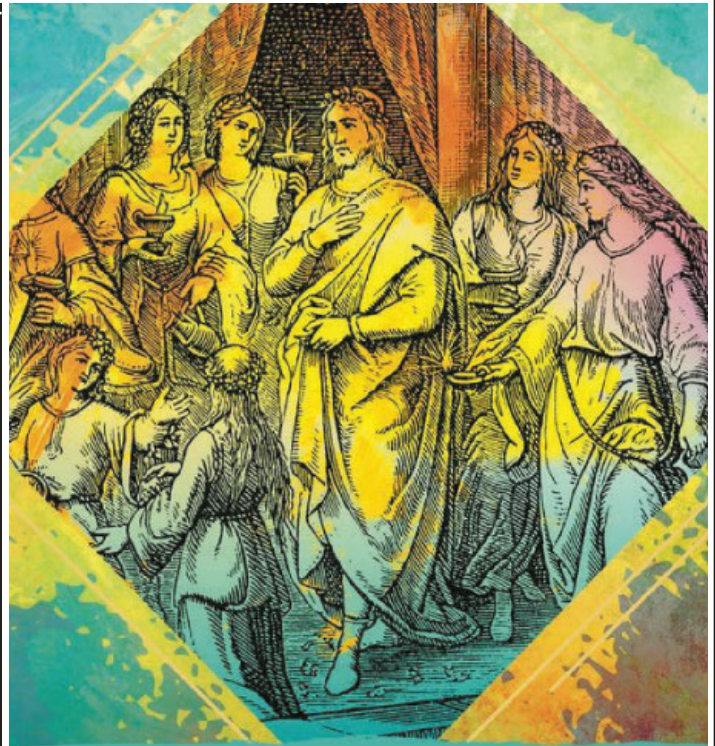

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

In these closing weeks of the Liturgical Year, the Readings become more Apocalyptic. But leave it to Jesus and the whole sense of his message of "Good News" to "de-escalate" something as dramatic as potentially traumatizing as "The End of the World" to a story of ten bridesmaids, five who were responsible and five who were not.

The message of Jesus was clear: we must be prudent; we must be ready. But on the other hand, the language was quite simple – just make sure you bought your flask of oil in time.

Now for years I found the more responsible girls' response to the flightier ones a bit mean. Where would one find a shop that was open near midnight to buy oil? I thought. But about 10 years ago, talking to Fr Albert, OSM an Indian classmate of mine, he noted that in the Middle Eastern / South Asian cultures, the central market would always be open throughout the night, and especially "if there was a big wedding going on." That was simply what good merchants did.

So ... it would not have been an impossibility for the girls without the oil to be able to buy their flasks of oil late. Indeed, the bigger problem would have been that they might have gotten distracted then while going to the market and/or coming back with the oil afterwards. If one has ever been to a Middle Eastern bazaar, there is a lot to get distracted by!

So then, there it is. We are asked to be prudent in our faith and fight against distraction, at least when it comes to the most important things in life.

We are all praying for Deacon Richard Doubledee as he fights his cancer. One thought that has always stuck with me regarding Deacon since I met him was his view that the most important question in our lives should be: Where do I want to spend Eternity? And to then guide one's life accordingly.

Yes, there are many things that are lovely in this world, created by God. But none of those things ought to distract us from our love and respect given to the God who made us and put us then into this world.

May we always seek to be wise even as we appreciate the gifts that God has given all of us!

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

En estas últimas semanas del Año Litúrgico, las lecturas se vuelven más apocalípticas. Pero dejemos que Jesús y todo el sentido de su mensaje de "Buena Nueva" "desescalen" algo tan dramático y potencialmente traumatizante como "El Fin del Mundo" a una historia de diez damas de honor, cinco que eran responsables y cinco que no lo eran.

El mensaje de Jesús era claro: debemos ser prudentes; debemos estar preparados. Pero, por otro lado, el lenguaje era bastante sencillo: asegúrate de comprar tu frasco de aceite a tiempo.

Durante años me pareció un poco mezquina la respuesta de las chicas más responsables a las más ligeras. ¿Dónde encontraría una tienda abierta cerca de medianoche para comprar aceite? pensaba yo. Pero hace unos 10 años, hablando con el P. Albert, OSM, un compañero mío de la India, observó que en las culturas de Oriente Próximo y del sur de Asia, el mercado central siempre estaba abierto durante toda la noche, y especialmente "si había una gran boda". Eso era simplemente lo que hacían los buenos comerciantes.

Así que... no habría sido una imposibilidad para las chicas sin el aceite poder comprar sus frascos de aceite tarde. De hecho, el mayor problema habría sido que se hubieran distraído mientras iban al mercado o volvían con el aceite. Si uno ha estado alguna vez en un bazar de Oriente Medio, ¡hay mucho en lo que distraerse!

Así pues, ahí está. Se nos pide que seamos prudentes en nuestra fe y luchemos contra la distracción, al menos cuando se trata de las cosas más importantes de la vida.

Todos rezamos por el diácono Richard Doubledee en su lucha contra el cáncer. Desde que le conocí, siempre me ha quedado grabada una idea del diácono: la pregunta más importante de nuestra vida debería ser: ¿Dónde quiero pasar la Eternidad? Y orientar la vida en consecuencia.

Sí, hay muchas cosas bonitas en este mundo, creado por Dios. Pero ninguna de esas cosas debe distraernos de nuestro amor y respeto al Dios que nos hizo y nos puso en este mundo.

Que siempre busquemos ser sabios, incluso cuando apreciamos los dones que Dios nos ha dado a todos.
