PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we are given the opportunity to reflect on one of the most powerful episodes of all our Scriptures:

Jesus walking on the water, assuring us that Jesus can lift us out of the chaos of this world to a far more serene plane.

And there can be, indeed, much to worry about in the world today.

We live at a time that for the first time in our country's history we can imagine that our nation's Democracy is coming to an end.

We're told all sorts of reasons why our Democracy has already failed many people, and assured by such people that we won't hardly miss it when it is gone:

If one was poor, of an even somewhat darker skin tone, with a non-Shakespearian last name, or for that matter simply a woman, our nation's Democracy could always have been experienced as still largely a dream.

But at the very time when so many people who were previously ignored have been gaining their voice, why such a call to bring it crashing down?

Well, be that as it may, Jesus ultimately tells us that this doesn't matter.

I've noted this now for over a year, that only in the last 12-15 hours of his life did Jesus meet with anyone who was "important" at his time. It was only then that he met the Chief Priest Caiaphas, Herod, or Pontius Pilate (and they of course had him killed).

Instead, Jesus spent his entire life with regular people. So, in the end, I will miss Washington, Jefferson, Lincoln, Teddy Roosevelt, FDR, Truman, Eisenhower, Kennedy, Reagan, Clinton, GW Bush, and Obama, all of whom fundamentally tried to do good with the power entrusted to them.

But in the end, it does not matter. If in the end we choose to trade our Republic for the Statue of one man, any man really, ultimately, we are people, we are flawed, and the one person, who in any time can pull us out of the chaos of our time, to a higher plane is ... Jesus.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Este domingo tenemos la oportunidad de reflexionar sobre uno de los episodios más poderosos de todas nuestras Escrituras:

Jesús caminando sobre las aguas, asegurándonos que Jesús puede sacarnos del caos de este mundo a un plano mucho más sereno.

Y puede haber, en efecto, mucho de qué preocuparse en el mundo de hoy.

Vivimos en una época en la que, por primera vez en la historia de nuestro país, podemos imaginar que la Democracia de nuestra nación está llegando a su fin.

Nos cuentan todo tipo de razones por las que nuestra Democracia ya ha fallado a mucha gente, y nos aseguran que apenas la echaremos de menos cuando desaparezca:

Si uno fuera pobre, de un tono de piel algo más oscuro, con un apellido no shakesperiano, o simplemente una mujer, la democracia de nuestra nación siempre podría haber sido experimentada como un sueño.

Pero en el mismo momento en que tantas personas que antes eran ignoradas han ido ganando voz, ¿por qué ese llamamiento a derribarla?

Sea como fuere, Jesús nos dice en última instancia que eso no importa.

Llevo más de un año observando que sólo en las últimas 12-15 horas de su vida se reunió Jesús con alguien "importante" en su época. Sólo entonces se encontró con el Sumo Sacerdote Caifás, Herodes o Poncio Pilato (y ellos, por supuesto, lo mandaron matar).

En cambio, Jesús pasó toda su vida con gente normal. Así que, al final, echaré de menos a Washington, Jefferson, Lincoln, Teddy Roosevelt, FDR, Truman, Eisenhower, Kennedy, Reagan, Clinton, GW Bush y Obama, todos los cuales intentaron fundamentalmente hacer el bien con el poder que se les confió.

Pero al final, no importa. Si al final elegimos cambiar nuestra República por la estatua de un hombre, cualquier hombre en realidad, en última instancia, somos personas, somos defectuosos, y la única persona, que en cualquier momento puede sacarnos del caos de nuestro tiempo, a un plano superior es ... Jesús.
