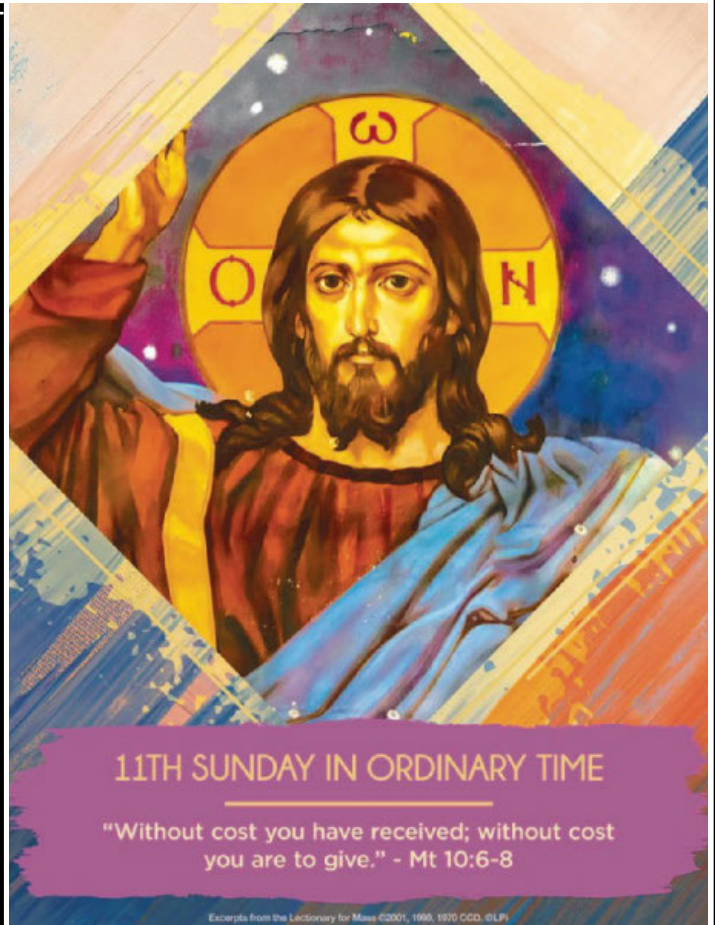

## PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we truly enter into "Ordinary Time." We celebrated Pentecost, the Arrival of the Holy Spirit three weeks ago, and then two weeks ago the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity and last week the Holy Body of Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). But now we've fully "returned to earth."

Yet this is what God created us for. There were no special feast days when God Created us, except for the Sabbath. And there were no special feast days in the early Church, except for Sunday, "the first day of the week" and with Jesus' Resurrection "the Day of the Lord." The Feast Days, from Passover to Easter, from Rosh Hashanah / Yom Kippur to Christmas / New Years (Mary Mother of God), from the Festival of the Booths to the Assumption of Mary are all wonderful, but they came later.

God made us for Ordinary Time with that one happy day of rest Saturday / Sunday with the other Feast Days being "nice" but fundamentally "extra."

And the Gospel Reading today already expresses an "Ordinary Concern." Jesus looks out at the people and sees that "the harvest is plenty, laborers few." And so he called his first disciples to step up.

Please take time to look at the bulletin folks. We've had some rough years over the past three years, but there are a lot of things going on again at the parish, from ministry recruitment and retreats, to a lovely summer program organized by our Faith Formation Program, to a Dance (a Luau) being organized by our quite enthusiastic Filipino Community. This alone is the third dance that we're having at the parish in a year, and another is probably coming for Our Lady of Sorrows / Mexican Independence Day in September! Good food, good fun.

Much going on. Additionally we will be having, again after three year suspension, a men's fishing trip, and we hope to have a lovely family sports tournament here as well. All before and after our parish patronal feast of St. Philip Benizi in August.

There is so much to do, there are so many ways we can contribute and participate. Marching forward into this lovely patch of ordinary time, let's seek to gladden the Holy Spirit with our activities and our praises. If nothing else, there's always something do, when one's part of the Kingdom of God!

