PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This year we are following Mark's Gospel. It is the shortest of the four Canonical Gospels. Today it is generally considered to be the oldest of the four.

Indeed, since about 90% of the content of Mark's Gospel is also found in the Gospels of Matthew and Luke, scholars assume that the writers of those two Gospels already had on hand Mark's Gospel when they set about writing their own.

The writer then of John's Gospel, by tradition the Apostle John, then seemed to write his Gospel as a companion piece to the other three – sometimes he offers his own version of the events presented in the other three. Sometimes he seems to further explain and deepen the meaning of the events presented in the other three.

Together the four Gospels tell the story, or all that the Church has felt that we need to know, about both Jesus and his mission for our own salvation. Anything "extra" while at times nice, even salutary, isn't deemed necessary by the Church for our salvation or even spiritual growth.

Returning to Mark's Gospel. There's a breathlessness to it. It does not dwell on Jesus' first thirty years of life here among us. Instead, it begins with his baptism, sends him into the desert afterwards for 40 days, then sets him immediately on his mission.

Indeed, it would be worthwhile to take note of how often the word "Immediately" appears in Mark's Gospel, especially in the early chapters.

So then ... how can this knowledge relate to us, or even in our understanding of the Gospel Reading today?

Mark's Gospel presents Jesus as one who, when his hour had come, was urgently committed to his task. The "fullness of time had come," and so he set to work.

Last Sunday, we heard him call his first disciples. This Sunday, we hear him, silencing a Spirit who both knew who he was, and sought to be in his way. Next week he will set about to heal a loved one of one of his early disciples. Again, the fullness of time had come, it was time for action.

Let us appreciate that all of us are here for a not altogether long period of time and let us use the talents that we have the best as we can to fulfill God's will for us and those around us.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

Este año seguimos el Santo Evangelio según San Marcos. Es el más corto de los cuatro Evangelios canónicos. Hoy en día se considera generalmente el más antiguo de los cuatro.

De hecho, dado que alrededor del 90% del contenido del Evangelio de San Marcos también se encuentra en los Evangelios de San Mateo y San Lucas, los estudiosos suponen que los escritores de esos dos Evangelios ya tenían a mano el Evangelio de Marcos cuando se dispusieron a escribir el suyo propio.

El escritor entonces del Evangelio de San Juan, por tradición el apóstol San Juan, pareció escribir su Evangelio como pieza complementaria de los otros tres; a veces ofrece su propia versión de los acontecimientos presentados en los otros tres. A veces parece buscar explicar más, o profundizar el significado de los hechos presentados en los otros tres.

Juntos, los cuatro Evangelios cuentan la historia, o todo lo que la Iglesia ha sentido que necesitamos saber, tanto sobre Jesús como sobre su misión para nuestra propia salvación. La Iglesia no considera necesario cualquier cosa "extra", aunque a veces sea agradable, incluso saludable, para nuestra salvación o incluso nuestro crecimiento espiritual.

Volviendo al Evangelio de San Marcos. Hay una falta de aliento. No se detiene en los primeros treinta años de vida de Jesús aquí entre nosotros. De hecho, comienza con su bautismo, luego lo envía al desierto durante 40 días y luego lo pone inmediatamente en su misión.

Valdría la pena tomar nota de la frecuencia con la que aparece la palabra "inmediatamente" en el Evangelio de Marcos, especialmente en los primeros capítulos.

Entonces... ¿cómo puede este conocimiento relacionarse con nosotros, o incluso con nuestra comprensión de la lectura del Evangelio hoy?

El Evangelio de San Marcos presenta a Jesús como alguien que cuando "llegó su hora" se comprometió urgentemente a su tarea. "Había llegado la plenitud de los tiempos", y entonces se puso a trabajar.

El domingo pasado lo escuchamos llamar a sus primeros discípulos. Este domingo lo escuchamos silenciando a un Espíritu que sabía quién era y buscaba interponerse en su camino. La próxima semana se dedicará a sanar a un ser querido de uno de sus primeros discípulos. Nuevamente había llegado la plenitud del tiempo, era hora de actuar.

Apreciemos que todos estamos aquí por un período de tiempo no del todo largo, y usemos los talentos que tenemos lo mejor que podamos, para cumplir la voluntad de Dios para nosotros y quienes nos rodean.
