PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

After 4 weeks of preparation for the Christmas Season and then 2 ½ weeks of celebrating the season, we find ourselves again in Ordinary Time.

If the past month and a half have seemed relatively breathless, this Sunday after the Celebration of Christmas generally leaves us still at the site of Jesus' Baptism. This allows us to reflect a little bit more on the event that occurred there and that after centuries of waiting for the Anointed one to come and then 30 years of waiting after his arrival with Jesus' Baptism in the Jordan, finally his Messianic Program was about to begin.

And certainly, Jesus' Baptism was remembered an event befitting the mission on which he was to embark, though as we hear in John's Gospel, the drama may have been more internal than external.

Sometime after Jesus' baptism, we read in John's Gospel that he runs into a number of his future Disciples. The encounter didn't seem particularly life changing at the time, but at Jesus' invitation, they "came and saw" and their lives came to be changed irrevocably.

Indeed, God's voice, God's invitation is repeatedly presented in our Scriptures as gentle, unassuming to a fault:

Moses saw a burning bush in the distance, that after some time, he discovered didn't seem to burn out. When after some further time, he decided to approach it, he ... found God.

Elijah one day had been given a premonition that he would encounter God, and yet in the midst of storms and earthquakes he experienced nothing, until he heard a quiet whispering voice, which he immediately recognized as that of God.

In the first Reading today, the future Prophet Samuel is invited by a similar voice to come follow him.

And in the Gospel Reading today, it is in a similar, unassuming voice that Jesus invited his first disciples to "come and see" and they came to follow him.

Let us be open to the unassuming voices in our own lives that call us to come closer to God.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos feligreses,

Después de 4 semanas de preparación para la temporada navideña y luego 2 semanas y media de celebración de la temporada, nos encontramos nuevamente en el Tiempo Ordinario.

Si el último mes y medio podía parecer casi una corrida, este domingo después de la celebración de Navidad generalmente nos deja todavía en el lugar del Bautismo de Jesús. Esto nos permite reflexionar un poco más sobre el evento ocurrido allí y que después de siglos de espera para que viniera el Ungido y luego 30 años de espera después de su llegada con el Bautismo de Jesús en el Jordán, finalmente se trataba de su Programa Mesiánico. empezar.

Y ciertamente el bautismo de Jesús fue recordado como un acontecimiento que acorde con la misión que debía emprender, aunque, como escuchamos en el Evangelio de Juan, el drama puede haber sido más interno que externo.

Algún tiempo después del bautismo de Jesús, leemos en el Evangelio de Juan que se encuentra con varios de sus futuros discípulos. El encuentro no pareció cambiar sus vidas en particular en ese momento, pero por invitación de Jesús, "vinieron y vieron" y sus vidas cambiaron irrevocablemente.

De hecho, la voz de Dios, la invitación de Dios, se presenta repetidamente en nuestras Escrituras como gentil y sin pretensiones hasta el extremo:

Moisés vio a lo lejos una zarza ardiendo, que después de un tiempo descubrió que no parecía apagarse. Cuando después de algún tiempo decidió acercarse, él... encontró a Dios.

Un día, Elías tuvo la premonición de que se encontraría con Dios, y sin embargo, en medio de tormentas y terremotos no experimentó nada, hasta que escuchó una voz susurrante y tranquila, que inmediatamente reconoció como la de Dios.

En la primera lectura de hoy, una voz similar invita al futuro profeta Samuel a seguirlo.

Y en la lectura del Evangelio de hoy, es con una voz similar y sencilla que Jesús invitó a sus primeros discípulos a "vengan y vean" y vinieron a seguirlo.

Estemos abiertos a las voces sencillas en nuestras propias vidas que nos llaman a acercarnos a Dios.
