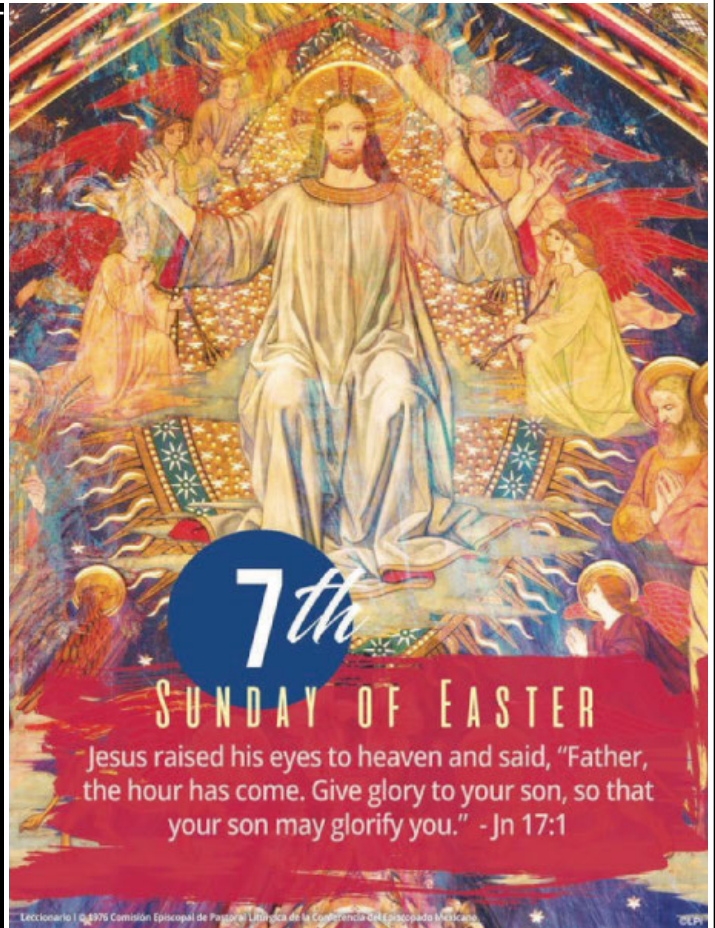

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, is one of those days that forces us to recognize that Jesus as much as he was human, indeed, fully human, was also divine. Both of these elements are necessary to understand both who Jesus really was, and then above all, the message that Jesus brought with him when he came.

If Jesus was merely human or merely divine, both his Resurrection and his Ascension to Heaven would be diminished. In the first case, these would be merely favors bestowed by a God more powerful than us on someone elected by God to receive them. In the second case, neither Jesus' Resurrection nor Ascension would be particularly special because "Gods can do whatever they want."

That Jesus was both showed that, one, God really wanted to understand us, our sufferings, our lowliness, and two, remained powerful enough to do something about it.

Both these elements are necessary to provide us with the Good News of Jesus Christ. If either was lacking – that God didn't care, or God was not strong enough (not really God) – the Gospel would have been diminished.

But for two thousand years we have proclaimed that both are true, that Jesus was truly human and truly divine.

So the event we celebrate today, Jesus' Ascension into Heavens, can give us hope that where Jesus went, he promises to bring us as well.

And so then let us give thanks to both the Lord and to the Church and our Ancestors for giving us the hope that our lives don't end here, but are designed to be with our Lord, in the Heavens forever.

Happy Ascension Sunday!

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Estimados feligreses,

La solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor, es uno de esos días que nos obligan a reconocer que Jesús, tanto como era humano, es más, plenamente humano, era también divino. Ambos elementos son necesarios para comprender quién era realmente Jesús y, sobre todo, el mensaje que Jesús trajo consigo cuando vino.

Si Jesús fuera meramente humano o meramente divino, tanto su Resurrección como su Ascensión al Cielo se verían disminuidas. En el primer caso, serían meros favores concedidos por un Dios más poderoso que nosotros a alguien elegido por Dios para recibirlos. En el segundo caso, ni la Resurrección ni la Ascensión de Jesús serían particularmente especiales porque "los Dioses pueden hacer lo que quieran".

Que Jesús fuera ambas cosas mostraba que, uno, Dios realmente quería comprendernos, nuestros sufrimientos, nuestra bajeza, y dos, seguía siendo lo suficientemente poderoso como para hacer algo al respecto.

Ambos elementos son necesarios para darnos la Buena Nueva de Jesucristo. Si faltara alguno de los dos -que a Dios no le importara, o que Dios no fuera lo suficientemente fuerte (que no fuera realmente Dios)-, el Evangelio habría quedado mermado.

Pero durante dos mil años hemos proclamado que ambas cosas son ciertas, que Jesús era verdaderamente humano y verdaderamente divino.

Por eso, el acontecimiento que celebramos hoy, la Ascensión de Jesús a los cielos, puede darnos la esperanza de que allí donde Jesús fue, promete llevarnos también a nosotros.

Así pues, demos gracias tanto al Señor como a la Iglesia y a nuestros antepasados por darnos la esperanza de que nuestras vidas no terminan aquí, sino que están destinadas a estar con nuestro Señor, en los Cielos, para siempre.

