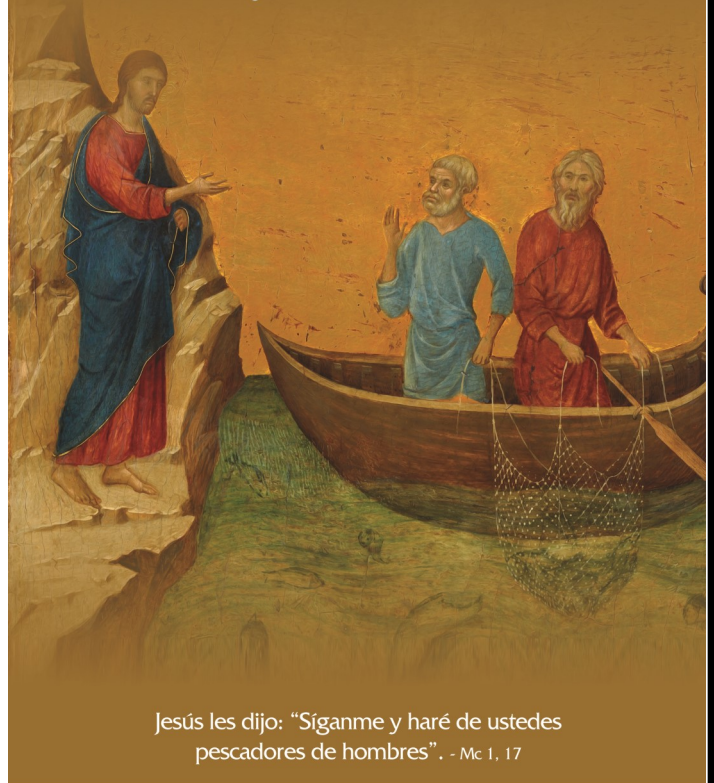

**PASTORS PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

If last Sunday's Readings were about the gentleness of God's call to us, this Sunday's Readings express God's request for a clear decisive reply.

The First Reading today reminds us of Jonah's unambiguous message to the Ninevites: "(For your sins) in 40 days your city will be destroyed," and then the Ninevite's clear, unambiguous response with the city proclaiming a universal fast and the whole city putting on sack-cloth. Finally, as a result God repented of his punishment.

In the Gospel Reading we hear of Mark's version of Jesus' call of his first disciples: Jesus passed by the shore of the Sea of Galilee. He saw Simon Peter and Andrew and called them. They dropped what they were doing and followed him. Further on, he saw James and John, the sons of Zebedee, in a fishing boat with their father. Again, he called them, and they dropped what they were doing, and left their father in the boat to follow him.

In both cases, there was no space for hesitation.

Moments like these do come in our lives, and we do need to act. In the end, we do have to be clear, we do have to put aside what does not matter and put God / Jesus first.

What's the payoff? Well, we heard in the First Reading that the Ninevites faced certain destruction. And they had their "Come to Jesus moment" realizing that if they don't change, they are doomed. Many who faced addiction could tell similar stories, when they realized that if they do not change, they were facing certain failure / destruction.

Jesus also reminds us, that at stake is not simply our earthly life, or our physical bodies, which we may have largely squandered by this point. Instead, it's about our very soul. From the cross he promised a thief who was dying with him eternal redemption. Until the last moment of life there's still the opportunity to change, to be redeemed. But afterwards, all our cards have been played. At that point it's too late.

In the case of the Gospel Reading, it's a different story. An invitation comes, perhaps a surprising one, but one which is clear. Choose this and your life will change, right there, and for the (morally) better. Decide to let it go, well, God's Will will be done anyway, we're not necessarily going to be abandoned, but our destiny will be changed, diminished as well.

When key moments in our lives come, let us pray that we may indeed choose well.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos feligreses,

Si las lecturas del domingo pasado hablaban de la suave manera en que Dios nos llama, las lecturas de este domingo expresan que Dios pide por una respuesta clara y decisiva de nosotros.

La Primera Lectura de hoy nos recuerda el mensaje inequívoco de Jonás a los ninivitas: "(Por sus pecados) en 40 días su ciudad será destruida", y luego la respuesta clara e inequívoca de los ninivitas con la ciudad proclamando un ayuno universal y toda la ciudad vistió en sayal. Finalmente, como resultado, Dios se arrepintió de su castigo.

En la lectura del Evangelio escuchamos la versión de San Marcos del llamado de Jesús a sus primeros discípulos: Jesús pasó por la orilla del mar de Galilea. Vio a Simón Pedro y a Andrés y los llamó. Ellos dejaron lo que estaban haciendo para seguirlo. Más adelante vio a Santiago y Juan, los hijos de Zebedeo, en un barco de pesca con su padre. De nuevo los llamó y ellos dejaron lo que estaban haciendo y dejaron a su padre en la barca para seguirlo.

En ambos casos no hubo lugar para dudas.

Momentos como estos llegan a nuestras vidas y necesitamos actuar. Al final sí que tenemos que ser claros, sí que tenemos que dejar de lado lo que no importa y poner a Dios/Jesús en primer lugar.

¿Cuál es la recompensa? Bueno, escuchamos en la Primera Lectura que los ninivitas enfrentaban una destrucción segura. Y tuvieron su "momento de decisión" al darse cuenta de que si no cambian, están condenados. Muchos de los que enfrentaron la adicción pudieron contar historias similares, cuando se dieron cuenta de que si no cambiaban, se enfrentaban a un fracaso/ destrucción segura.

Jesús también nos recuerda que lo que está en juego no es simplemente nuestra vida terrenal o nuestros cuerpos físicos, que a estas alturas quizá ya hayamos desperdiciado en gran medida. Más bien, se trata de nuestra propia alma. Desde la cruz prometió a un ladrón que agonizaba con él la eterna redención. Hasta el último momento de la vida todavía existe la oportunidad de cambiar, de ser redimido. Pero después se han jugado todas nuestras cartas. En ese momento ya es demasiado tarde.

En el caso de la lectura del Evangelio, es una historia diferente. Llega una invitación, quizás sorprendente, pero clara. Elige esto y tu vida se cambiará, allí mismo y para mejor. Decide dejarlo ir, bueno, la Voluntad de Dios se hará de todos modos, no necesariamente vamos a ser abandonados, pero nuestro destino será cambiado, disminuido también.

Cuando lleguen momentos claves en nuestras vidas, pedimos para que realmente podamos elegir bien.

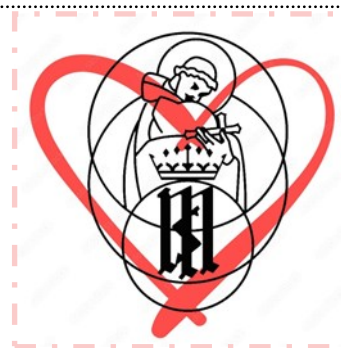
