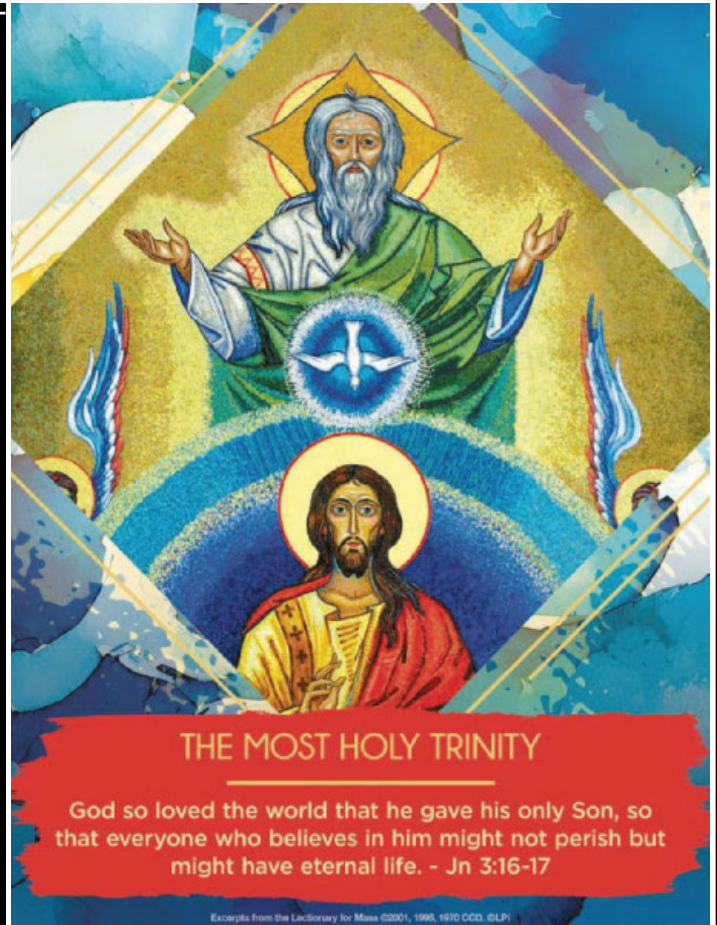

**PASTORS PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

With the celebration of Pentecost Sunday, we find ourselves at least during the week again in Ordinary Time. However, since we are coming to the end of the most intense part of the Liturgical Year, which began with Ash Wednesday which opened subsequent 40 day Lenten Season of preparation for Holy Week and Easter and we continued then celebrating the Easter Season for 50 days until the Feast of Pentecost, the first two Sundays following the close of the Easter Season remain special.

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, and next Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

The Most Holy Trinity remains one of the most difficult Doctrines to explain in our Christian Faith. Indeed, it is a Mystery that St. Augustine once described as large as an ocean.

Yet the Readings chosen by the Church for this feast help us to understand at least a part of it. By reminding us that "God send his Son into the world not to condemn the world but that it be saved through him," we are reminded once more that our God is not merely Great (bigger / greater than us) but also and above Good.

It would make little sense in following a God who was not good, and it has been noted in these past decades by various theologians led by the German Cardinal named Walter Kasper that one of benefits of believing in the Most Holy Trinity is that we believe in a God who is already complete without us, that God does not need us to like him, or worship him.

Instead, since God is not "alone" but from the beginning lives in a community of three persons, God was able to create us simply out Divine love and joy. God loves us, God created us, but God does not "need us" in order to be happy. God was, is, and always will be already complete, without us.

Yes, we believe in a God who cares, and today's Gospel reminds us of this. However, we believe in a God who does not have to care, doesn't need us to be good, and so we are all completely free, even as God remains loving us, with hand outstretched toward us anyway.

So let us give thanks for having a God who's there for us when we need him, but who doesn't need us to love him. And let the freedom that we have help us to appreciate the Greatness of God's love for all of us.

