasingly available resource for spiritual nourishment.

And yes, the Reflections offered during this past week offered from St. Basil the Great to the Second Vatican Council all expound on the nature and gift of the Holy Spirit, its omnipresence and gentleness (like sunlight), its ability to sanctify and its ability change hearts and turn us to the right path.

These are beautiful reflections and continue to offer us hope that just as was the experience of the Early Church so to today, every problem and crisis can be transformed by the Holy Spirit into a blessing that only brings us closer to God and makes the Church grow.

Happy Pentecost Sunday!

Con el Domingo de Pentecostés, llegamos al final del Tiempo Pascual. En Pentecostés, por supuesto, recordamos la llegada del Espíritu Santo a la Iglesia primitiva, a sus Apóstoles, un espíritu que creemos que permanece con nosotros incluso hoy.

A los Servitas, como a todos los sacerdotes y religiosos católicos, se nos pide que recemos diariamente el Oficio de Lecturas, que siempre contiene una Lectura de la Escritura, y luego también una Lectura de los Santos, de los Padres de la Iglesia, o de otro modo del Magisterio de la Iglesia o de la Sagrada Tradición.

Desde la celebración de la Ascensión del Señor, las segundas lecturas del Oficio se centran en el Espíritu Santo. Merece la pena buscar estas lecturas y reflexionar sobre ellas incluso después de nuestra celebración de la llegada del Espíritu Santo con Pentecostés.

Estas lecturas pueden leerse diariamente en varios idiomas, incluidos el inglés y el español, utilizando la aplicación gratuita iBreviary. También se pueden consultar en inglés en universalis.com, divineoffice.org y liturgies.net y en español en ofciodivino.com y liturgiadelashoras.github.io.

Este ciclo anual de Lecturas ofrece diariamente una reflexión sólida y a menudo bastante amplia de las preocupaciones litúrgicas del día siempre en el contexto de la parte del Año Litúrgico en la que nos encontramos. Os animo a todos a tener presente el Oficio Divino como un recurso cada vez más disponible para el alimento espiritual.

Y sí, las Reflexiones ofrecidas durante esta semana pasada, desde San Basilio el Grande hasta el Concilio Vaticano II, exponen todas sobre la naturaleza y el don del Espíritu Santo, su omnipresencia y dulzura (como la luz del sol), su capacidad para santificar y su capacidad para cambiar los corazones y dirigirnos por el buen camino.

Son hermosas reflexiones y siguen ofreciéndonos la esperanza de que, al igual que la experiencia de la Iglesia primitiva, también hoy todo problema y toda crisis pueden ser transformados por el Espíritu Santo en una bendición que no hace sino acercarnos a Dios y hacer crecer a la Iglesia.

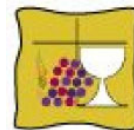

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

The Fame Communicated

“Fire! Fire! They’re all gonna die! They’re all gonna burn up!”
 I had absolutely no hope of restoring order as I read the story of Pentecost with my young children last year. As soon as they glimpsed the tongues of fire hovering over the foreheads of the apostles, they were lost to giggles and shrieks. I sighed, sipped my coffee, and wondered resentfully why the Holy Spirit couldn’t have chosen to be a dove on that particular day. Just a nice, peaceful dove.

I’ll say this, though: the fire left an impression. It usually does, doesn’t it? Fire consumes. It renews. It illuminates. It leaves you breathless with fear and awe. The memory and scent and impact of a flame lingers long after it is extinguished.

When I am trying to explain theology to my kids, I have an awful habit of overcomplicating things. I’d had a whole speech prepared for them about what the Holy Spirit is, but it went out the window as soon as they saw the flames. And you know what? It’s probably for the best. They wouldn’t have remembered that speech. The flames, though? The flames they remembered. The flame communicated.

As a result of Pentecost, the apostles suddenly had the ability to give the truth to foreigners. Aliens. People who were heretofore beyond their reach, isolated by language. The flame communicated.

God’s sense of timing is impeccable, and His delivery is carefully crafted. And on Pentecost, the Holy Spirit did not descend as a dove or pour forth as water.

On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit burned.

La Fama Comunicada

“¡Fuego! ¡Fuego! ¡Todos van a morir! ¡Todos se van a quemar!”

No tenía absolutamente ninguna esperanza de restaurar el orden cuando leí la historia de Pentecostés con mis hijos pequeños el año pasado. Tan pronto como vieron las lenguas de fuego flotando sobre las frentes de los apóstoles, se perdieron entre risas y gritos. Suspiré, tomé un sorbo de mi café y me pregunté con resentimiento por qué el Espíritu Santo no pudo haber elegido ser una paloma en ese día en particular. Solo una paloma agradable y pacífica.

Sin embargo, diré esto: el fuego dejó una impresión. Suele pasar, ¿no? El fuego consume. Renueva. Ilumina. Te deja sin aliento con temor y asombro. El recuerdo, el olor y el impacto de una llama persisten mucho después de que se extingue.

Cuando trato de explicar teología a mis hijos, tengo la terrible costumbre de complicar demasiado las cosas. Les había preparado todo un discurso sobre lo que es el Espíritu Santo, pero se fue por la ventana en cuanto vieron las llamas. ¿Y sabes qué? Probablemente sea lo mejor. No habrían recordado ese discurso. ¿Las llamas, sin embargo? Las llamas recordaron. La llama se comunicó.

Como resultado de Pentecostés, los apóstoles repentinamente tuvieron la habilidad de dar la verdad a forasteros. Extranjeros. Personas que hasta ahora estaban fuera de su alcance, aisladas por el idioma. La llama se comunicó.

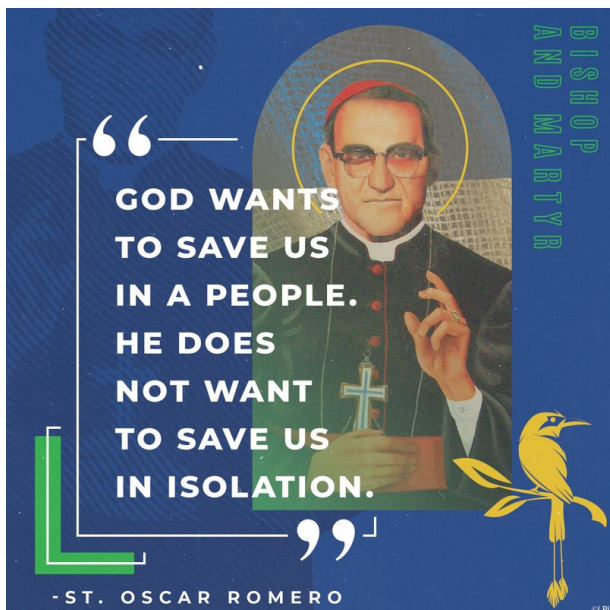
