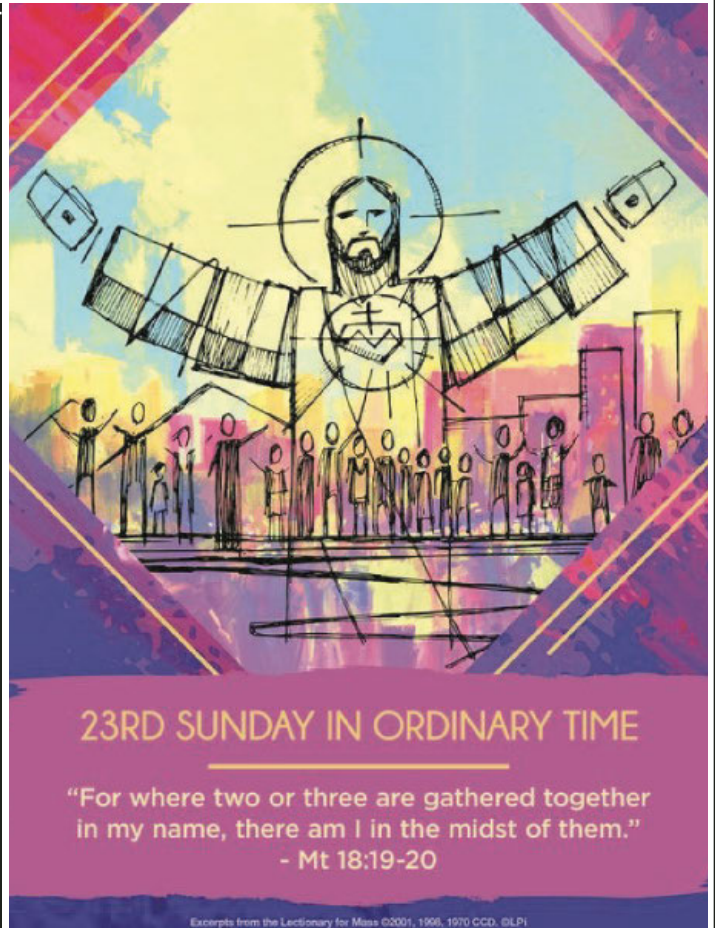

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday the Readings talk to us of what we have called "Fraternal Correction," about what to do when someone does something wrong, especially against us.

The First Reading coming from the Prophet Ezekiel calls us not to be blind. Indeed, the Reading reminds us that we have an appointed role to serve as guards both for the people and even for God.

Yet when we come to the Gospel Reading, we hear a clearly gentler tone: We are asked in the first case to deal with the problem directly with the person involved, then, if necessary, to bring 2-3 witness, and only afterwards to the whole church / community. And even if the person still does not listen, then to "treat the person as a pagan or tax collector" (How does Jesus tell us to treat those people? With kindness and continued respect).

This is not to say that sin does not exist or cause damage. Sin clearly exists and its consequences are often seen all around us. But we are not to make a game of this.

Some years back I realized that for all the talk of "bad behavior must have consequences" certainly common in our time, this is not the language of God. Indeed, it seems to me that God looks for excuses not to have to punish us, and instead seeks to lift us out of our difficulties of our own making (sin). Punishing people for their sins and failings seems to be the enthusiastic domain of Bond Villains, the mob and of Fascists.

So, what to do? In the first place, we are called to be (come) responsible ourselves. When someone is correcting us, there is a reason for it. And it is best to anticipate the problem by not falling into it. I tell that to kids all the time who come to Confession: "Just do your chores. If you do them, get them out of the way, then your parents will not have to remind you to do them. Indeed, they will be relieved that they do not have to do so and be happier as a result, making you happier as well. If on the other hand, they must use up their time to remind you to do your chores, they will become unhappier as a result and make us unhappier as well. So just doing the right thing helps everybody along."

So please let us seek to do the right thing, always. And in as much as we do, let see in that our contribution to making this world closer to the way our God wished it to be all along.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Este domingo las Lecturas nos hablan de lo que hemos llamado "Corrección Fraternal", sobre qué hacer cuando alguien hace algo mal, especialmente contra nosotros.

La primera lectura, del profeta Ezequiel, nos llama a no ser ciegos. De hecho, la lectura nos recuerda que nuestro papel es el de guardianes del pueblo e incluso de Dios.

Sin embargo, cuando llegamos a la lectura del Evangelio, escuchamos un tono claramente más suave: Se nos pide, en primer lugar, que tratemos el problema directamente con la persona implicada, después, si es necesario, que llevemos 2-3 testigos, y sólo después a toda la iglesia / comunidad. E incluso si la persona sigue sin escuchar, entonces "tratar a la persona como a un pagano o recaudador de impuestos" (¿Cómo nos dice Jesús que tratemos a esas personas? Con amabilidad y respeto continuo).

Esto no quiere decir que el pecado no exista o cause daño. El pecado existe claramente y sus consecuencias se ven a menudo a nuestro alrededor. Pero no debemos hacer de esto un juego.

Hace algunos años me di cuenta de que, por mucho que se hable de que "el mal comportamiento debe tener consecuencias", algo ciertamente común en nuestro tiempo, éste no es el lenguaje de Dios. De hecho, me parece que Dios busca excusas para no tener que castigarnos, y en su lugar busca sacarnos de las dificultades que nosotros mismos hemos creado (el pecado). Castigar a la gente por sus pecados y defectos parece ser el dominio entusiasta de los villanos de Bond, de la mafia y de los fascistas.

Entonces, ¿qué hacer? En primer lugar, estamos llamados a ser responsables nosotros mismos. Cuando alguien nos corrige, por algo será. Y lo mejor es anticiparse al problema no cayendo en él. Se lo digo siempre a los niños que vienen a confesarse: "Haz tus tareas. Si las hacéis, quitáoslas de en medio, entonces vuestros padres no tendrán que recordaros que las hagáis. Es más, se sentirán aliviados de no tener que hacerlo y, como consecuencia, estarán más contentos, haciéndote a ti también más feliz. Si, por el contrario, tienen que emplear su tiempo en recordarte que hagas tus tareas, se sentirán más infelices y nos harán más infelices a nosotros. Así que hacer lo correcto ayuda a todos".

Así que, por favor, procuremos hacer lo correcto, siempre. Y en la medida en que lo hagamos, veamos en ello nuestra contribución para hacer que este mundo se acerque más a la forma en que nuestro Dios deseó que fuera desde el principio.

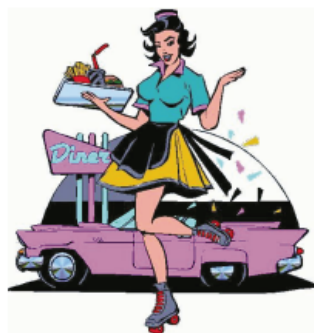