Happy Trinity Sunday.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados feligreses,

Con la celebración del Domingo de Pentecostés, nos encontramos de nuevo, al menos durante esta semana, en el Tiempo Ordinario. Sin embargo, como estamos llegando al final de la parte más intensa del Año Litúrgico, que comenzó con el Miércoles de Ceniza que abrió el posterior Tiempo de Cuaresma de 40 días de preparación para la Semana Santa y la Pascua y continuamos luego celebrando el Tiempo Pascual durante 50 días hasta la fiesta de Pentecostés, los dos primeros domingos que siguen a la clausura del Tiempo Pascual siguen siendo especiales.

Este domingo celebramos la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad, y el próximo domingo celebramos la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo.

La Santísima Trinidad sigue siendo una de las doctrinas más difíciles de explicar en nuestra fe cristiana. De hecho, es un Misterio que San Agustín describió una vez tan grande como un océano.

Sin embargo, las lecturas elegidas por la Iglesia para esta fiesta nos ayudan a comprender al menos una parte. Al recordarnos que "Dios no envió a su Hijo al mundo para condenar al mundo, sino para salvarlo por medio de Él", se nos recuerda una vez más que nuestro Dios no es simplemente Grande (más grande / más grande que nosotros), sino también y sobre todo Bueno.

No tendría mucho sentido seguir a un Dios que no fuera bueno, y en las últimas décadas varios teólogos, encabezados por el cardenal alemán Walter Kasper, han señalado que uno de los beneficios de creer en la Santísima Trinidad es que creemos en un Dios que ya está completo sin nosotros, que Dios no necesita que le queramos ni que le adoremos.

En cambio, como Dios no está "solo", sino que desde el principio vive en una comunidad de tres personas, Dios pudo crearnos simplemente por amor y alegría divinos. Dios nos ama, Dios nos creó, pero Dios no nos "necesita" para ser feliz. Dios ya estaba, está y estará siempre completo, sin nosotros.

Sí, creemos en un Dios que se preocupa, y el Evangelio de hoy nos lo recuerda. Sin embargo, creemos en un Dios que no tiene que preocuparse, que no nos necesita para ser bueno, y por eso todos somos completamente libres, aunque Dios siga amándonos, con la mano tendida hacia nosotros de todos modos.

Así que demos gracias por tener un Dios que está ahí para nosotros cuando le necesitamos, pero que no necesita que le amemos. Y dejemos que la libertad que tenemos nos ayude a apreciar la Grandeza del amor de Dios por todos nosotros.

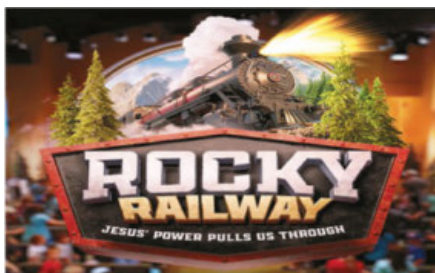

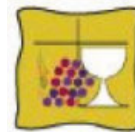

**RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS**

**RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS**

**We Bear the Name of the Lord**

**Llevamos el Nombre del Señor**

The name of the Lord is a curiously powerful thing. Say it deliberately, even in a group of people who are not particularly religious, and you'll know what I mean. There is a shift in the mood, a change in the atmosphere. When we utter the name of the Lord, He turns His head.

El nombre del Señor es algo curiosamente poderoso. Dilo deliberadamente, incluso en un grupo de personas que no son particularmente religiosas, y sabrás a lo que me refiero. Hay un cambio en el estado de ánimo, un cambio en la atmósfera. Cuando pronunciamos el nombre del Señor, Él voltea Su cabeza.

Once, in confession, I admitted to the sin of using the Lord's name in vain. "When you do that, tell God that you love him," advised the priest, who was wise enough to know that I would repeat this sin at some point. "You've said His name, after all. You have His attention."

