## PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday's Readings continue the theme of Biblical "fairness" with the nominally "good people" complaining that God (or Jesus) is not fair.

I've long began homilies on this theme noting that probably most of us of my age and above present at Mass were probably from among those who were "the good kids" in our families. We've probably been the ones that our parents depended on and so these Readings must at some level irritate us, especially if the homilist decides to preach directly on them.

There are, of course, all sorts of rhetorical tricks that one can do to switch the theme of one's reflection on something else. But if one looks at these Readings and those of last week directly, one can not avoid the disconcerting conclusion that we probably have far more in common with the Pharisees of Jesus' audience that we'd like to admit, and then we'd wonder why Jesus would have chosen to challenge them (and challenge us today) when honestly we've probably tried to be rather good people and even suffered for it at times. So what's going on here?

Here some of the traditional religious language of our parents and grandparents would probably become useful, specifically the adage that "God does not try us with more than we can handle."

And I write this knowing immediately that there are people in our community suffering right now, a great deal, and hence simply may not be able to hear those words now. So stop reading my article at this point and go to something else. There are lovely things announced each week throughout this bulletin. There will be a lovely "Blessing of the Animals" again this Sunday at 3:30 PM. The Women's Council is offering its lovely annual raffle. We will be praying the Rosary again all month, in the Plaza here each evening at 7 PM during the week and before each of the Sunday liturgies. There's a lovely collection for mother's in need today as well. And the Diocesan Eucharistic Congress is coming up on October 20-21. All these are wonderful things...

But let's get back to the challenge that Jesus occasionally gives us. We could feel it hard or even unfair, that we are faced at times with burdens that we do not understand. Or we can see in them God's confidence in us. God could have chosen to give that burden to someone else, but instead chose us, in part certainly because God felt that we could handle that burden perhaps better than someone else. And God also showers us with all kinds of other nicer gifts as well.

So even if we may at times feel that God is unfair, let us always remember that God really does love us, and to see in every challenge that he gives us an invitation to become better, greater, kinder than we were before.

The challenges that come to us in life don't go away in any case. Let us make the choice to see in them God's invitation to grow in one way or another in our faith and in our relationships with others.

## PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Las lecturas de este domingo continúan con el tema de la "justicia" bíblica, con la "gente buena" que se queja de que Dios (o Jesús) no es justo.

Llevo mucho tiempo comenzando las homilias sobre este tema señalando que probablemente la mayoría de los que tenemos mi edad o más y estamos presentes en la misa éramos "los niños buenos" de nuestras familias. Probablemente hemos sido aquellos de los que nuestros padres dependían y por eso estas Lecturas deben irritarnos en algún nivel, especialmente si el homilista decide predicar directamente sobre ellas.

Hay, por supuesto, todo tipo de trucos retóricos que uno puede hacer para cambiar el tema de su reflexión sobre otra cosa. Pero si uno examina directamente estas Lecturas y las de la semana pasada, no puede evitar la desconcertante conclusión de que probablemente tenemos mucho más en común con los fariseos del auditorio de Jesús de lo que nos gustaría admitir, y entonces nos preguntaríamos por qué Jesús habría elegido desafiarlos (y desafiarnos hoy) cuando honestamente probablemente hemos intentado ser bastante buenas personas e incluso hemos sufrido por ello a veces. Entonces, ¿qué ocurre aquí?

Aquí probablemente sería útil algo del lenguaje religioso tradicional de nuestros padres y abuelos, en concreto el adagio de que "Dios no nos prueba con más de lo que podemos manejar."

Y escribo esto sabiendo inmediatamente que hay gente en nuestra comunidad que está sufriendo ahora mismo, y mucho, y de ahí que simplemente no puedan escuchar esas palabras ahora. Así que dejen de leer mi artículo en este momento y dedíquense a otra cosa. Hay cosas preciosas anunciadas cada semana a lo largo de este boletín. Habrá una encantadora "Bendición de los Animales" de nuevo este domingo a las 3:30 PM. El Consejo de Mujeres ofrecerá su encantadora rifa anual. Estaremos rezando el Rosario de nuevo todo el mes, en la Plaza aquí cada tarde a las 7 PM durante la semana y antes de cada una de las liturgias dominicales. Hoy también hay una preciosa colecta para las madres necesitadas. Y el Congreso Eucarístico Diocesano se acerca el 20 y 21 de octubre. Todas estas son cosas maravillosas...

Pero volvamos al reto que Jesús nos plantea de vez en cuando. Podemos sentirlo duro o incluso injusto, que nos enfrentamos a veces con cargas que no entendemos. O podemos ver en ellas la confianza de Dios en nosotros. Dios podría haber elegido dar esa carga a otra persona, pero en lugar de eso nos eligió a nosotros, en parte seguramente porque Dios sintió que nosotros podíamos manejar esa carga quizás mejor que otra persona. Y Dios también nos colma de todo tipo de regalos más agradables.

Por eso, aunque a veces nos parezca que Dios es injusto, recordemos siempre que Dios nos ama de verdad, y veamos en cada reto que nos plantea una invitación a ser mejores, más grandes, más amables de lo que éramos antes.

Los desafíos que se nos presentan en la vida no desaparecen en ningún caso. Tomemos la decisión de ver en ellos la invitación de Dios a crecer de un modo u otro en nuestra fe y en nuestras relaciones con los demás.
