

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

(Superficially) what a difference a week makes! Last Sunday we were closing out the Liturgical Year, all in White, celebrating the Solemnity of Christ, King of the Universe, reminding us that the primary and goal in our lives is to be with Jesus the Christ for all eternity.

This weekend, we start the Liturgical Cycle all over. The Church is decorated in purple, the color of both penance and preparation. We have an Advent Wreath with four candles, to help us count down the Sundays to Christmas. Finally, we are reminded in the Readings of how the project of salvation and redemption of the world began.

This Sunday we are reminded that seeing the difficulties and injustices in the world, the Prophets predicted that "in the fullness of time" an Anointed One (Messiah) would come to set things right, but that the clock by which God and the Universe that he created runs at a quite different pace than our own:

It was many centuries, nearly a millennium before Jesus arrived after the Prophets first started preaching about him. And it's been more than two millennia since his arrival the first time.

Yet Jesus also tells us in the Gospel Reading that it is truly by God's time that these matters are set and that he could really come any time, and so then to be prepared.

This latter message is important for us to hear, and on multiple levels. There is plenty in our time that could make us anxious. There are wars, we just passed through a worldwide pandemic, as almost always the economy feels precarious and the speed at which the world runs seem to go faster every year.

Yet, if we take a few steps back to gain a better perspective, we should be able to see that every time offers plenty to be anxious about, from wars, to plagues, to economic, political, and even theological uncertainties.

What we are asked to do is to simply focus on Jesus during the uncertainties that we face. And if we do so, then whether God comes for us today, tomorrow, or whenever we will be ready to meet him, and the concerns of the world will no longer be a problem.

So, the Message this Sunday is not completely different from last Sunday or every Sunday. Let us continue to focus on Jesus and all will turn out fine.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos feligreses,

(Superficialmente) ¡Qué diferencia hace una semana! El domingo pasado estábamos cerrando el Año Litúrgico, todos de Blanco, celebrando la Solemnidad de Cristo, Rey del Universo, recordándonos que lo primordial y la meta en nuestras vidas es estar con Jesús el Cristo por toda la eternidad.

Este fin de semana, comenzamos de nuevo el Ciclo Litúrgico. La Iglesia está decorada de morado, el color de la penitencia y de la preparación. Tenemos una Corona de Adviento con cuatro velas, para ayudarnos a contar los domingos hasta Navidad. Por último, las lecturas nos recuerdan cómo comenzó el proyecto de salvación y redención del mundo.

Este domingo se nos recuerda que viendo las dificultades e injusticias del mundo, los Profetas predijeron que "en la plenitud de los tiempos" un Ungido (Mesías) vendría a poner las cosas en su sitio, pero que el reloj con el que Dios y el Universo que creó funciona a un ritmo bastante diferente al nuestro:

Pasaron muchos siglos, casi un milenio antes de que Jesús llegara después de que los Profetas empezaran a predicar sobre él. Y han pasado más de dos milenios desde su llegada la primera vez.

Sin embargo, Jesús también nos dice en la lectura del Evangelio que es realmente por el tiempo de Dios que estas cuestiones se establecen y que en realidad podría venir en cualquier momento, y por lo tanto a estar preparados.

Este último mensaje es importante que lo escuchemos, y a varios niveles. Hay muchas cosas en nuestro tiempo que podrían inquietarnos. Hay guerras, acabamos de pasar por una pandemia mundial, como casi siempre la economía se siente precaria y la velocidad a la que corre el mundo parece ir más deprisa cada año.

Sin embargo, si damos unos pasos atrás para tener una mejor perspectiva, deberíamos ser capaces de ver que cada tiempo ofrece mucho por lo que estar ansiosos, desde guerras a plagas, pasando por incertidumbres económicas, políticas e incluso teológicas.

Lo que se nos pide es que simplemente nos centremos en Jesús durante las incertidumbres a las que nos enfrentamos. Y si lo hacemos así, tanto si Dios viene a buscarnos hoy, mañana o cuando sea, estaremos preparados para encontrarnos con Él, y las preocupaciones del mundo dejarán de ser un problema.

Así pues, el Mensaje de este domingo no es completamente distinto del del domingo pasado ni del de todos los domingos. Sigamos centrándonos en Jesús y todo saldrá bien.
