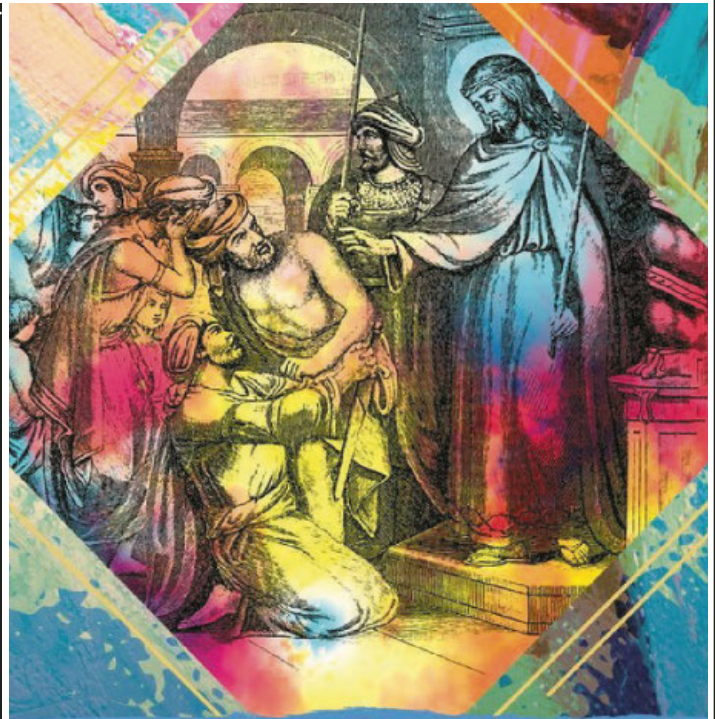

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday instead of the 24th Sunday of Ordinary Time, our Parish celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows, the principal Patroness of the Servite Order which has staffed this parish from its very beginning.

This is one of the three Sundays in which the Diocese allows us to celebrate a Servite Feast instead of the Sunday of the Ordinary Calendar. The other two Feasts that we can celebrate in this extraordinary way are the Feast of the Seven Holy Founders (on the Sunday closest to their Feast Day of February 17th) and the Feast of St. Philip Benizi, the Patron of the Parish (on the Sunday closest to his Feast Day of August 23rd).

Why does the Servite venerate in a peculiar way Mary as Our Lady of Sorrows? By tradition it was St. Philip Benizi who was responsible for the Servite adopting this Marian devotion as their own. Asked why the Servite Friars wear a habit identical to that of the Dominican Friars only black rather than the Dominican white, the future St. Philip Benizi answered: "Because we honor the widowhood of Mary."

This proved to be a fortuitous choice as 50 years later came the Great Plague which was responsible for killing 1/3 of Europe's population at the time. Many of those who survived, had personal experience with watching helplessly loved ones succumb to the illness and had great admiration for Mary who stood also beside her crucified Son as he died.

In subsequent centuries, the devotion has waxed and waned. However, it can give comfort to people who find themselves praying for loved ones in danger or peril, knowing that Mary experienced such pain and concern for her Son as well.

St. Paul wrote that in our own sufferings we complete what was missing in the Passion of the Lord. On this day we remember both that Mary's sufferings particularly at the Foot of the Cross were real, and that our own stories and sufferings matter (certainly to God) as well.

This may not be a cheerful feast but let us always remember that no matter what sufferings we may endure, we are never alone, that God, the Risen Jesus, Mary and all the Saints as well as our loved ones are with us as well.

May the Lord and His Mother accompany all those in our parish who find themselves in difficulty now.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Este domingo, en lugar del XXIV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, nuestra Parroquia celebra la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores, Patrona principal de la Orden Servita que atiende esta Parroquia desde sus inicios.

Este es uno de los tres domingos en los que la Diócesis nos permite celebrar una Fiesta Servita en lugar del Domingo del Calendario Ordinario. Las otras dos fiestas que podemos celebrar de esta manera extraordinaria son la fiesta de los Siete Santos Fundadores (el domingo más cercano a su fiesta, el 17 de febrero) y la fiesta de San Felipe Benizi, patrón de la parroquia (el domingo más cercano a su fiesta, el 23 de agosto).

¿Por qué los Servitas veneran de forma peculiar a María como Nuestra Señora de los Dolores? Según la tradición, fue San Felipe Benizi el responsable de que los Servitas adoptaran esta devoción mariana como propia. A la pregunta de por qué los frailes servitas llevan un hábito idéntico al de los frailes dominicos, sólo que negro en lugar del blanco dominico, el futuro San Felipe Benizi respondió: "Porque honramos la viudez de María".

Esto resultó ser una elección fortuita ya que 50 años más tarde llegó la Gran Peste que fue responsable de la muerte de 1/3 de la población europea de la época. Muchos de los que sobrevivieron tuvieron la experiencia personal de ver a sus seres queridos sucumbir indefensos a la enfermedad y sintieron gran admiración por María, que también estuvo junto a su Hijo crucificado mientras moría.

En los siglos posteriores, la devoción ha sufrido altibajos. Sin embargo, puede reconfortar a las personas que se encuentran rezando por sus seres queridos en peligro, sabiendo que María también experimentó ese dolor y preocupación por su Hijo.

San Pablo escribió que en nuestros propios sufrimientos completamos lo que faltaba en la Pasión del Señor. En este día recordamos tanto que los sufrimientos de María, especialmente al pie de la Cruz, fueron reales, como que nuestras propias historias y sufrimientos también importan (ciertamente a Dios).

Puede que no sea una fiesta alegre, pero recordemos siempre que, sean cuales sean los sufrimientos que padezcamos, nunca estamos solos, que Dios, Jesús resucitado, María y todos los santos, así como nuestros seres queridos, también están con nosotros.

Que el Señor y su Madre acompañen a todos aquellos de nuestra parroquia que se encuentran en dificultades ahora.


