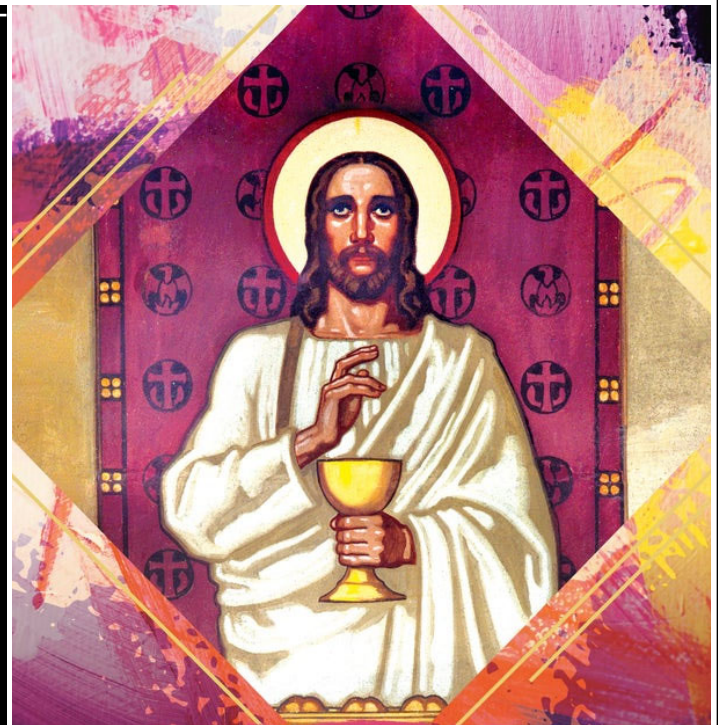

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). This celebration definitively ends the "extraordinary" part of our Liturgical year. During the week we've already been celebrating days of Ordinary Time since the Solemnity of Pentecost. However, from next Sunday onward to the Solemnity of Christ the King at the end of November even our Sunday celebrations will be overwhelmingly those of Ordinary Time.

But we end the "extraordinary" part of our Liturgical year remembering Jesus' mandate to his Apostles at the Last Supper: "Do this in Memory of Me." And so, we do ...

The Solemnity of the Corpus Christi along with attendant processions entered into the Church's Liturgical Calendar during the time of the Reformation. It seeks to underline the importance that the Church has given to fulfill what Jesus asked of us to do, and to take seriously Jesus' words that the elements of bread and wine brought to the celebration of the Eucharist really do become the Body and Blood of Christ.

With greater possibility for movement, the first half of the twentieth century was marked by various regional, national, and even international Eucharistic Congresses to focus the eyes of all Catholics on the Eucharist.

In these years immediately following the Covid-19 pandemic, the Catholic Church here in the United States has decided to organize a national Eucharistic revival to bring us together again, focusing on Eucharist, which the Second Vatican Council had declared "the source and the summit of our faith."

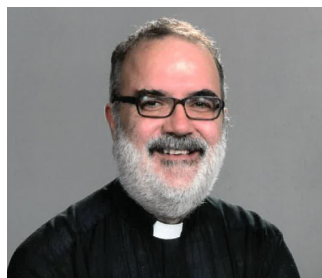
Since the very beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic we at St. Philip Benizi have been actively promoting Eucharistic devotion. Even when we could not meet physically, every Thursday night we livestreamed a Holy Hour from our "Chapel of Undisclosed Location" during which we prayed the Rosary in bilingual fashion with the Blessed Sacrament exposed ending with Benediction. When we could start meeting again under our tent in the St. Joseph Courtyard, we immediately offered Holy Hours before the Blessed Sacrament in both English and Spanish on Thursdays. When we returned to the Church, we continued our weekly Holy Hours on Tuesday evenings in Spanish and on Thursday Mornings in English.

Further during this time, we have been graced by the creation of our "Nocturnal Adoration" group which prays in vigil before the Blessed Sacrament, exposed, each 2nd Friday of the Month beginning at 10 PM and ending with Benediction and Mass at 6 AM on Saturday.

As part of our participation in the national Eucharistic revival, just held our 24 Hours with the Lord this weekend in preparation for this great Solemnity of Corpus Christ. And we will continue to actively promote both Eucharistic Devotion as well as the Prayer of the Holy Rosary as part of our Parish's spiritual life both "in season" and "out," looking forward to participating in the Diocesan Eucharistic Congress planned for October at the Cathedral.

