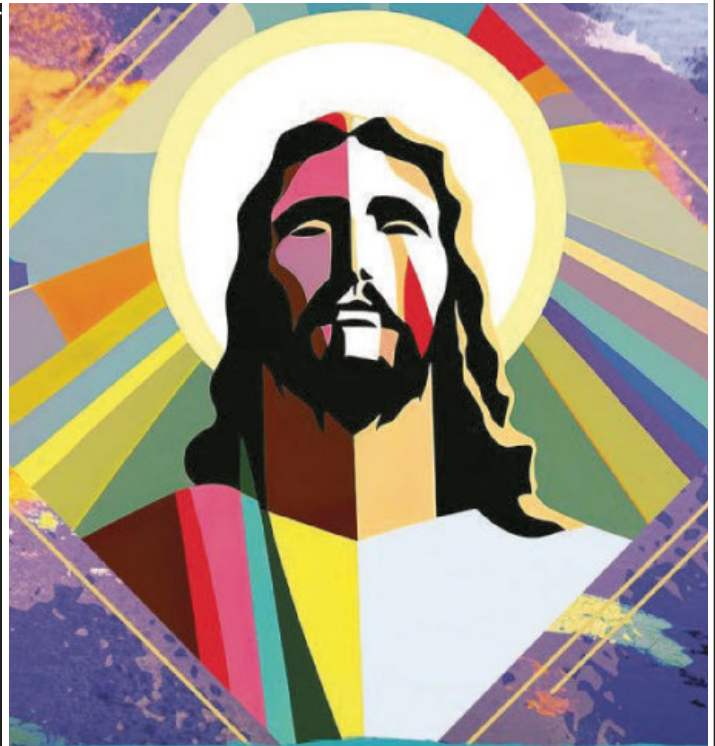

## PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

The Gospel Readings for these last few Sundays of the Liturgical Year are Apocalyptic in nature. Yet all things concerned, they are softer than our “go to” popular understanding of the term Apocalyptic.

This year, the Readings are mostly about choices. Last week, the Gospel Reading was about choosing to be prudent, prepared. This week, the Gospel Reading is about choosing to use the talents that we have received. Finally, next week the Gospel Reading will be about putting our gifts into the service of others.

In each case, we are given cases of people who chose wisely, and those who did not.

And if there is still any doubt in our minds about the apocalyptic theme for this year, the theme that brings the year to its close, the First Reading both this Sunday and last, is about Wisdom and the value of seeking it.

We do live in precarious times. There are now several wars going on that is more worrisome than wars of the recent past. Our Economy is clearly not going particularly well.

We have a major political candidate, who may win the White House (again) who sounds increasingly like someone who would be far more comfortable with living in or leading Germany or Italy of the 1930s than in the United States of that time, or really any other time.

Yet despite these challenges, we’re asked to continue to believe and continue to put our faith into action, to continue to pray, to continue to put one foot in front of the other, no matter what news at home or outside we wake up to.

Despite everything we can remain kind. Despite everything we can continue to choose to care.

Jesus came into the world and in the context of a people whose life was never easy but then experiencing a particularly tough time.

But Jesus didn’t put his attention on the presence of “Romans” (Roman Occupiers, arguably the first true Fascists) during the people he came to. Instead, he spent his entire time simply caring about regular people. We can look to do the same.

## PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses,

Los Evangelios de estos últimos domingos del Año Litúrgico son de naturaleza apocalíptica. Sin embargo, en general, son más suaves que nuestra interpretación popular del término "apocalíptico".

Este año, las lecturas tratan sobre todo de opciones. La semana pasada, la lectura del Evangelio trataba de elegir ser prudentes, estar preparados. Esta semana, la lectura del Evangelio trata sobre la elección de utilizar los talentos que hemos recibido. Por último, la semana que viene la lectura del Evangelio tratará de poner nuestros dones al servicio de los demás.

En cada caso, se nos presentan casos de personas que eligieron sabiamente, y de otras que no lo hicieron.

Y si aún nos queda alguna duda sobre el tema apocalíptico de este año, el tema que cierra el año, la Primera Lectura tanto de este domingo como del anterior, trata de la Sabiduría y del valor de buscarla.

Vivimos tiempos precarios. Ahora hay varias guerras en curso, lo que es más preocupante que las guerras del pasado reciente. Es evidente que nuestra economía no va especialmente bien.

Tenemos un candidato político importante, que puede ganar la Casa Blanca (otra vez) que suena cada vez más como alguien que estaría mucho más cómodo viviendo o dirigiendo la Alemania o la Italia de los años 30 que los Estados Unidos de esa época, o realmente de cualquier otra época.

Sin embargo, a pesar de estos desafíos, se nos pide que sigamos creyendo y que sigamos poniendo nuestra fe en acción, que sigamos rezando, que sigamos poniendo un pie delante del otro, sin importar con qué noticias en casa o fuera nos despertemos.

A pesar de todo, podemos seguir siendo amables. A pesar de todo, podemos seguir optando por preocuparnos.

Jesús vino al mundo y en el contexto de un pueblo cuya vida nunca fue fácil, pero que entonces vivía un momento especialmente duro.

Pero Jesús no puso su atención en la presencia de "romanos" (ocupantes romanos, posiblemente los primeros verdaderos fascistas) en el pueblo al que vino. En lugar de eso, dedicó todo su tiempo simplemente a preocuparse por la gente corriente. Nosotros podemos procurar hacer lo mismo.
