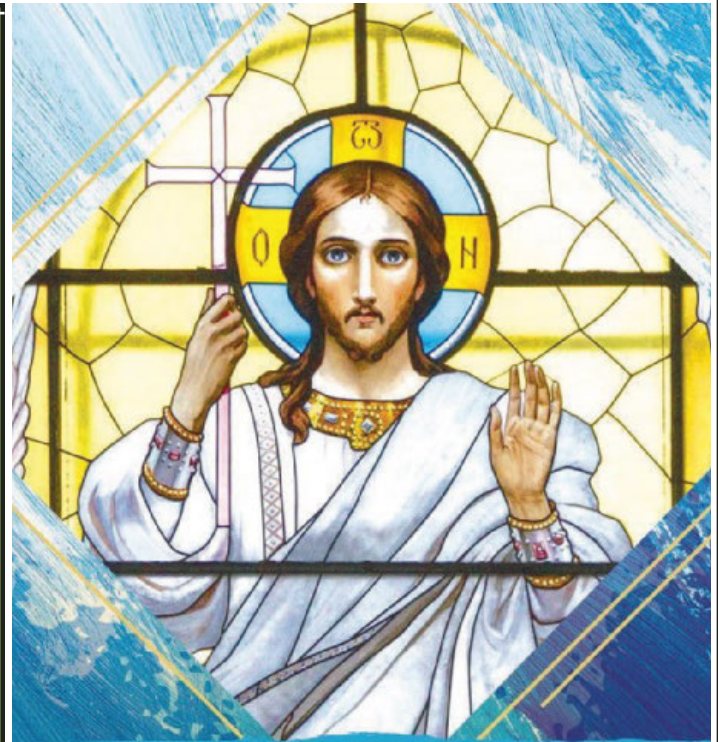

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday's readings continue a thematic unit in the Liturgical Cycle that is quite tough towards the pillars of the religious community of Jesus' time. In a sense, no wonder that they had Jesus killed!

What to make of this toughness of Jesus towards the people that perhaps he should have wooed?

A Jewish Theologian, Abraham Herschel, noted that the Prophets themselves used to be unbearably tough on the community of their time, with similar results.

Again, why would the Prophets have done that? And why would we want to hold them in esteem? After all, what the prophets and Jesus had said of the people of their own time can be quite easily applied to the people of our time as well.

What's going on?

Perhaps the best answer to these questions can be found in the psychology of Carl Jung: The Prophets (and Jesus) channel basically the thoughts of the subconscious, that which needs to be said, but for whatever reason we don't. And this, the Shadow, as Carl Jung would call it, serves as a counter-weight to the prevailing reality of the time, any time.

So ... when things go relatively well in Biblical Israel, the prophets jump up and down and criticize the people for the failings they overlook.

But ... and this is key ... when things end badly, this is when the Prophets, often the same prophets, start to start to talk of consolation, and new hope.

Jesus certainly challenged the people of his day, but he also treated them with love even as he did so. To the young man who told Jesus that he followed all the commandments from his childhood, Jesus responded with love and continued: "Now give up what you have and give to the poor." He didn't do this out of meanness. He did this out of love.

Let us see in the criticisms that all of us receive an invitation to try and do better.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Las lecturas de este domingo continúan una unidad temática del Ciclo Litúrgico que es bastante dura con los pilares de la comunidad religiosa del tiempo de Jesús. En cierto sentido, ¿no es de extrañar que mandaran matar a Jesús!

¿Qué pensar de esta dureza de Jesús con la gente a la que tal vez debería haber cortejado?

Un teólogo judío, Abraham Herschel, señaló que los propios Profetas solían ser insoportablemente duros con la comunidad de su tiempo, con resultados similares.

De nuevo, ¿por qué habrían hecho eso los Profetas? ¿Y por qué queríamos tenerlos en estima? Al fin y al cabo, lo que los profetas y Jesús habían dicho de la gente de su tiempo puede aplicarse también con bastante facilidad a la gente de nuestro tiempo.

¿Qué es lo que ocurre?

Quizá la mejor respuesta a estas preguntas se encuentre en la psicología de Carl Jung: Los Profetas (y Jesús) canalizan básicamente los pensamientos del subconsciente, aquello que hay que decir, pero que por alguna razón no decimos. Y esto, la Sombra, como la llamaría Carl Jung, sirve de contrapeso a la realidad imperante del momento, de cualquier momento.

Así que... cuando las cosas van relativamente bien en el Israel bíblico, los profetas saltan y critican al pueblo por los fallos que pasan por alto.

Pero... y esto es clave... cuando las cosas acaban mal, es cuando los profetas, a menudo los mismos profetas, empiezan a hablar de consuelo y de nueva esperanza.

Jesús desafió a la gente de su tiempo, pero también la trató con amor. Al joven que le dijo a Jesús que seguía todos los mandamientos desde su infancia, Jesús le respondió con amor y continuó: "Ahora deja lo que tienes y dáselo a los pobres". No lo hizo por mezquindad. Lo hizo por amor.

Veamos en las críticas que todos recibimos una invitación a intentar hacerlo mejor.
