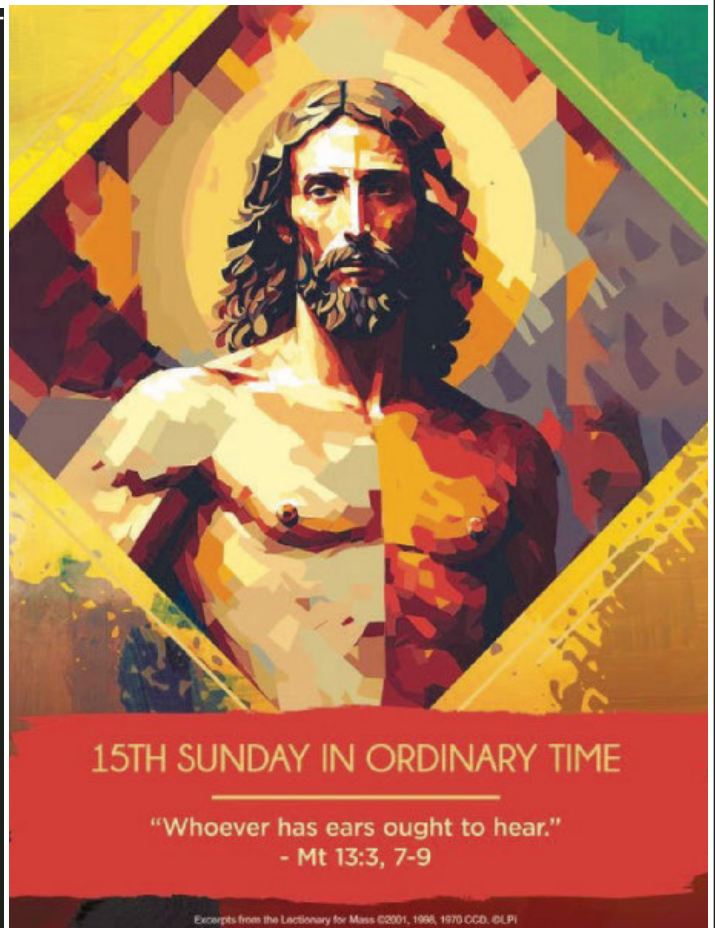

## PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

In this time of summer and hopefully of greater opportunity to rest and reflect, the Liturgy gives us this Sunday and during the succeeding ones, the opportunity to reflect on a number of Jesus' most famous parables.

This Sunday, we are given the opportunity to reflect on the Parable of the Sower and the Seed, and reminded that only some of the seed falls on good soil and is able to bear fruit. And yet, the parable assures us that this seed will produce enough of a harvest to make the effort worthwhile.

In the succeeding centuries, the Church has often reflected on this parable and even on the reality that the Truth doesn't always win immediately, and that part of being a disciple of Jesus is to accept difficulties and even to search out the harder path rather than the easier one.

How to make sense of this? In our time, probably Mother Theresa said it most clearly: "We're not called to be successful, but to be faithful." And the ministries taken by her entire congregation seem almost designed to underline the point.

During my time in the Seminary, I had the opportunity to help at the Soup Kitchen that Mother Theresa's sisters had at the Vatican. Every Saturday evening they prepared a meal for exactly 50 people. There were plenty of people in Rome who could have used the free meal. Indeed, there were plenty of other Catholic organizations, notably the Community of San Egidio, which routinely fed people by the hundreds even at roughly the same time.

Further, though there wouldn't have been any trouble to have gotten "donations" from any number of restaurants across Rome, even and especially 5-star restaurants for the work of "saintly Sisters of Mother Theresa," The sisters kindly turned those offers down, saying: "Thank you very much for your kind offers, but we don't want your food, let alone your best food. Instead, we could use your garbage."

And so it was, every Saturday, we produced a meal, a good, quality, 2-3 star, healthy meal, whose beginning ingredients were the discarded scraps of Rome's 4-5 star restaurants. And this fed not hundreds, or even thousands, but exactly ... 50 people.

What was going on here? The point clearly wasn't to feed the multitudes. The point was ... to make a point about what we throw out and how (if we all were more mindful of what we throw out) our scraps could feed, and feed well, a surprising number of people.

Not all the seed needs to fall on good ground. That which does, can be more than enough.

