## PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we approach the end of a lengthy section on of the Liturgical Year when we hear Jesus criticizing the pillars of the religious community of his time. We have one more Sunday to go before we change to a more Apocalyptic "things coming to an end" theme in the Liturgy as we approach the close of the Liturgical Year with the Feast of Christ the King at the end of November, prior to beginning a new Liturgical Year with the beginning of Advent.

This Sunday we asked to understand that what God asks of us could be summarized in two Commandments: (1) Love God, (2) Love our neighbors as ourselves.

And if there were to be a doubt in our minds about who we should consider our neighbors to be, we're told in the First Reading to not mistreat the "aliens," the "strangers" among us, that if we do, they will cry out of God, and God will hear them in the same way as God heard the cries of the Israelites in Egypt while they were in slavery.

Sometimes "others" can annoy us. Indeed, the famous existentialist philosopher Jean-Paul Sartre even declared one time that "Hell is other people."

But this is not the way God, or our Church has seen other people. Other people and Life are intended to be a blessing.

I remember that in the Seminary at one time I complained, that "I don't like Baroque Art much," that "it's just too busy."

Fr. Ed Penonzek, OSM responded to my complaint, explaining that we are to understand that the Baroque Era "as a celebration of life, where everything was portrayed as exploding with new life, new possibilities."

I then recalled that the Baroque Era came around the time of the end of the Thirty-Year War, and all sorts of other desperate Wars with the Turks, a time when the Church really could have become depressed focused on its misery. Instead, in every baroque painting anywhere, the sky was ripping open, and a superabundance of new life was coming in.

So, let us not complain that the people around us are different from us, let us not wish that we were all the same and performing the same tasks, except if ordered to do something else from above.

Let us see those around us as "completing us" and see in them the blessings that they intended to be.

## PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Este domingo nos acercamos al final de una larga sección del Año Litúrgico en la que escuchamos a Jesús criticar a los pilares de la comunidad religiosa de su tiempo. Nos queda un domingo más antes de que cambiemos a un tema más apocalíptico de "las cosas que llegan a su fin" en la Liturgia, mientras nos acercamos a la clausura del Año Litúrgico con la Fiesta de Cristo Rey a finales de noviembre, antes de comenzar un nuevo Año Litúrgico con el inicio del Adviento.

Este domingo pedimos entender que lo que Dios nos pide podría resumirse en dos Mandamientos: (1) Amar a Dios, (2) Amar al prójimo como a nosotros mismos.

Y por si nos quedara alguna duda sobre a quién debemos considerar nuestro prójimo, en la Primera Lectura se nos dice que no maltratemos a los "extranjeros", a los "forasteros" que hay entre nosotros, que, si lo hacemos, clamarán a Dios, y Dios los oirá del mismo modo que oyó los gritos de los israelitas en Egipto mientras estaban esclavizados.

A veces los "otros" pueden molestarnos. De hecho, el famoso filósofo existencialista Jean-Paul Sartre llegó a declarar una vez que "el infierno son los demás".

Pero no es así como Dios, o nuestra Iglesia, ha visto a las otras personas. Las otras personas y la Vida están destinadas a ser una bendición.

Recuerdo que en el Seminario me quejé una vez que "no me gusta mucho el Arte Barroco", que "es demasiado recargado".

El P. Ed Penonzek, OSM respondió a mi queja, explicando que debemos entender la Era Barroca "como una celebración de la vida, donde todo era retratado como explotando con nueva vida, nuevas posibilidades."

Entonces recordé que la Era Barroca llegó en la época del final de la Guerra de los Treinta Años, y todo tipo de otras guerras desesperadas con los turcos, una época en la que la Iglesia realmente podría haberse deprimido centrada en su miseria. En cambio, en todas las pinturas barrocas, el cielo se abría y entraba una superabundancia de vida nueva.

Así pues, no nos quejemos de que la gente que nos rodea sea diferente de nosotros, no deseemos ser todos iguales y realizar las mismas tareas, salvo si desde arriba se nos ordena hacer otra cosa.

Veamos a los que nos rodean como "completándonos" y veamos en ellos las bendiciones que pretendían ser.

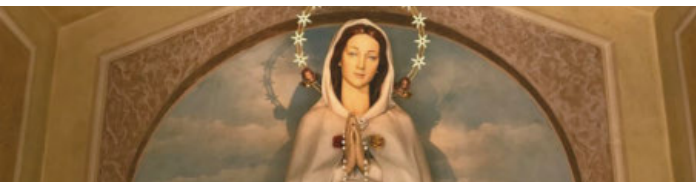