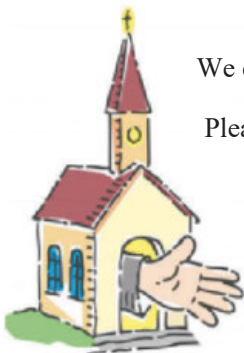

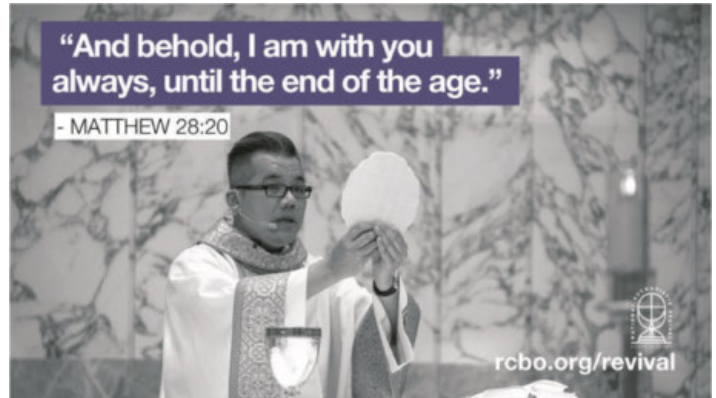

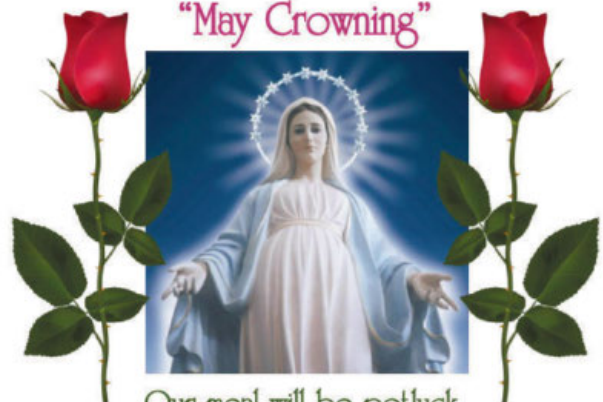

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Seeking Christ in One Another

The funeral luncheon, the Irish wake, the vigil at an ailing loved one’s bedside: in times of crisis, people gather. In moments of sadness, fear, and confusion, we gravitate toward one another. For some reason, the feelings are so much more bearable when we are not alone.

I’m sure that the disciples and their companions, gathered in the upper room after the Lord’s Ascension, did all of the things we typically do at these functions. I’m sure they hugged and talked and shared food, processing together the remarkable events they had witnessed.

But we don’t hear about any of that. We hear only that they prayed — fervently, and together.

Saint John Paul II famously said that “it is Jesus that you seek when you dream of happiness; He is waiting for you when nothing else you find satisfies you.” And I think that, whenever we gather, in good times or in bad, we think we are seeking companionship — but we are actually seeking God.

As I think back on the last few crisis-gatherings my family has had, I try to remember when we have stopped everything to pray together. I can think of a few times, but to be honest, they are *too* few. We are usually occupied with more practical tasks: planning the funeral, talking to the doctor, making the decisions, ordering the food. Just trying to survive through it.

But this is the busywork of sorrow, and it is a waste of our time. We would do better to follow the example of the disciples and remember that, in these dire moments, God is waiting for us.

Buscando a Cristo en los Demás

El almuerzo fúnebre, el velatorio irlandés, la vigilia junto a la cama de un ser querido enfermo: en tiempos de crisis, la gente se reúne. En momentos de tristeza, miedo y confusión, gravitamos el uno hacia el otro. Por alguna razón, los sentimientos son mucho más soportables cuando no estamos solos.

Estoy segura de que los discípulos y sus compañeros, reunidos en el aposento alto después de la Ascensión del Señor, hicieron todo lo que normalmente hacemos en estas funciones. Estoy segura de que se abrazaron, hablaron y compartieron comida, procesando juntos los extraordinarios acontecimientos que habían presenciado.

Pero no escuchamos nada de eso. Solo escuchamos que oraron, fervientemente y juntos.

San Juan Pablo II dijo célebremente que “es a Jesús a quien buscas cuando sueñas con la felicidad; Él te está esperando cuando nada más te satisfaga.” Y creo que, cada vez que nos reunimos, en las buenas o en las malas, pensamos que estamos buscando compañía, pero en realidad estamos buscando a Dios.

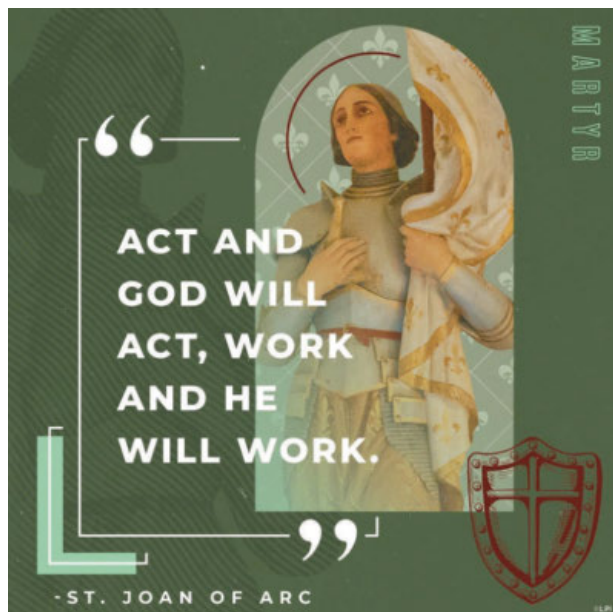
Mientras pienso en las últimas reuniones de crisis que ha tenido mi familia, trato de recordar cuándo hemos detenido todo para orar juntos. Puedo pensar en algunas veces, pero para ser honesta, son muy pocas. Por lo general, estamos ocupados con tareas más prácticas: planificar el funeral, hablar con el médico, tomar decisiones, ordenar la comida. Solo tratando de sobrevivir o atravesar el momento.

Pero este es el trabajo pesado del dolor, y es una pérdida de nuestro tiempo. Haríamos mejor en seguir el ejemplo de los discípulos y recordar que, en estos momentos difíciles, Dios nos está esperando.
