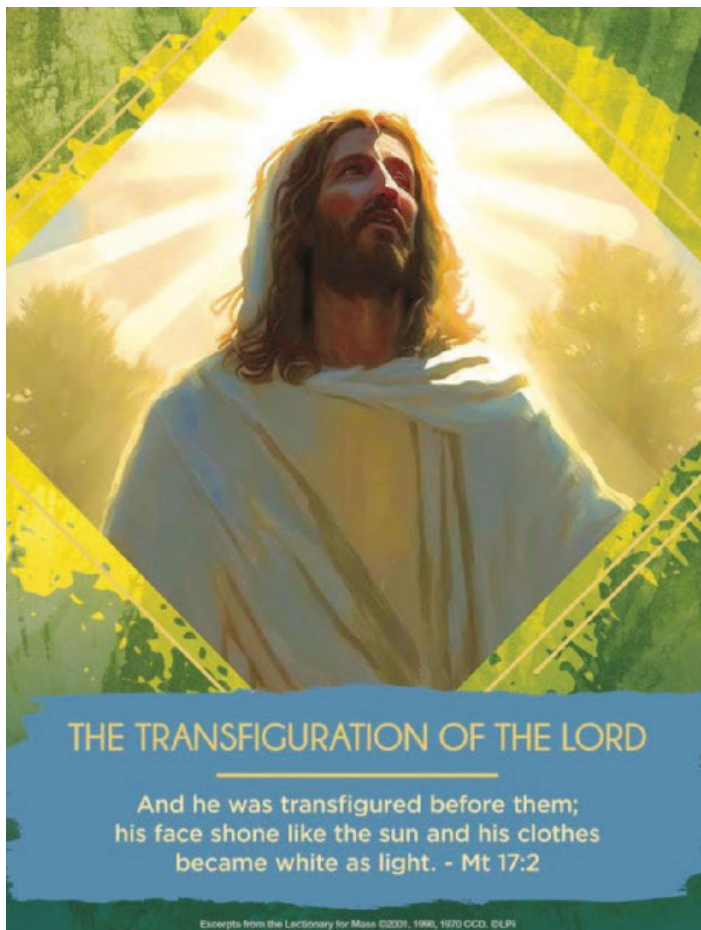

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

We may find ourselves in Ordinary Time, but During Ordinary time if a major Feast falls on a Sunday, the Readings and Prayers of that Feast Day are used rather than the Ordinary Sunday ones. So, it is here.

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration, an important episode in the Life and Ministry of Jesus when he made manifest a glimpse of his Glory to three of his closest disciples.

That Jesus had favorites might be surprising as it may be surprising too that he appeared to lean on these three more than the others. What of the other nine? What even of Andrew, Simon Peter's brother?

Indeed, I remember hearing a joke from several years back, of Jesus doing an interview in our time, explaining his thoughts and "the process" of his ministry and him sharing: "You know, I chose 12 Apostles, there were Biblical Reasons for it, but to be honest, I probably could have done this with six."

So, besides the 12 Apostles mirroring in some way the 12 tribes of Israel (many of which we really don't hear much of besides Judah, Benjamin and at times Ephraim) why did he pick 12?

Well, several Sundays back we heard of the Parable of the Sower and the Seed, and there we heard that though there was a lot of seed, only portion of it fell on good soil. But those other seeds were still necessary, to assure that there'd be at least some seed that fell on that good soil. And in the end, that seed produced enough to make the whole project a success.

We need to remember this. It is a universal phenomenon across the Church and even into the Communities of our Protestant Brothers and Sisters that 90% of the work is done by 10% of the people.

We can choose to be unhappy about this and we can certainly encourage as many people as possible to get involved (and then put needless obstacles in front of them when they try to get involved).

But at the end of the Day let us be happy (and grateful) for those who are involved, and we appreciate that ultimately God is in charge, and truly everything done in a good spirit will accomplish one way or another God's purpose.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Podemos encontrar en el Tiempo Ordinario, pero durante el Tiempo Ordinario si una Fiesta importante cae en domingo, se utilizan las Lecturas y Oraciones de ese día de Fiesta en lugar de las del Domingo Ordinario. Así sucede en este caso.

Este domingo celebramos la fiesta de la Transfiguración, un episodio importante en la vida y el ministerio de Jesús, cuando manifestó una visión de su gloria a tres de sus discípulos más cercanos.

Que Jesús tuviera favoritos puede sorprender, como puede sorprender también que pareciera apoyarse en estos tres más que en los demás. ¿Y los otros nueve? ¿Y Andrés, el hermano de Simón Pedro?

De hecho, recuerdo haber escuchado un chiste de hace varios años, de Jesús haciendo una entrevista en nuestro tiempo, explicando sus pensamientos y "el proceso" de su ministerio y él compartiendo: "Sabes, elegí 12 Apóstoles, había Razones Bíblicas para ello, pero para ser honesto, probablemente podría haber hecho esto con seis".

Así que, además de que los 12 Apóstoles reflejan de alguna manera las 12 tribus de Israel (de muchas de las cuales realmente no oímos hablar mucho además de Judá, Benjamín y a veces Efraín) ¿por qué eligió 12?

Bueno, varios domingos atrás escuchamos la Parábola del Sembrador y la Semilla, y allí escuchamos que, aunque había mucha semilla, sólo una parte cayó en buena tierra. Pero esas otras semillas seguían siendo necesarias, para asegurar que hubiera al menos alguna semilla que cayera en esa buena tierra. Y al final, esa semilla produjo lo suficiente para que todo el proyecto fuera un éxito.

Necesitamos recordar esto. Es un fenómeno universal en toda la Iglesia e incluso en las comunidades de nuestros hermanos y hermanas protestantes que el 90% del trabajo lo hace el 10% de las personas.

Podemos elegir no estar contentos con ello y, desde luego, podemos animar al mayor número posible de personas a que se impliquen (y luego ponerles obstáculos innecesarios cuando intenten hacerlo).

Pero, al fin y al cabo, estemos contentos (y agradecidos) por los que se implican, y apreciemos que, en última instancia, es Dios quien manda, y realmente todo lo que se haga con buen espíritu cumplirá de un modo u otro el propósito de Dios.

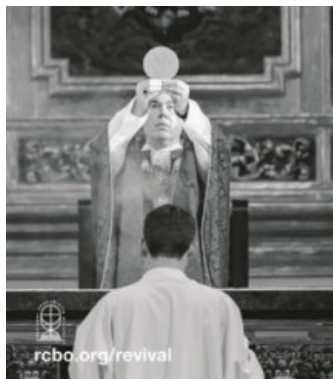
