PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

If the first Sunday of Lent always takes us with Jesus to the Desert and the second Sunday of Lent always takes us with him and three of his disciples to the Mountain Top, the following three Sundays take a different itinerary each of the three years of our liturgical cycle.

While each of the three itineraries has its point and is beautiful in its own way, this year, since we are following the Year A readings, we follow the classic itinerary in which Jesus' reconciliatory mission progressively revealed and expanded upon with each Sunday.

This week, already quite radical by conventional standards, Jesus makes it a point to bring into the fold a person that most people of his time would have completely ignored – a Samaritan woman with somewhat problematic past.

First, women in Jesus time were simply largely dismissed in public life. Second, if Israel itself understood itself to be a small country of little consequence at least in a world of far larger and more powerful states, the Samaritans, smaller, poorer, with a more mixed, less culturally distinct, they were a people that even the Jews of Israel would look down upon. Finally, this woman had a problematic personal history that made her a complicated outcast even among her Samaritan kinfolk.

The result was that this woman had apparently resigned herself to living a very solitary life. And it was into this life that Jesus entered, encountering her at her town's well, when she came there at a time of day – high noon – when she expected truly no one to be there.

And yet in her solitude, there came Jesus (God) to help bring her back.

By the end of the episode, this woman has not only rediscovered her self-worth but, she then presented Jesus, who had saved her, to the others of her community.

Jesus is able to bring us back from isolation and reconcile both to himself and to the larger community growing around him.

And this story is the first stop in a three part journey the continues next week.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Si el primer domingo de Cuaresma nos lleva siempre con Jesús al Desierto y el segundo domingo de Cuaresma siempre nos lleva con él y tres de sus discípulos a la Dima de la Montaña, los tres domingos siguientes toman un itinerario diferente cada uno de los tres años de nuestra ciclo litúrgico.

Si cada uno de los tres itinerarios tiene su belleza a su manera, este año, dado que estamos siguiendo las lecturas del Año A, seguimos el itinerario clásico en el que la misión reconciliadora de Jesús se revela y amplía progresivamente con cada domingo.

Esta semana, ya bastante radical según los estándares convencionales, Jesús se propone traer al redil a una persona que la mayoría de la gente de su tiempo habría ignorado por completo: una mujer samaritana con un pasado personal problemático.

Primero, las mujeres en el tiempo de Jesús simplemente fueron descartadas en gran medida de la vida pública. En segundo lugar, si el mismo Israel se entendió a sí mismo como un pequeño país de poca importancia al menos en un mundo de estados mucho más grandes y poderosos, los samaritanos, siempre más pequeños, más pobres, con una cultura más mixta, menos distinta culturalmente, eran un pueblo que incluso los judíos de Israel despreciarían. Finalmente, esta mujer tenía una historia personal problemática que la convirtió en una paria complicada aun para sus parientes samaritanos.

El resultado fue que esta mujer aparentemente se había resignado a vivir una vida muy solitaria. Y fue en esta vida que Jesús entró, encontrándola en el pozo de su pueblo, cuando ella llegó allí en un momento del día, el mediodía, cuando ella realmente esperaba que no hubiera nadie allí.

Y adentro de su soledad, entró Jesús (Dios) para ayudarla a traerla de vuelta.

Al final de este episodio, esta mujer no solo ha redescubierto su autoestima, sino que ella llevó a Jesús, quien la había salvado, a los demás de su comunidad.

Jesús es capaz de sacarnos del aislamiento y reconciliarnos con él mismo y a la comunidad más grande que crece a su alrededor.

Y esta historia sirve solo como la primera parada en un itinerario de tres partes que continúa la próxima semana.


