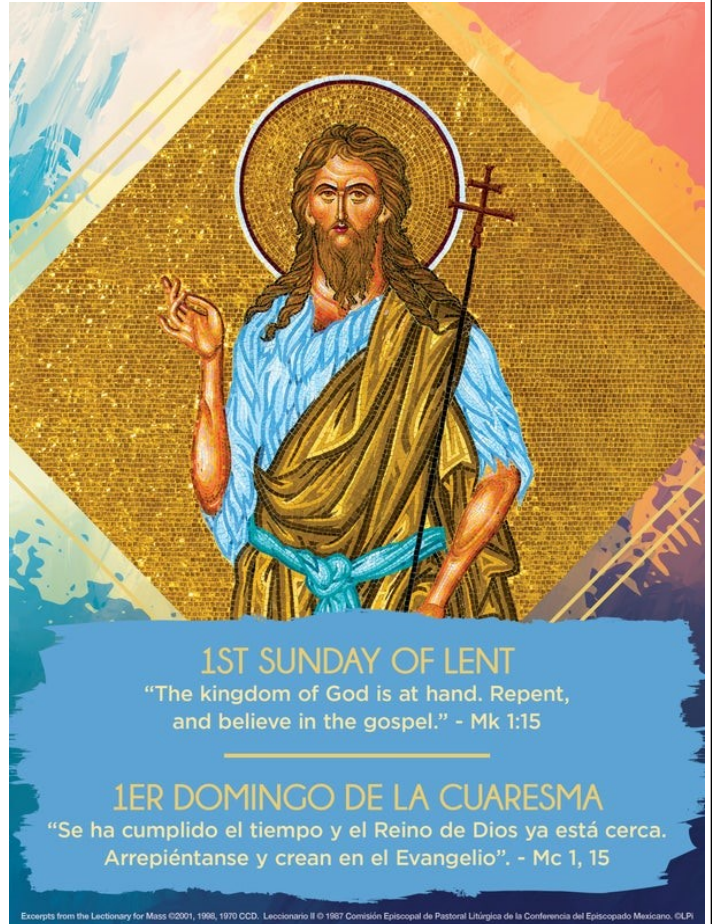

Dear Parishioners,

Welcome to Lent again. The Church is largely bare. What color there is, is purple. On Wednesday we received our ashes on our foreheads. On Friday we abstained from meat, and perhaps came to the parish to pray the stations of the cross and spend some time enjoying a Lenten meal and time with friends at the parish.

Hopefully, figured out what you're giving up for Lent and/or what spiritual or charitable practice you're going to focus on individually or as a family.

And all this is good.

On this First Sunday of Lent, as always, the Liturgy sends us out symbolically into the Desert to reflect on our lives and to decide what we're going to try to change to bring us closer to Jesus and his Church.

But the message this Sunday is not simply of austerity, but also of a promise of hope.

In the First Reading today, we hear that at the end of God's greatest punishment of humanity for its sins, God promised to never do so again, sealing his promise in two symbols of hope that endure to this day: the dove carrying the olive branch in its beak back to the ark, signaling that the dry land was appearing once more, and the rainbow, whose spectrum of colors have been occasions of wonder for both young and old across the ages.

Yes, there is much wrong in this world. There's much we can and need to change both within ourselves and across society / the world.

But even as we join Jesus in the Desert contemplating what we should do next, we are offered these symbols of hope for the future.

Let us never give up on that hope as we take our first steps on our annual Lenten journey.

God bless you all and may this Lent become an occasion of blessing for you.

Sí, hay muchos problemas en este mundo. Hay muchas cosas que podemos y necesitamos cambiar tanto dentro de nosotros mismos como en toda la sociedad y el mundo.

Pero en este momento cuando nos unimos a Jesús en el desierto contemplando lo que debemos hacer a continuación, se nos ofrecen estos símbolos de esperanza para el futuro.

Nunca perdamos esa esperanza mientras tomamos nuestros primeros pasos en nuestro viaje anual de Cuaresma.
