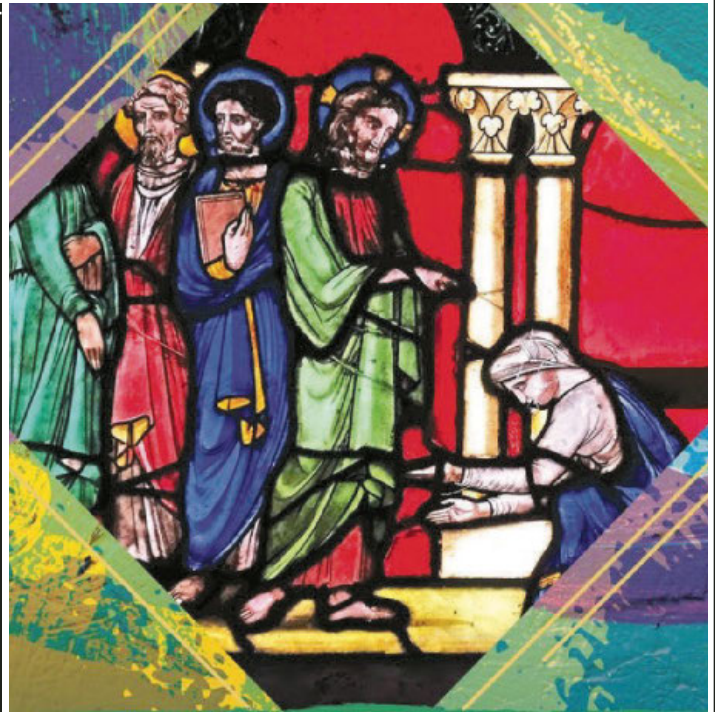

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we honor St. Philip Benizi, the Saint after whom our Parish is named.

In my time here, I've hoped to get the Parish better acquainted with our Parish patron saint because though he lived some 700 years ago, his life is surprisingly relatable:

He was born to upper middle-class parents, his father most likely a merchant who worked for a living.

Though comfortable, money isn't everything. St. Philip Benizi's parents had trouble having kids, like a surprising number of our parishioners. After many prayers to the Virgin, St. Philip Benizi's parents were able to conceive, and when they did have him, they wanted the best for him. They sent him to the Sorbonne in Paris the equivalent at that time of sending him to Harvard or perhaps Berkely to become a doctor (again St. Philip's parents were of some means).

Yet as happens in a lot of families, St. Philip had other aspirations, as apparently did Mary. When he returned home, he decided to join the Servites as a simple brother.

When the Servites learned of his education, they made him study to be a priest and then elected him Prior General. With some embarrassment, he didn't tell his parents that he was the Servite Prior General for 8 years.

But finding himself in a position of some import, he used it to try to get the Servite Order approved by the Holy See a Herculean Project that sent him on errands all over Italy and finally, perhaps that he was frustrated that "the paperwork wasn't getting done," by legend he was asked if he then would like to be Pope, emphatically said no.

Eventually, he got the Servite Order approved, if, alas on "a temporary license," but having gotten that matter completed, he used the rest of his time as Prior General doing what he really liked to do: simply visiting the friars, as well as joining them in doing the cooking and cleaning (there's a lovely picture of him working in the kitchen in the Servite Priory in Innsbruck and another one of his sweeping at some Church in Italy). Yes, there were (some) miracles associated with him. Yes, he helped a few poor and troubled people. But above all, he was just a decent guy, with some administrative talents that he preferred to put aside and just spend time with his friends (his Servite brothers). And "he made it."

Isn't that nice? Many times, we may be worried that we're not good enough for God. In St. Philip, all in all a quite gentle Saint, we are given the hope that we are. Happy Parish Feast Day!

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Estimados feligreses,

Este domingo honramos a San Felipe Benizi, el santo que da nombre a nuestra parroquia.

Durante el tiempo que llevo aquí, he intentado que la parroquia conozca mejor a nuestro patrón, porque, aunque vivió hace unos 700 años, su vida es sorprendentemente cercana:

Nació en el seno de una familia de clase media alta, su padre probablemente era un comerciante que trabajaba para ganarse la vida.

Aunque cómodo, el dinero no lo es todo. Los padres de San Felipe Benizi tuvieron problemas para tener hijos, como un sorprendente número de nuestros feligreses. Tras muchas oraciones a la Virgen, los padres de San Felipe Benizi pudieron concebir, y cuando lo tuvieron, quisieron lo mejor para él. Le enviaron a la Sorbona de París, lo que en aquella época equivalía a enviarle a Harvard o quizás a Berkely para que se convirtiera en médico (de nuevo, los padres de San Felipe tenían recursos).

Sin embargo, como ocurre en muchas familias, San Felipe tenía otras aspiraciones, al igual que al parecer María. Cuando regresó a casa, decidió unirse a los Servitas como simple hermano.

Cuando los Servitas se enteraron de su educación, le hicieron estudiar para ser sacerdote y luego le eligieron Prior General. Con cierta vergüenza, no dijo a sus padres que era el Prior General de los Servitas durante 8 años.

Pero encontrándose en una posición de cierta importancia, la utilizó para intentar conseguir que la Orden Servita fuera aprobada por la Santa Sede, un proyecto hercúleo que le envió a hacer recados por toda Italia y finalmente, tal vez frustrado porque "el papeleo no se hacía", por la leyenda le preguntaron si entonces le gustaría ser Papa, dijo rotundamente que no.

Finalmente, consiguió la aprobación de la Orden Servita, aunque, por desgracia, con "una licencia temporal", pero una vez completado ese asunto, utilizó el resto de su tiempo como Prior General haciendo lo que realmente le gustaba: simplemente visitando a los frailes, así como uniéndose a ellos para cocinar y limpiar (hay una preciosa foto suya trabajando en la cocina del Priorato Servita de Innsbruck y otra de él barriendo en alguna iglesia de Italia). Sí, hubo (algunos) milagros asociados a él. Sí, ayudó a algunas personas pobres y con problemas. Pero, por encima de todo, no era más que un tipo decente, con algunos talentos administrativos que prefería dejar de lado y limitarse a pasar tiempo con sus amigos (sus hermanos servitas). Y "lo consiguió".

¿No es bonito? Muchas veces nos preocupa no ser lo bastante buenos para Dios. En San Felipe, un santo bastante amable, se nos da la esperanza de que lo somos. ¡Feliz fiesta parroquial!
