

PASTORS PONDERINGS**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday's Readings, which we hear in the context of a time of greater relaxation are about inclusion – the Church as a tree on which all of the birds of the air can find a place to nest, as well as leaving judgement to God. In the business of life or even in the running of a parish, we can forget those things.

First, in terms of inclusion, we do have to remember that all of us are children of God given skills to offer our other brothers and sisters in the building of the kingdom of God. Hence the Church and on the small scale the parish ought to be a place where everyone can offer their talents to the service of God and brother and sister. Both our doors and our hearts need to be open to others.

In my time here, I've tried very hard to keep such doors open and to encourage all people to share their talents here with others. There have been exceptions but they have been very few and almost always causing a good deal of pain to all around. We often wonder why God often doesn't get involved in our conflicts. I think I've learned something about that here.

That all said, for the most part our doors really are open, and we do everything from fish to pray, celebrate Mass in three, sometimes even four languages. Our upcoming St. Philip Benizi picnic will include both Irish and Mexican folk dancers, and we may still get the Indonesian Lion Dancers as well (though I am always reminded that they like to go back to sleep after New Years until the next year).

As irritating as it is sometimes, we remain a place known across the County and Diocese that cares for those who are poor and homeless. All things considered, it's probably better to have that reputation than a reputation of a parish that does not care.

I am concerned about some of the rhetoric I occasionally hear among us about our LGBTQ brothers and sisters. Know honestly that among us are people who have loved ones who are LGBTQ and who do in fact love them because they are their children, nieces and nephews.

One of the greatest testaments of "leaving things to God" given to me by my family was the example of two of my uncles, one, after whom I'm named, who was jailed by the Communists (for being part of a student group that passed among itself banned materials), and the other who married into my family though was a "card carrying Communist." Despite vastly different points of view, both still happily got together and "went to grandma's house" for Christmas, Easter, birthdays, and my Communist uncle even married my aunt (my dad's sister) in the Church after the Communists were already in power so as to not cause needless problems in his new (my) family.

We can all be nice, and leave judgement to God, who knows us all, better than we know ourselves. May God continue to bless us all.

Estimados feligreses,

Las lecturas de este domingo, que escuchamos en el contexto de un tiempo de mayor relajación, tratan sobre la inclusión: la Iglesia como un árbol en el que todos los pájaros del cielo pueden encontrar un lugar para anidar, así como dejar el juicio a Dios. En los negocios de la vida o incluso en la gestión de una parroquia, podemos olvidar estas cosas.

En primer lugar, en términos de inclusión, tenemos que recordar que todos somos hijos de Dios con habilidades para ofrecer a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en la construcción del Reino de Dios. De ahí que la Iglesia y, a pequeña escala, la parroquia deban ser un lugar en el que todos puedan ofrecer sus talentos al servicio de Dios y de los hermanos. Tanto nuestras puertas como nuestros corazones deben estar abiertos a los demás.

En el tiempo que llevo aquí, he intentado por todos los medios mantener esas puertas abiertas y animar a todas las personas a compartir aquí sus talentos con los demás. Ha habido excepciones, pero han sido muy pocas y casi siempre han causado bastante dolor a todos los que estaban alrededor. A menudo nos preguntamos por qué Dios no suele involucrarse en nuestros conflictos. Creo que aquí he aprendido algo al respecto.

Dicho todo esto, en su mayor parte nuestras puertas están realmente abiertas, y hacemos de todo, desde pescar para rezar, celebrar misa en tres, a veces incluso cuatro idiomas. Nuestro próximo picnic de San Felipe Benizi incluirá bailarines folclóricos irlandeses y mexicanos, y puede que también tengamos a los Indonesian Lion Dancers (aunque siempre me recuerdan que les gusta volver a dormir después de Año Nuevo hasta el año siguiente).

Por irritante que sea a veces, seguimos siendo un lugar conocido en todo el Condado y la Diócesis que se preocupa por los pobres y los sin techo. Considerando todas las cosas, es probablemente mejor tener esa reputación que la reputación de una parroquia que no se preocupa.

Me preocupa algo de la retórica que ocasionalmente escucho entre nosotros sobre nuestros hermanos y hermanas LGBTQ. Sepan honestamente que entre nosotros hay personas que tienen seres queridos que son LGBTQ y que de hecho los aman porque son sus hijos, sobrinos y sobrinas.

Uno de los mayores testimonios de "dejar las cosas en manos de Dios" que me dio mi familia fue el ejemplo de dos de mis tíos, uno, que me da nombre, que fue encarcelado por los comunistas (por formar parte de un grupo estudiantil que distribuía entre ellos material prohibido), y el otro, que se casó con alguien de mi familia aunque era "comunista de carné". A pesar de tener puntos de vista muy diferentes, ambos se reunían felizmente e "iban a casa de la abuela" por Navidad, Pascua, cumpleaños, y mi tío comunista incluso se casó con mi tía (la hermana de mi padre) por la Iglesia cuando los comunistas ya estaban en el poder para no causar problemas innecesarios en su nueva familia (la mía).

Todos podemos ser amables, y dejar el juicio a Dios, que nos conoce a todos, mejor que nosotros mismos. Que Dios nos siga bendiciendo a todos.