Happy 15th Sunday of Ordinary Time!  
And may these days bring us all some lovely, well needed rest and time for reflection.

## PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Estimados feligreses,

En este tiempo de verano y, esperemos, de mayores oportunidades para descansar y reflexionar, la Liturgia nos brinda este domingo y los siguientes la oportunidad de reflexionar sobre algunas de las parábolas más famosas de Jesús.

Este domingo, se nos ofrece la oportunidad de reflexionar sobre la parábola del sembrador y la semilla, y se nos recuerda que sólo una parte de la semilla cae en buena tierra y es capaz de dar fruto. Sin embargo, la parábola nos asegura que esta semilla producirá una cosecha suficiente para que el esfuerzo merezca la pena.

En los siglos posteriores, la Iglesia ha reflexionado a menudo sobre esta parábola e incluso sobre la realidad de que la Verdad no siempre vence inmediatamente, y que parte de ser discípulo de Jesús consiste en aceptar las dificultades e incluso en buscar el camino más difícil en lugar del más fácil.

¿Cómo entender esto? En nuestro tiempo, probablemente la Madre Teresa lo dijo más claramente: "No estamos llamados a tener éxito, sino a ser fieles". Y los ministerios asumidos por toda su congregación parecen casi diseñados para subrayar este punto.

Durante mi estancia en el Seminario, tuve la oportunidad de ayudar en el comedor que las hermanas de la Madre Teresa tenían en el Vaticano. Todos los sábados por la noche preparaban una comida para exactamente 50 personas. Había mucha gente en Roma a la que le habría venido bien esa comida gratis. De hecho, había muchas otras organizaciones católicas, en particular la Comunidad de San Egidio, que daban de comer a cientos de personas a la misma hora.

Además, aunque no habría habido ningún problema en conseguir "donaciones" de cualquier número de restaurantes de Roma, incluso y especialmente restaurantes de 5 estrellas para el trabajo de las "santas Hermanas de la Madre Teresa", las hermanas amablemente rechazaron esas ofertas, diciendo: "Muchas gracias por sus amables ofertas, pero no queremos su comida, y mucho menos su mejor comida. En su lugar, nos vendría bien su basura".

Y así fue, cada sábado, elaborábamos una comida, una comida buena, de calidad, de 2-3 estrellas, sana, cuyos ingredientes iniciales eran las sobras desechadas de los restaurantes de 4-5 estrellas de Roma. Y esto no alimentó a cientos, ni siquiera a miles, sino exactamente... a 50 personas.

¿Qué estaba pasando aquí? El punto claramente no era alimentar a las multitudes. El objetivo era ... hacer un punto sobre lo que tiramos y cómo (si todos fuéramos más conscientes de lo que tiramos) nuestras sobras podrían alimentar, y alimentar bien, a un número sorprendente de personas.

No es necesario que todas las semillas caigan en buena tierra. La que cae, puede ser más que suficiente.

¡Feliz 15º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario! Y que estos días nos traigan a todos un hermoso y necesario descanso y tiempo para la reflexión.

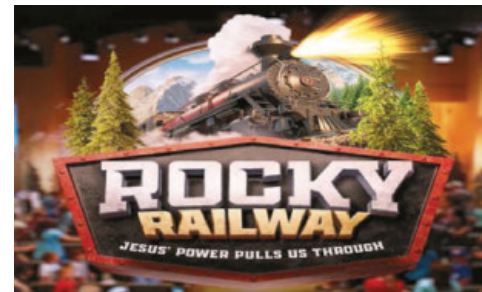

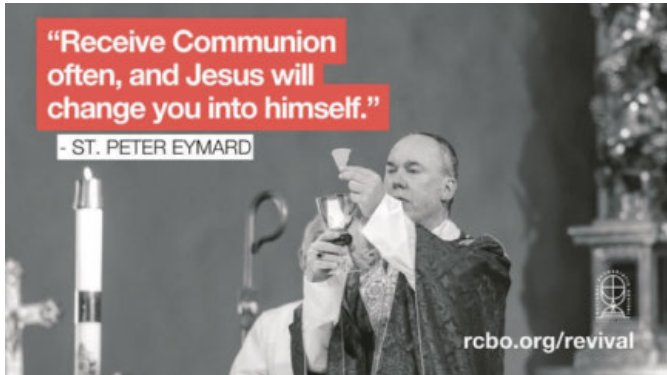
