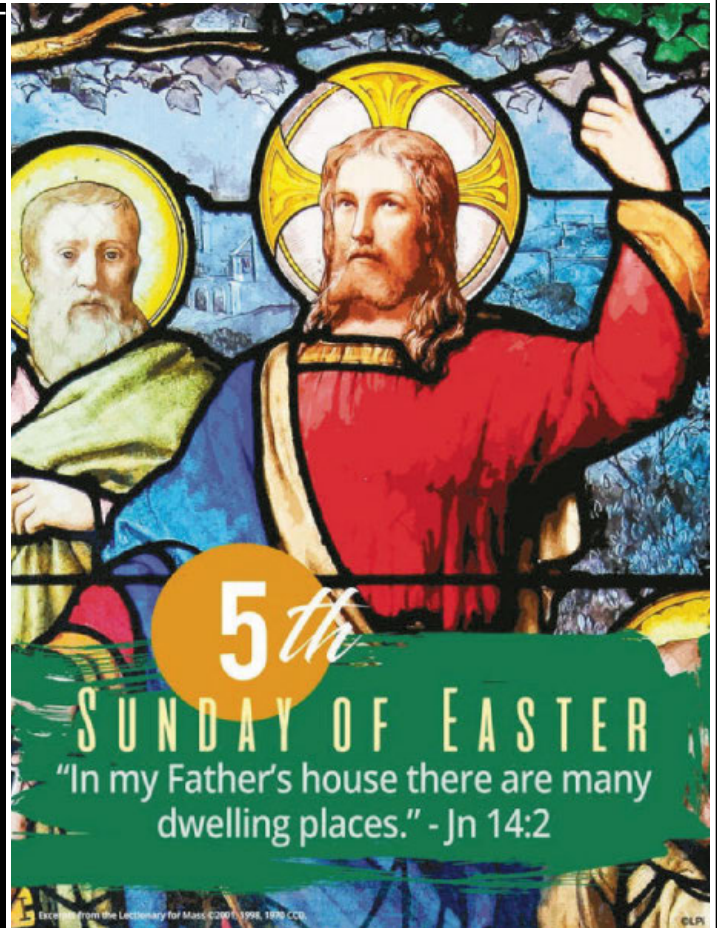

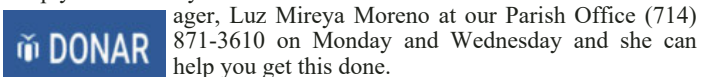

## PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This week we find ourselves in something of a pause in the Easter Season. The first half of this Season is over. Good Shepherd Sunday was last week. Next Sunday will pickup again with our celebration of the Ascension and the Sunday following will be Pentecost Sunday.

But what then to make of this Sunday?

During the whole of the Easter Season, both on Sundays and during the week, the First Reading always comes from the Acts of the Apostles. One of the overwhelming themes of the Acts of the Apostles was that through the action of the Holy Spirit any crisis that the Church found itself in could be not only overcome but would also make the Church grow.

In the First Reading today we hear a complaint that many of us could understand even today: A sizable second language preferring community began to complain that its needs were not being attended to. Feeling both that they had enough to do, and quite possibly feeling not the best equipped to respond to these needs themselves, the Apostles decided to appoint Deacons from that community to attend to those needs.

This set-in motion a completely predictable string of events. "New people" bring with them new ideas and with them at least initially new problems: One of the new Deacons, St. Stephen started preaching a bit "more boldly" than the community (and outside the community) were used to. As a result, he got killed, and the whole church, in Jerusalem, found itself having to flee.

One can imagine some of the complaints of that Christian community forced to flee because "that guy" from "that community" started saying things that [he should have known better] not to say.

But the hero here becomes the Holy Spirit.

Yes, it had to have been a real problem for the members of the Christian community of Jerusalem to have to flee their homes and their businesses because some "loud mouth" and then "from another ethnicity" "couldn't keep it together."

But through the action of the Holy Spirit, the Church only grew. If this had not happened, if St. Stephen would have not been who he was, the Christian community would have never left Jerusalem and would have slowly died of its own complacency.

Yes, the response to St. Stephen's stinging preaching was like that of a baseball bat smashing into a bee hive. But the bees then scattered and the whole region came to filled with new busy bees building new hives and in places that they would not have gone before.

So please let us not be afraid in front of the challenges that face us. The Holy Spirit remains with us, within the Church. And any crisis we face can be redeemed and just make the Church bigger, better, more impactful than before.

Happy Fifth Sunday of Easter.

## PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Esta semana nos encontramos en una especie de pausa en el Tiempo Pascual. La primera mitad de este tiempo ha terminado. El Domingo del Buen Pastor fue la semana pasada. El próximo domingo celebraremos de nuevo la Ascensión y el domingo siguiente será Pentecostés.

Pero, ¿qué pensar entonces de este domingo?

Durante todo el tiempo pascual, tanto los domingos como entre semana, la primera lectura procede siempre de los Hechos de los Apóstoles. Uno de los temas más importantes de los Hechos de los Apóstoles es que, gracias a la acción del Espíritu Santo, cualquier crisis en la que se encontrara la Iglesia podía no sólo superarse, sino también hacerla crecer.

En la primera lectura de hoy escuchamos una queja que muchos de nosotros podríamos entender incluso hoy: Una comunidad numerosa que prefería una segunda lengua empezó a quejarse de que no se atendían sus necesidades. Los Apóstoles, que pensaban que ya tenían bastante que hacer y que posiblemente no se sentían los más capacitados para responder a esas necesidades, decidieron nombrar diáconos de esa comunidad para atenderlas.