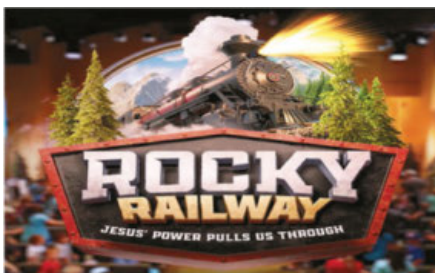

**EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION**

Baptized and Confirmed Catholic men and women of at least 25 years of age are eligible for this ministry. They should be persons who sincerely try to live the Gospel message in their communal and individual lives. If they are married, they should be married in the Church (divorce does not make one ineligible to serve as an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion). They should faithfully participate in the Sunday Eucharist and with God's grace in every aspect of their lives. People under the age of 25 must be individually recommended for delegation by their pastors.

Saturday, June 24<sup>th</sup> at 9:30am in the St. Joseph Plaza (between the school buildings) there will be a Formation/ Training Seminar. Every 3 years the names of those completing this formation are submitted to the Diocese for Commissioning, therefore it is mandatory that all current EMHC and EMHC to the Sick as well anyone who wishes to be a part of this ministry attend. **MINISTROS EXTRAORDINARIOS DE LA SAGRADA COMUNIÓN**

Los hombres y mujeres católicos bautizados y confirmados de al menos 25 años de edad son elegibles para este ministerio. Deben ser personas que intenten sinceramente vivir el mensaje del Evangelio en su vida comunitaria e individual. Si están casados, deben estar casados por la Iglesia (el divorcio no los hace inelegibles para servir como ministros extraordinarios de la Sagrada Comunión). Cada 3 años los nombres de los que completan esta formación se presentan a la Diócesis para la Comisión, por lo tanto, es obligatorio que todos los EMHC y EMHC para enfermos actuales, así como cualquier persona que desee ser parte de este ministerio asistir. ## The Toy

What does it mean to be God's "special possession"? Our world is dominated by *things*, objects, possessions. To say we are a materialistic culture is an understatement. In that context, it can be really hard to fully appreciate the meaning of being "possessed" by God. I have so many possessions, after all. I acquire and discard them without thought. I am even overwhelmed by them. Sometimes, it feels like *they* possess *me*.

But then I think of the week after Christmas in a house with small children. In that week, there is always The Toy. The Toy that won the heart of your child under the tree, The Toy to which they emotionally attached themselves in a whirlwind of twinkle lights and sugar cookies. For that one week, The Toy is all there is. There were many gifts, but The Toy is special, and there can only be one.

So, what does it mean to be "possessed" by God? What does it mean to be of his people? It means you will be cherished and protected in ways you do not deserve and cannot understand. It means you are distinguished not by your own merit, but by the love with which you are beheld.

It means that you are always The Toy, and every day is Christmas.

## El Juguete

¿Qué significa ser la "posesión especial" de Dios? Nuestro mundo está dominado por cosas, objetos, posesiones. Decir que somos una cultura materialista es quedarse corto. En ese contexto, puede ser realmente difícil apreciar completamente el significado de ser "poseído" por Dios. Tengo tantas posesiones, después de todo. Las adquiero y las descarto sin pensar. Incluso estoy abrumado por ellas. A veces, siento que ellas me poseen a mí.

Pero luego pienso en la semana después de Navidad en una casa con niños pequeños. En esa semana, siempre está El Juguete. El Juguete bajo el árbol que se ganó el corazón de tu hijo, El Juguete al que se unieron emocionalmente en un torbellino de luces centelleantes y galletas de azúcar. Por esa semana, El Juguete es todo lo que hay. Hubo muchos regalos, pero El Juguete es especial, y solo puede haber uno.

Entonces, ¿qué significa ser "poseído" por Dios? ¿Qué significa ser de su pueblo? Significa que serás apreciado y protegido de maneras que no mereces y no puedes entender. Significa que no te distingues por tu propio mérito, sino por el amor con el que te miran.

Significa que siempre eres El Juguete, y todos los días es Navidad.