Una vez, en confesión, admití el pecado de usar el nombre del Señor en vano. "Cuando hagas eso, dile a Dios que lo amas," aconsejó el sacerdote, quien fue lo suficientemente sabio como para saber que en algún momento repetiría este pecado. "Después de todo, has dicho Su nombre. Tienes Su atención."

We hear the name of the Lord, and we think of what it represents — John 3:16, salvation history summed up in a neat little sentence, the why and the how and the who of it all laid out before us. The Lord, so slow to anger that He offers us a million chances. The Lord, so rich in kindness and fidelity that He literally gave Himself to us that we might be saved.

Oímos el nombre del Señor y pensamos en lo que representa: Juan 3:16, la historia de la salvación resumida en una pequeña frase ordenada, el por qué, el cómo y el quién de todo ello expuesto ante nosotros. El Señor, tan lento para la ira que nos ofrece un millón de oportunidades. El Señor, tan rico en bondad y fidelidad que literalmente se entregó a nosotros para que pudiéramos ser salvos.

But the name of the Lord is more than that. It is not just a symbol, it is an invitation. I think of Moses clutching the commandments, beseeching the Lord: "Come with us. Forgive us. Receive us as your own." The Lord accompanies us down the mountain. We bear the name of the Lord into the world with us wherever we go.

Pero el nombre del Señor es más que eso. No es solo un símbolo, es una invitación. Pienso en Moisés aferrado a los mandamientos, suplicando al Señor: "Ven con nosotros. Perdónanos. I have to ask myself: do I do that name justice?

Tengo que preguntarme: ¿le hago justicia a ese nombre?

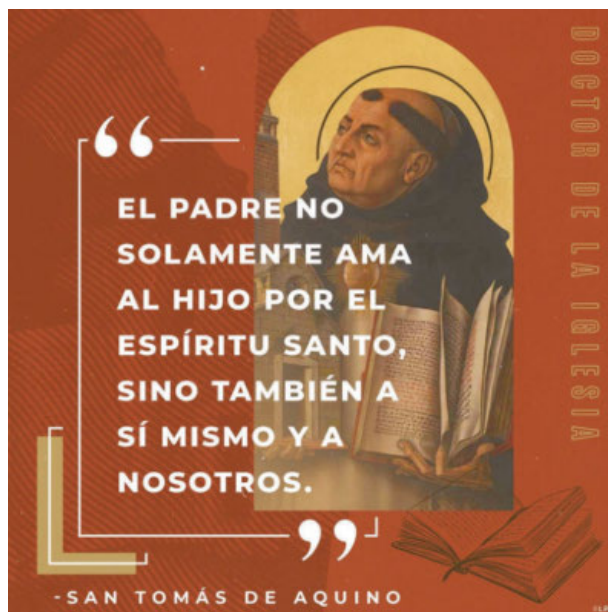
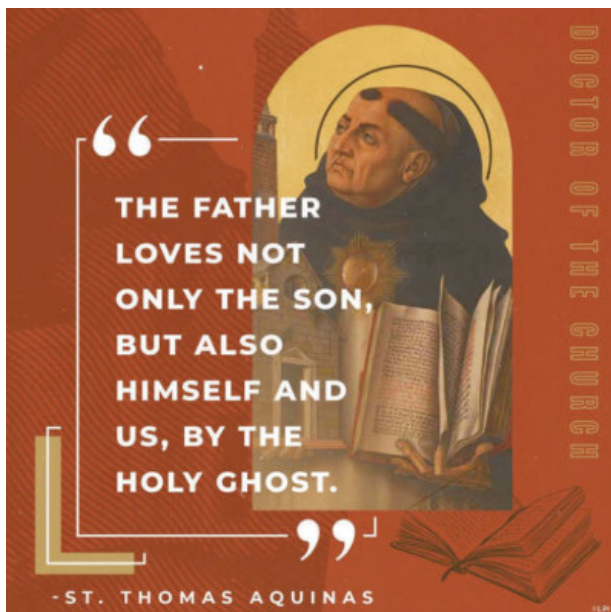
