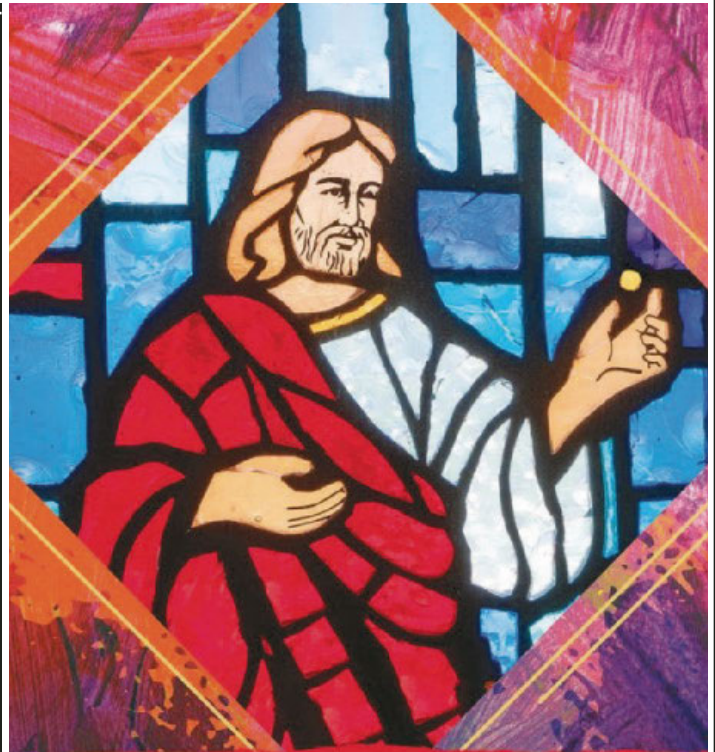

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

During this part of the Liturgical Year, we are repeatedly challenged by the Sunday Readings to be(come) better than we thought possible.

After hearing for several weeks how Jesus challenged the Scribes (the priests) and Pharisees (the active laity in synagogues), we hear of them striking back.

They gave Jesus a question that was certain to give him trouble: Should they as Jews be paying taxes to their Roman occupiers?

Yes there was anger in that question posed, but over the years, I've realized that there could have been a sincerity in it as well: "Okay, Jesus, you've been challenging us for all this time, let us invite you into our world and give you a question with which we are struggling with every day.

"If we tell the people who come to us with this question not to pay taxes to the Romans, we are sentencing both them and us to near certain punishment and death. But if we tell them to pay the taxes both we and they become collaborators with our occupiers. So, honestly, help us..."

Jesus' answer was a good one and for all seasons. There are all sorts of obligations that we may have with regards to all kinds of people, but Jesus asks us to remember that there is also an obligation to God.

That obligation to God can become the source of our freedom. True, we can clutter up our relationship with God with all sorts of other obligations. But at its base is a promise that God does not want to do that to us. The Jewish Community had been invited to meet God during its Day of Rest. Yes, they went to Synagogue, and we go to Mass. But at the end, it is only 1 to 1 ½ hours a week that comes with the invitation to take the rest of the day off. We should accept that invitation!

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Durante esta parte del Año Litúrgico, las lecturas dominicales nos desafían una y otra vez a ser mejores de lo que creíamos posible.

Después de oír durante varias semanas cómo Jesús desafiaba a los escribas (los sacerdotes) y a los fariseos (los laicos activos en las sinagogas), oímos que le devuelven el golpe.

Le hicieron a Jesús una pregunta que seguramente le causaría problemas: ¿Debían ellos, como judíos, pagar impuestos a sus ocupantes romanos?

Sí, había rabia en esa pregunta, pero con los años me he dado cuenta de que también podía haber sinceridad en ella: "De acuerdo, Jesús, nos has estado desafiando durante todo este tiempo, permítenos invitarte a nuestro mundo y plantearte una pregunta con la que estamos luchando cada día.

"Si le decimos a la gente que viene a nosotros con esta pregunta que no paguen impuestos a los romanos, los estamos condenando a ellos y a nosotros a un castigo casi seguro y a la muerte. Pero si les decimos que paguen los impuestos, tanto nosotros como ellos nos convertimos en colaboradores de nuestros ocupantes. Así que, sinceramente, ayúdanos..."

La respuesta de Jesús fue buena y para todos los tiempos. Hay todo tipo de obligaciones que podemos tener con respecto a todo tipo de personas, pero Jesús nos pide que recordemos que también hay una obligación con Dios.

Esa obligación para con Dios puede convertirse en la fuente de nuestra libertad. Es cierto que podemos desordenar nuestra relación con Dios con todo tipo de obligaciones. Pero en su base está la promesa de que Dios no quiere hacernos eso. La comunidad judía había sido invitada a encontrarse con Dios durante su Día de Reposo. Sí, iban a la Sinagoga, y nosotros vamos a Misa. Pero al final, es sólo de 1 a 1 ½ horas a la semana lo que viene con la invitación a tomar el resto del día libre. ¡Deberíamos aceptar esa invitación!

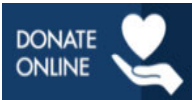
