PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

In these final weeks of the Liturgical Year, between the Feasts of All Saints / All Souls and Christ the King, the Readings become more Eschatological, more focused on the „Final Things.“ Hence the First Reading comes from the Prophet Malechi, one of the final prophets before the coming of Jesus.

The Gospel Reading also invites us to reflect on our attitude toward our faith: Do we try to leverage our Faith to make ourselves „more important,“ do we use our faith to „tie heavy burdens on others?“

I've long believed that the only legitimate use of power is to put it in the service of the common good, and then especially in the service of those in need. The rest is show.

Indeed, in these years at St. Philip's I've become cognizant that I've gotten to know more local leaders than Jesus ever did – many of you should recall by now that I've mentioned that only in the last 12 hours of Jesus' life did he meet any of the „important people“ of his time – the Chief Priest Caiaphas, Pilate and Herod (and together they all condemned him...). Instead, Jesus (God) spent his entire earthy life with regular and often problematic people.

As such in as much comes to have a hand on _any lever of power_ it better be used for the common good / those in need.

There's a woman whose been sleeping on our grounds on and off for the last several months, and more or less continuously for the last several weeks. Annoying, okay, yes, perhaps. But when we call to get her assistance, the shelters are full „for women.“ A victim of domestic violence, she was with me in my office as we called 10 separate numbers for domestic violence on Monday. Seven of those numbers were merely „hotlines“ which simply offered us other numbers to call, a fair number of their suggestions starting to repeat themselves, and the three others were all full. Only one told us to call back in a few days because they felt there may come to be an opening later in the week.

I hope this shocks you. How is it possible that in our day and time there would not be a shelter for a woman who's been a victim of domestic violence? This woman was all packed, twice, to go to a shelter, and both days, we completely struck-out, and certainly not without trying. Please call: OC Supervisor Doug Chaffee -- (714) 834-3100, and State Assembly member Sharon Quirk Silva (714) 521-6713 to ask for more funding IMMEDIATELY for DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTERS. Money for this would be there, we just have ask / demand it.

It's getting cold, our alternative is putting her up in a hotel room, but _understandably_ as a victim of domestic violence, she feels _uncomfortable_ if I pay for it. I get it, but honestly SOMEONE ELSE STEP UP, or at least CALL those numbers so that money can be found so that THESE PEOPLE can be protected with dignity.

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

En estas últimas semanas del Año Litúrgico, entre las fiestas de Todos los Santos / Todos los Difuntos y Cristo Rey, las Lecturas se vuelven más escatológicas, más centradas en las "Cosas Finales". De ahí que la Primera Lectura provenga del Profeta Malechi, uno de los últimos profetas antes de la venida de Jesús.

La Lectura del Evangelio también nos invita a reflexionar sobre nuestra actitud hacia nuestra fe: ¿Intentamos aprovechar nuestra Fe para hacernos "más importantes", utilizamos nuestra Fe para "atar pesadas cargas a los demás"?

Hace tiempo que creo que el único uso legítimo del poder es ponerlo al servicio del bien común, y especialmente al servicio de los necesitados. Lo demás es espectáculo.

De hecho, en estos años en San Felipe me he dado cuenta de que he llegado a conocer a más líderes locales de los que jamás conoció Jesús - muchos de vosotros recordaréis ya que he mencionado que sólo en las últimas 12 horas de la vida de Jesús conoció a alguna de las "personas importantes" de su tiempo - el Sumo Sacerdote Caifás, Pilato y Herodes (y todos juntos le condenaron...). En cambio, Jesús (Dios) pasó toda su vida terrenal con gente normal y a menudo problemática.

Como tal en cuanto llega a tener una mano en _cualquier palanca de poder_ mejor que sea usada para el bien común / los necesitados.

Hay una mujer que ha estado durmiendo en nuestro terreno de vez en cuando durante los últimos meses, y más o menos continuamente durante las últimas semanas. Molesta, vale, sí, quizás. Pero cuando llamamos para pedirle ayuda, los albergues están llenos "para mujeres". Víctima de violencia doméstica, estaba conmigo en mi despacho mientras llamábamos el lunes a 10 números distintos de violencia doméstica. Siete de esos números eran meras "líneas directas" que se limitaban a ofrecernos otros números a los que llamar, bastantes de cuyas sugerencias empezaban a repetirse, y los otros tres estaban todos llenos. Sólo uno nos dijo que volviéramos a llamar en unos días porque creían que podría llegar a haber una vacante más adelante en la semana.

Espero que esto les escandalice. ¿Cómo es posible que en nuestros días no haya un refugio para una mujer que ha sido víctima de violencia doméstica? Esta mujer tenía todo preparado, dos veces, para ir a un refugio, y ambos días, nos dimos de bruces, y no sin intentarlo. Por favor, llame: Supervisor de OC Doug Chaffee -- (714) 834-3100, y miembro de la Asamblea Estatal Sharon Quirk Silva (714) 521-6713 para pedir más fondos IMMEDIATAMENTE para REFUGIOS DE VIOLENCIA DOMÉSTICA. El dinero para esto estaría allí, sólo tenemos que pedirlo / exigirlo.

Está haciendo frío, nuestra alternativa es alojarla en una habitación de hotel, pero _comprensiblemente_ como víctima de violencia doméstica, se siente _incómoda_ si yo pago por ello. Lo entiendo, pero honestamente ALGUIÉN QUE SE APOYE, o al menos LLAME a esos números para que se pueda encontrar dinero para que ESTAS PERSONAS puedan ser protegidas con dignidad.
