PASTORS PONDERINGS**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Dear Parishioners,

The Season of Advent is both a challenging time and a season of hope.

In the Gospel Reading we hear the Authorities of Jesus' time coming out to ask John the Baptist who he was.

John responded that he was no one of immense importance, simply one calling people to repentance and to "prepare the way of the Lord."

Why? Because he and many of the Prophets before him saw all that was still flawed and broken in the world and what it could become.

Sometimes we focus more on the Prophets' condemnations of their times and forget that they also preached about how things would be when the anointed one came.

Some of those prophesies we hear in the First Reading throughout this Season of Advent.

The first two Sundays we heard prophecies from Isaiah which talked of the peace, tranquility and beauty that would come at the end of the messianic age.

This Sunday, as we approach closer to our annual celebration of Christmas, the passage we hear is already more down to earth, and one which Jesus himself used to proclaim the beginning of his mission:

To bring glad tidings to the poor, to heal the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and release to the prisoners, to announce a year of favor from the LORD.

And that message of Jesus has resounded in the world ever since.

Yes, there are still many things flawed and broken in this world, but with the arrival of Jesus and then anointing of the Church, Christ's Body, us, together, by the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, God is and remains active in the world.

And yes, every day, every year, things are getting better even if we do not necessarily always see it. So then in this Season of Advent we give thanks for Christ's coming, and joyfully await his return. A happy rest of Advent to all!

El tiempo de Adviento es a la vez un tiempo desafiante y un tiempo de esperanza.

En la lectura del Evangelio oímos a las Autoridades del tiempo de Jesús salir a preguntar a Juan el Bautista quién era.

Juan respondió que no era nadie de inmensa importancia, simplemente alguien que llamaba a la gente al arrepentimiento y a "preparar el camino del Señor".

¿Por qué? Porque él y muchos de los Profetas que le precedieron vieron todo lo que aún había de imperfecto y roto en el mundo y en lo que podía convertirse.

A veces nos centramos más en las condenas de los Profetas de su tiempo y olvidamos que también predicaron sobre cómo serían las cosas cuando viniera el ungido.

Algunas de esas profecías las escuchamos en la Primera Lectura a lo largo de este Tiempo de Adviento.

Los dos primeros domingos escuchamos profecías de Isaías que hablaban de la paz, la tranquilidad y la belleza que llegarían al final de la era mesiánica.

Este domingo, a medida que nos acercamos a la celebración anual de la Navidad, escuchamos un pasaje más realista, que el propio Jesús utilizó para proclamar el comienzo de su misión:

Llevar la buena nueva a los pobres, curar a los quebrantados de corazón, proclamar la libertad a los cautivos y la liberación a los prisioneros, anunciar un año de gracia de Yahveh.

Y ese mensaje de Jesús ha resonado en el mundo desde entonces.

Sí, todavía hay muchas cosas defectuosas y rotas en este mundo, pero con la llegada de Jesús y luego la unción de la Iglesia, el Cuerpo de Cristo, nosotros, juntos, por el Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés, Dios es y sigue siendo activo en el mundo.

Y sí, cada día, cada año, las cosas mejoran, aunque no siempre lo veamos. Así pues, en este tiempo de Adviento damos gracias por la venida de Cristo y esperamos con alegría su regreso. ¡Feliz resto de Adviento a todos!


