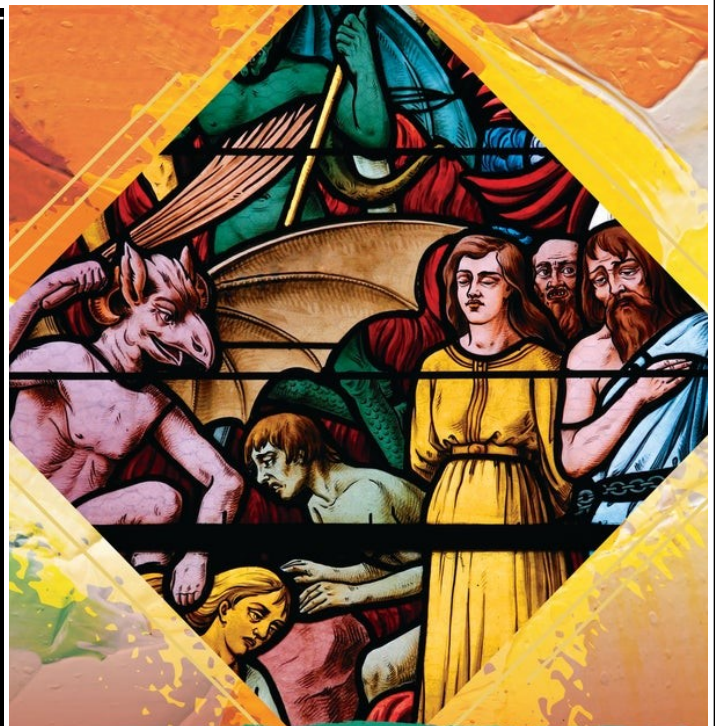

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

The Readings this Sunday speak to us of priorities and choices. We hear in the Gospel Reading of the Parable of the Pearl of Great Price and how a merchant when he had found it sold everything that he had to own it.

Then least one be worried about the implications of unthinkingly diving whole heartedly into something we hear in the First Reading of King Solomon, who became King at a very young age being offered by God the choice of picking any kind of blessing, asked to receive Wisdom, for which he was blessed by God.

The Pearl of Great Price offers us a symbol for anything that we consider the most important (or at least among the most important) things in our lives.

All of us are asked, of course, to put God / Jesus as our top priority in our lives. Then it has been the wisdom of the ages that those who are married put their Spouses then as right below God. Those in Religious Life asked to put their Order / Congregation (and the brothers or sisters concretely making it up) in the place where Spouse and then Family would be. Those entrusted with responsibility – Parish, Diocese, City, Country – should put the people of those places in a high place as well.

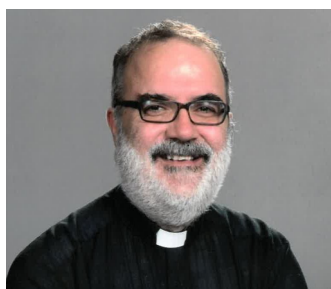
And yet we also hear that the Good Shepherd will leave the rest of the flock (that he's been entrusted with) to search for the lost sheep, presumably because in doing so, he's following the commandant of God (and the needs of that one person) over the needs / concerns of the rest of the flock. (It's tricky, huh?!).

But the point in all this is that searching for "vainglory" is pointless. Most of us know quite well that a shelf of trophies is meaningless if we had to climb over bodies to get them. We're reminded by Jesus that "what good is it to gain the whole world if one loses one's eternal soul in the process."

So, we're asked, in all things, but especially in the things that really matter to, "choose wisely."

Let's seek to do that, and may God bless us all!

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Las lecturas de este domingo nos hablan de prioridades y opciones. Escuchamos en la lectura del Evangelio la parábola de la Perla de Gran Precio y cómo un mercader, cuando la encontró, vendió todo lo que tenía para poseerla.

Entonces, para que uno no se preocupe por las implicaciones de lanzarse irreflexivamente de todo corazón a algo, escuchamos en la Primera Lectura que al Rey Salomón, que se convirtió en Rey a una edad muy temprana, Dios le ofreció la opción de elegir cualquier tipo de bendición, y pidió recibir la Sabiduría, por la que fue bendecido por Dios.

La Perla de Gran Precio nos ofrece un símbolo para todo aquello que consideramos lo más importante (o al menos entre lo más importante) de nuestra vida.

A todos nosotros se nos pide, por supuesto, que pongamos a Dios / Jesús como la máxima prioridad en nuestras vidas. Entonces ha sido la sabiduría de los siglos que aquellos que están casados pongan a sus Esposos entonces como justo debajo de Dios. A los que están en la Vida Religiosa se les pide que pongan a su Orden / Congregación (y a los hermanos o hermanas que la componen concretamente) en el lugar donde estaría el Cónyuge y luego la Familia. Aquellos a los que se les ha confiado una responsabilidad - Parroquia, Diócesis, Ciudad, País- deberían poner también a las personas de esos lugares en un lugar elevado.

Y, sin embargo, también oímos que el Buen Pastor dejará al resto del rebaño (que se le ha confiado) para buscar a la oveja perdida, presumiblemente porque, al hacerlo, está siguiendo el mandato de Dios (y las necesidades de esa persona) por encima de las necesidades / preocupaciones del resto del rebaño. (Es complicado, ¿eh?).

Pero el punto en todo esto es que buscar "vanagloria" no tiene sentido. La mayoría de nosotros sabemos muy bien que un estante de trofeos no tiene sentido si tenemos que pasar por encima de los cuerpos para conseguirlos. Jesús nos recuerda que "de qué sirve ganar el mundo entero si en el proceso se pierde el alma eterna".

Así que se nos pide que, en todas las cosas, especialmente en las que realmente importan, "elijamos sabiamente".

Procuremos hacerlo, ¡y que Dios nos bendiga a todos!

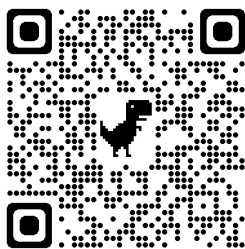
