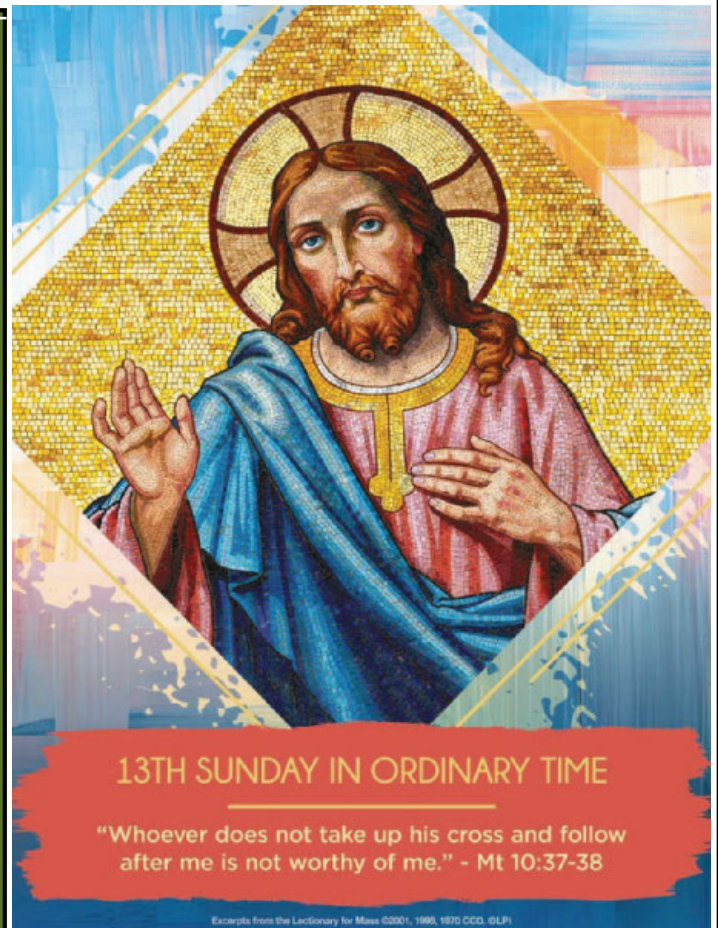

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

One of the most common admonitions in the Scriptures is not to be afraid. Indeed, arguably the Original Sin was not so much that Adam and Eve ate from the tree of Good and Evil -- if the tree really would have been that dangerous, God would not have put it in the middle of the Garden. Instead, the Original Sin was that Adam and Eve tried to hide their eating from the tree from God, that they were afraid of God's reaction.

Similarly, after witnessing all that God had done for them in liberating them from slavery in Egypt, from the witnessing the plagues to walking dry shod through the Red Sea, right at the edge of the Promised Land, the Israelites initially got "cold feet." They sent spies into the Promised Land and became scared of its inhabitants: "They are too big and there are too many of them. We're too small and there are not nearly enough of us."

For their lack of faith, God did not allow them to enter into the Promised Land. No God did not abandon them. Indeed, he fed them for forty years, but he did not allow them to enter the Promised Land. Instead, they were cursed to wander in the Desert for the rest of their lives wondering "what could have been."

In today's Readings, we are assured that God does see and rewards even the smallest gestures of kindness that we may have done. Elisha assures the woman who gave him hospitality that God will reward her, and Jesus tells his followers that God will reward even someone who gives even a single cup of water to someone in need.

Yes, God sees all. Yes, he sees our sins. But he also sees the good things that we've done. Let us not fear doing good.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Una de las advertencias más comunes en las Escrituras es no tener miedo. De hecho, podría decirse que el Pecado Original no fue tanto que Adán y Eva comieran del árbol del Bien y del Mal -- si el árbol hubiera sido realmente tan peligroso, Dios no lo habría puesto en medio del Jardín. En cambio, el Pecado Original fue que Adán y Eva trataron de ocultarle a Dios que habían comido del árbol, temían la reacción de Dios.

Del mismo modo, después de presenciar todo lo que Dios había hecho por ellos al liberarlos de la esclavitud en Egipto, desde presenciar las plagas hasta caminar con los pies descalzos por el Mar Rojo, justo al borde de la Tierra Prometida, los israelitas al principio se "acobardaron". Enviaron espías a la Tierra Prometida y se asustaron de sus habitantes: "Son demasiado grandes y demasiados. Nosotros somos demasiado pequeños y no somos suficientes".

Por su falta de fe, Dios no les permitió entrar en la Tierra Prometida. No, Dios no los abandonó. De hecho, los alimentó durante cuarenta años, pero no les permitió entrar en la Tierra Prometida. En lugar de eso, fueron maldecidos a vagar por el Desierto durante el resto de sus vidas preguntándose "qué podría haber sido".

En las Lecturas de hoy, se nos asegura que Dios sí ve y recompensa incluso los más pequeños gestos de bondad que hayamos podido hacer. Eliseo asegura a la mujer que le dio hospitalidad que Dios la recompensaría, y Jesús dice a sus seguidores que Dios recompensará incluso a quien dé un solo vaso de agua a alguien necesitado.

Sí, Dios lo ve todo. Sí, ve nuestros pecados. Pero también ve las cosas buenas que hemos hecho. No tengamos miedo de hacer el bien.

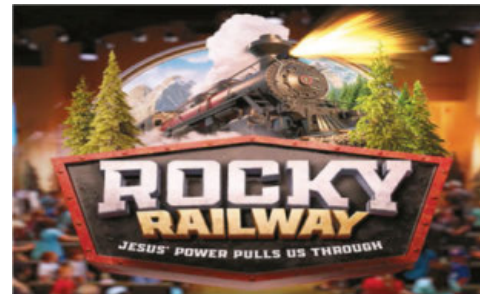