The Eucharist is as Jesus declares in the Gospel Reading today "The Bread of Life," it is food for our journey. Let us always appreciate and honor what we received from our Lord at his last supper, and then strengthened by it seek to share our gifts with others, especially with those in greatest need.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Este domingo celebramos la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo (Corpus Christi). Con esta celebración termina definitivamente la parte "extraordinaria" de nuestro año litúrgico. Durante la semana ya hemos estado celebrando días del Tiempo Ordinario desde la Solemnidad de Pentecostés. Sin embargo, a partir del próximo domingo y hasta la Solemnidad de Cristo Rey, a finales de noviembre, también nuestras celebraciones dominicales serán mayoritariamente las del Tiempo Ordinario.

Pero terminamos la parte "extraordinaria" de nuestro año litúrgico recordando el mandato de Jesús a sus Apóstoles en la Última Cena: "Haced esto en memoria mía". Y así lo hacemos ...

La solemnidad del Corpus Christi, junto con las procesiones que la acompañan, entró en el Calendario Litúrgico de la Iglesia en tiempos de la Reforma. Pretende subrayar la importancia que la Iglesia ha dado al cumplimiento de lo que Jesús nos pidió que hiciéramos, y tomar en serio las palabras de Jesús de que los elementos de pan y vino que se traen a la celebración de la Eucaristía se convierten realmente en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo.

Con mayores posibilidades de movimiento, la primera mitad del siglo XX estuvo marcada por diversos Congresos Eucarísticos regionales, nacionales e incluso internacionales, para centrar la mirada de todos los católicos en la Eucaristía.

En estos años inmediatamente posteriores a la pandemia de Covid-19, la Iglesia católica aquí en los Estados Unidos ha decidido organizar un renacimiento eucarístico nacional para reunirnos de nuevo, centrándonos en la Eucaristía, que el Concilio Vaticano II había declarado "la fuente y la cumbre de nuestra fe".

Desde el comienzo de la pandemia de Covid-19, en San Felipe Benizi hemos promovido activamente la devoción eucarística. Incluso cuando no podíamos reunirnos físicamente, todos los jueves por la noche retransmitíamos en directo una Hora Santa desde nuestra "Capilla de ubicación no revelada" durante la cual rezábamos el Rosario en bilingüe con el Santísimo Sacramento expuesto finalizando con la Bendición. Cuando pudimos volver a reunirnos bajo nuestra carpa en el Patio de San José, inmediatamente ofrecimos Horas Santas ante el Santísimo Sacramento tanto en inglés como en español los jueves. Cuando regresamos a la Iglesia, continuamos nuestras Horas Santas semanales los martes por la noche en español y los jueves por la mañana en inglés.

Además, durante este tiempo, hemos sido agraciados con la creación de nuestro grupo de "Adoración Nocturna" que reza en vigilia ante el Santísimo Sacramento, expuesto, cada 2do Viernes del Mes comenzando a las 10 PM y terminando con la Bendición y Misa a las 6 AM del Sábado.

Como parte de nuestra participación en el avivamiento eucarístico nacional, acabamos de celebrar nuestras 24 Horas con el Señor este fin de semana en preparación de esta gran Solemnidad del Corpus Christi. Y continuaremos promoviendo activamente tanto la Devoción Eucarística como el Rezo del Santo Rosario como parte de la vida espiritual de nuestra Parroquia tanto "en temporada" como "fuera de temporada", esperando participar en el Congreso Eucarístico Diocesano planeado para Octubre en la Catedral.

La Eucaristía es como Jesús declara en la Lectura del Evangelio de hoy "El Pan de Vida", es alimento para nuestro camino. Apreciemos y honremos siempre lo que recibimos de nuestro Señor en su última cena, y luego, fortalecidos por ello, tratemos de compartir nuestros dones con los demás, especialmente con los más necesitados.

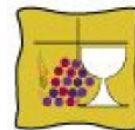

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

The Priesthood and the Eucharist

“These two Sacraments were born together,” wrote St. John Paul II of the priesthood and the Eucharist, “and their destiny is indissolubly linked until the end of the world.”

The Eucharist is such a beautiful example of how God, conscious of our limitations, bends to meet us. He once came to us cloaked in the flesh, that we might recognize Him. Now He comes as the very means by which we nourish ourselves: food and drink, the most familiar and comforting thing in the world to us. How easy He makes it to fulfill his command that we become one with Him. How generous He is to make such a sacred thing also accessible.

We can say the same of the priesthood, and of the men He calls to its number. How generous of Him to make such an accessible thing — our sons, our brothers, our uncles, our cousins — sacred. How generous of Him to allow these human creations — who share in our own faults — to be the means through which He comes to us in the Eucharist.

Without the Eucharist, we would have no eternal life. Without priests, we would have no Eucharist. On this, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, let’s give thanks for our priests, and redouble our prayers that God will send us good and holy ones — manna from Heaven in our wandering exile.
