**PASTORS PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

I've long found it comforting that one of the first miracles that Jesus performs, in his public ministry, was that he healed Simon-Peter's mother-in-law.

In this miracle, I've long seen true proof of Jesus' humanity: Simon-Peter, one of Jesus' early disciples, whose call at the seashore we recalled two Sundays ago, had a family. He couldn't completely just pick-up and leave. And perhaps the visible symbol of Simon-Peter's previously contracted obligations was his mother-in-law.

Perhaps Simon-Peter could even get his wife to go along with the idea that he could leave his work and family to follow this new, if charismatic preacher.

However, our mothers are often our strongest advocates, symbols to all, that we have people who love us. And so Jesus, the Second Person, incarnate, of the Most Holy Trinity, God, had to come into Simon Peter's house, and heal, raise up Simon-Peter's mother-in-law, before Simon-Peter really could leave with him on his mission.

And yet, that is exactly what Jesus did. He came over to Simon Peter's house, and healed his mother-in-law, so much so that she got up and (we assume) cheerfully from that point on served Jesus and his guests. Perhaps most importantly, afterwards, Simon-Peter could leave his home in peace, and perhaps even with his mother-in-law's blessing, to follow Jesus.

God cares and understands that following him requires a certain alignment of circumstances, among them a certain peace at home.

This may be useful to us in the years ahead, reminding us that God doesn't want us or even need us to be heroes beyond our capacities, that God will help us be set free.

There were many, many things wrong with the world at the time of Jesus. He didn't send his disciples out as sheep for the slaughter to correct them.

Instead, we hear today that he entered the house of one simple man to help him to be set free ... to follow him.

In the coming years many "mountains may fall, and hills turn to dust," but in the end following Jesus will be the only thing that really matters.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos feligreses,

Ya por mucho tiempo me reconforté que uno de los primeros milagros que Jesús hizo, en su ministerio público, fue que curó a la suegra de Simón Pedro.

En este milagro, he visto por mucho tiempo una verdadera prueba de la humanidad de Jesús: Simón Pedro, uno de los primeros discípulos de Jesús, cuyo llamado a la orilla del mar recordamos hace dos domingos, tenía una familia. No podía simplemente dejar todo e irse. Y quizás el símbolo visible de las obligaciones contraídas previamente por Simón Pedro fuera su suegra.

Quizás Simón Pedro podría convencer que su esposa aceptara la idea de que él podía dejar su trabajo y su familia para seguir a este nuevo, aunque carismático, predicador.

Sin embargo, nuestras madres suelen ser nuestras más firmes defensoras, símbolos para todos de que tenemos personas que nos aman. Y así Jesús, la encarnada Segunda Persona de la Santísima Trinidad, Dios, tuvo que entrar en la casa de Simón Pedro, y curar y levantar a la suegra de Simón Pedro antes de que Simón Pedro realmente salir con él en su misión.

Pero eso es exactamente lo que hizo Jesús. Llegó a la casa de Simón Pedro y sanó a su suegra, tanto que ella se levantó y (esperamos) alegremente desde ese momento sirvió a Jesús y a sus invitados. Quizás lo más importante es que después Simón Pedro pudo salir de su casa en paz, y tal vez con la bendición de su suegra, para seguir a Jesús.

Dios se preocupa y comprende que seguirlo requiere cierta alineación de circunstancias, y entre ellas cierta paz en el hogar.

Esto puede ser útil para nosotros en los años venideros, recordándonos que Dios no quiere ni necesita que seamos héroes más allá de nuestras capacidades, que Dios mismo nos ayudará a ser libres.

Había muchas, muchas cosas malas en el mundo en la época de Jesús. Él no envió a sus discípulos como ovejas al matadero para corregirlos.

En cambio, hoy escuchamos que entró en la casa de un hombre sencillo para ayudarlo a ser libre... para seguirlo.

En los próximos años muchas "montañas pueden caer y las colinas se reducirán en polvo", pero al final seguir a Jesús será lo único que realmente importe.
