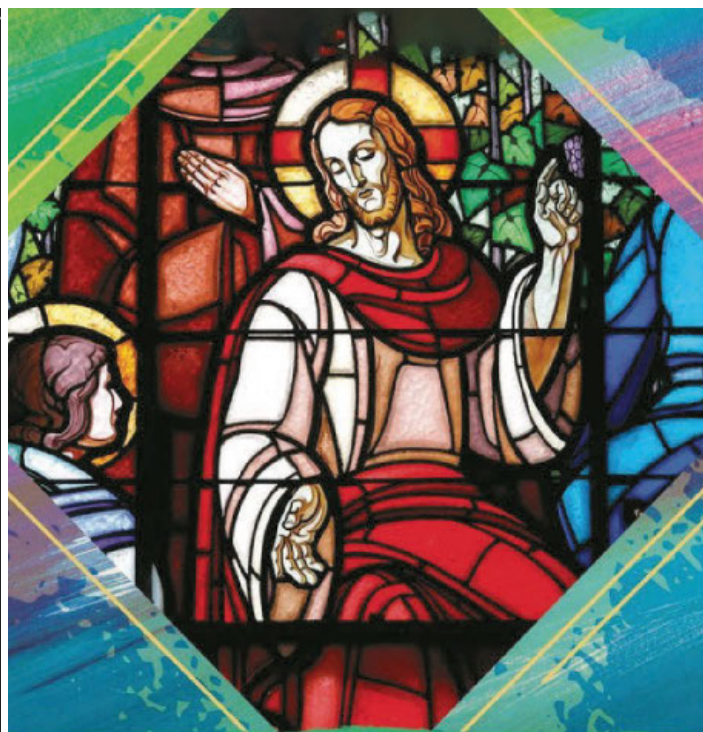

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

Not fair! All of us know how kids complain to their parents that they take the side of an irresponsible or otherwise badly behaving brother or sister over them.

In the Gospel Reading this Sunday we hear that God pays the people who “worked all day” in the vineyard the same as those who worked only the last hour. Not fair!

But then we are truly invited to put aside our thinking and put on the mindset of God: What is the alternative? Do we reject someone, send someone to Hell, simply because it took a bit long for someone to figure out their situation? We do not even know what the person went through before they got to the position to ask God for the job in the vineyard.

It is easy to dismiss the person and say they should have been quicker, more responsible etc. But we really do not know and cannot know the whole situation. And how would being cruel rather than kind help? Not giving the person coming late to a job with a living wage just leaves that person hungry and angry / desperate.

Over the years, I have already written of the mystic Meister Eckart’s observation that Heaven and Hell could be the same place, depending on our attitude.

An excellent example of this insight around us is the situation with our homeless brothers and sisters. We may find them annoying. We do find them annoying. But if we choose to do little for them, we ourselves reduce our own quality of life.

Yes, it is annoying – in the solemn words of our 8-year-olds, “it’s not fair”, to be kind to someone we may suspect is gaming the system. But the alternative leaves all of us unhappy.

So, let us seek to be kind, say a Hail Mary, two or three, when we are frustrated and honestly, do not want to be kind. But let us see in that an invitation to enter God’s world and hopefully let our hearts be changed.

It is not easy. But God more than “fair.” God is above all kind, and we can be(come) the same.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

¡No es justo! Todos sabemos que los niños se quejan a sus padres de que se pongan de parte de un hermano irresponsable o que se comporta mal.

En la lectura del Evangelio de este domingo oímos que Dios paga lo mismo a los que "trabajaron todo el día" en la viña que a los que sólo trabajaron la última hora. No es justo.

Pero entonces se nos invita de verdad a dejar a un lado nuestra manera de pensar y a ponernos la mentalidad de Dios: ¿Cuál es la alternativa? ¿Rechazamos a alguien, enviamos a alguien al Infierno, simplemente porque alguien tardó un poco en darse cuenta de su situación? Ni siquiera sabemos lo que la persona tuvo que pasar antes de llegar a la posición de pedirle a Dios el trabajo en la viña.

Es fácil descartar a la persona y decir que debería haber sido más rápida, más responsable, etc. Pero realmente no lo sabemos y no podemos hacerlo. Pero realmente no sabemos y no podemos conocer toda la situación. ¿Y en qué ayudaría ser cruel en lugar de amable? No dar a la persona que llega tarde un trabajo con un salario digno sólo deja a esa persona hambrienta y enfadada / desesperada.

A lo largo de los años, ya he escrito sobre la observación del místico Meister Eckart de que el Cielo y el Infierno podrían ser el mismo lugar, dependiendo de nuestra actitud.

Un ejemplo excelente de esta idea es la situación de nuestros hermanos y hermanas sin hogar. Puede que nos resulten molestos. Nos resultan molestos. Pero si decidimos hacer poco por ellos, nosotros mismos reducimos nuestra propia calidad de vida.

Sí, es molesto -en las solemnes palabras de nuestros niños de 8 años, "no es justo"- ser amables con alguien de quien sospechamos que se está aprovechando del sistema. Pero la alternativa nos hace infelices a todos.

Así pues, tratemos de ser amables, digamos un Ave María, dos o tres, cuando nos sintamos frustrados y, sinceramente, no queramos ser amables. Pero veamos en ello una invitación a entrar en el mundo de Dios y esperemos que nuestros corazones cambien.

No es fácil. Pero Dios es más que "justo". Dios es sobre todo amable, y nosotros podemos serlo.