Esto puso en marcha una serie de acontecimientos totalmente predecibles. La "gente nueva" trae consigo nuevas ideas y, al menos al principio, nuevos problemas: Uno de los nuevos diáconos, San Esteban, empezó a predicar un poco "más atrevidamente" de lo que la comunidad (y fuera de ella) estaba acostumbrada. Como resultado, fue asesinado, y toda la iglesia, en Jerusalén, se vio obligada a huir.

Uno puede imaginarse algunas de las quejas de esa comunidad cristiana obligada a huir porque "ese tipo" de "esa comunidad" empezó a decir cosas que [debería haber sabido mejor] no decir.

Pero el héroe aquí pasa a ser el Espíritu Santo.

Sí, tuvo que ser un verdadero problema para los miembros de la comunidad cristiana de Jerusalén tener que huir de sus casas y sus negocios porque algún "bocazas" y luego "de otra etnia" "no podía mantener la compostura".

Pero por la acción del Espíritu Santo, la Iglesia no hizo más que crecer. Si esto no hubiera sucedido, si San Esteban no hubiera sido quien fue, la comunidad cristiana nunca habría salido de Jerusalén y habría muerto lentamente de su propia complacencia.

Sí, la respuesta a la prédica urticante de San Esteban fue como la de un bate de béisbol estrellándose contra una colmena de abejas. Pero las abejas se dispersaron y toda la región se llenó de nuevas abejas ocupadas construyendo nuevas colmenas y en lugares a los que antes no habrían ido.

Así que, por favor, no tengamos miedo ante los retos que se nos presentan. El Espíritu Santo permanece con nosotros, dentro de la Iglesia. Y cualquier crisis a la que nos enfrentemos puede ser redimida y hacer que la Iglesia sea más grande, mejor y más impactante que antes.

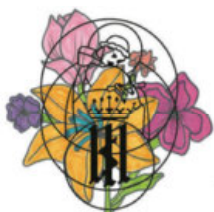

**RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS**

**Building on the Cornerstone**

Before I married my husband, I assumed there were “ugly houses” and “pretty houses,” and that was that. But Matt is an architect, someone who reads books with titles like “A Field Guide to American Houses” for fun and who uses the term *vernacular architecture* like he knows what it means.

Through him, I’ve come to learn a lot about why certain structures simply don’t have a pleasing look. There is a logic to ugliness, as it turns out. One of the main reasons a building or a home might strike some of us as ugly is because it has undergone a careless renovation. Whether out of laziness or an effort to be cost-effective, additions are made that depart from the architectural style of the original structure. The result is slapdash, confusing — ugly, for lack of a better word.

What is added on later must somewhat resemble the original. If you want to depart dramatically from the original style of a building, it’s better to build a separate structure altogether.

I think of this principle when I consider Christ as the “cornerstone.” We know we are called to model ourselves on Christ, to build on his example. But so often we cherry-pick elements of his message and attempt to build on it with additions that make no sense.

When someone looks at us, at our lives, they should be able to tell after whom that life is patterned. We must resemble the cornerstone, if we do not, it will be apparent, unseemly. You can’t see God the Father without embracing God the Son. You can’t chart the future of a house without any thought for its past.

If Christ is not our inspiration, he will be our contradiction.

Antes de casarme con mi esposo, asumí que había “casas feas” y “casas bonitas,” y eso fue todo. Pero Matt es arquitecto, alguien que lee libros con títulos como “Una Guía de Campo para las Casas Americanas” por diversión y que usa el término *arquitectura vernácula* como si supiera lo que significa.

A través de él, he llegado a aprender mucho acerca de por qué ciertas estructuras simplemente no tienen un aspecto agradable. Resulta que hay una lógica en la fealdad. Una de las razones principales por las que un edificio o una casa puede parecernos feo a algunos de nosotros es porque ha sufrido una renovación descuidada. Ya sea por pereza o por un esfuerzo por ser rentable, se realizan adiciones que se apartan del estilo arquitectónico de la estructura original. El resultado es descuidado, confuso, feo, a falta de una palabra mejor.

Lo que se agrega más tarde debe parecerse un poco al original. Si deseas apartarte drásticamente del estilo original de un edificio, es mejor construir una estructura separada por completo.

Pienso en este principio cuando considero a Cristo como la “piedra angular.” Sabemos que estamos llamados a modelarnos en Cristo, a construir sobre su ejemplo. Pero muy a menudo elegimos elementos de su mensaje e intentamos desarrollarlo con adiciones que no tienen sentido.

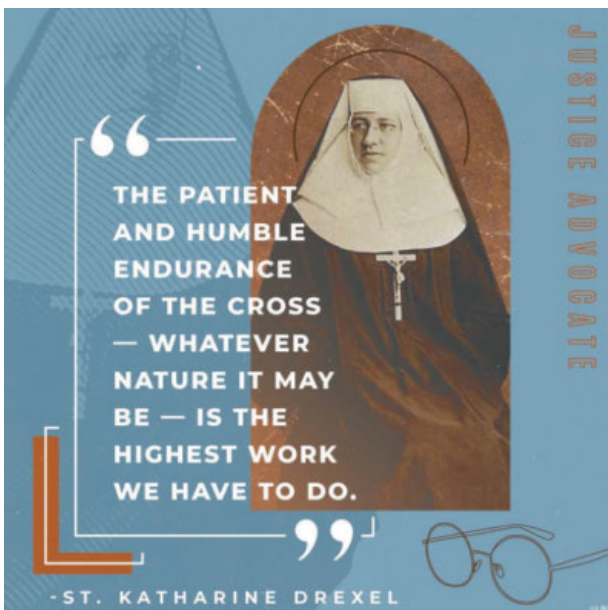

Si Cristo no es nuestra inspiración, será nuestra contradicción.
