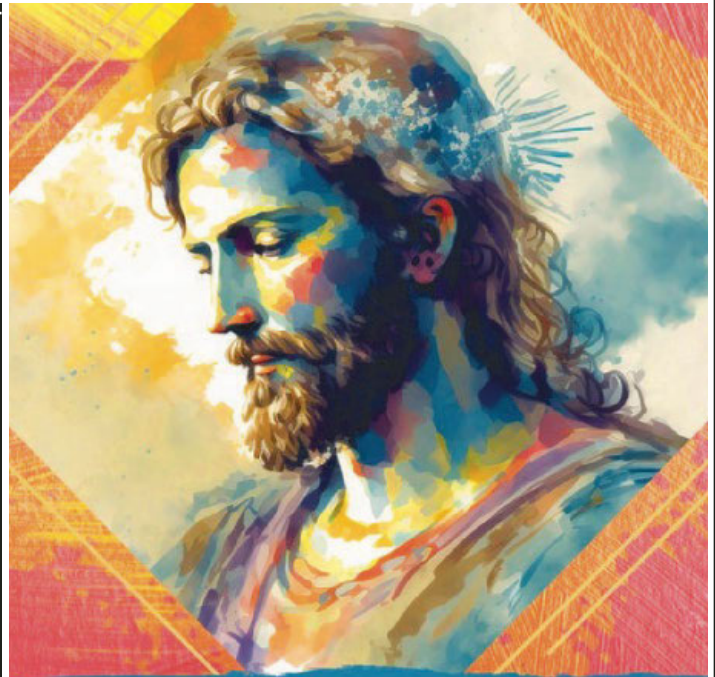

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

If last Sunday represented a “high point” in Jesus’ Disciples’ understanding of his mission and their place within it, this Sunday’s Readings remind us clearly that God’s way is not our way.

It is natural for us to hope that our faith in God / Jesus will help us to avoid the difficulties of life. In today’s Readings we hear that even the prophet Jeremiah and St. Peter had thought that this would be the case.

However, in our still at least partly broken world, it remains not the case.

Jesus reminds us that whoever truly wishes to be his disciple must “pickup their cross” and follow him. We have also been reminded that “no servant is greater than his master, no messenger greater than the one who sent him” and if Jesus was persecuted, then we ourselves will be persecuted as well.

So rather than look for ways to remain comfortable, as Jesus’ Disciples let us just seek to do what our conscience calls us to do. The faith of a mustard seed can move mountains. This does not mean that this would be easy, just that it is possible.

In the end, among the hardest things to deal with is regret: “I could have done something.” We cannot do everything, but we all can do something, and once we start moving, others are encouraged to respond and do their parts too.

And even if we don’t necessarily see our efforts succeed initially – imagine what Jesus would have seen initially from the Cross – nevertheless we are assured of God’s presence even in our hardest moments, and by remembering not merely the Cross, but also and above all the Resurrection, let us remember that ultimately all things will indeed end well.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Si el domingo pasado representó un "punto culminante" en la comprensión que los discípulos de Jesús tenían de su misión y del lugar que ocupaban en ella, las lecturas de este domingo nos recuerdan claramente que el camino de Dios no es nuestro camino.

Es natural que esperemos que nuestra fe en Dios / Jesús nos ayude a evitar las dificultades de la vida. En las lecturas de hoy oímos que incluso el profeta Jeremías y San Pedro habían pensado que así sería.

Sin embargo, en nuestro mundo todavía roto, al menos en parte, sigue sin ser así.

Jesús nos recuerda que quien quiera ser verdaderamente su discípulo debe "tomar su cruz" y seguirle. También nos recuerda que "ningún siervo es mayor que su señor, ningún mensajero mayor que el que le envió" y que si Jesús fue perseguido, nosotros también lo seremos.

Así que en lugar de buscar maneras de permanecer cómodos, como discípulos de Jesús busquemos simplemente hacer lo que nuestra conciencia nos llama a hacer. La fe de un grano de mostaza puede mover montañas. Esto no significa que sea fácil, sólo que es posible.

Al final, entre las cosas más difíciles de afrontar está el arrepentimiento: "Podría haber hecho algo". No podemos hacerlo todo, pero todos podemos hacer algo, y una vez que empezamos a movernos, los demás se animan a responder y hacer también su parte.

E incluso si no vemos necesariamente que nuestros esfuerzos tienen éxito al principio - imaginemos lo que Jesús habría visto al principio desde la Cruz-, sin embargo tenemos la seguridad de la presencia de Dios incluso en nuestros momentos más duros, y recordando no sólo la Cruz, sino también y sobre todo la Resurrección, recordemos que al final todas las cosas acabarán bien.

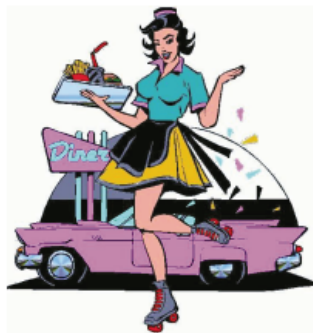

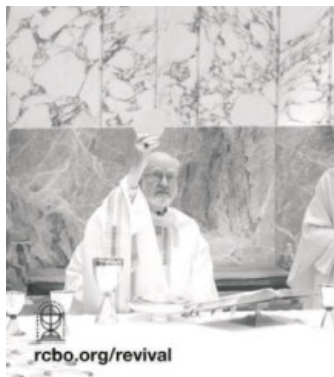
