PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

Today we arrive at the 4th Sunday of Advent and as happens every seven or eight years, the time that will follow our celebration of it will be quite short! Our last "Sunday Mass" will be the 12:30 PM Mass which will end by about 2 PM. Our Celebration of Christmas will begin then at 4 PM with our English Family Christmas Mass!

For now, however, we remain at the 4th Sunday of Advent, so it will remain the initial focus here.

If on the 1st Sunday of Advent, we begin "in the clouds" with simply the Prophets beginning to preach the arrival one day, "in the fullness of time" of an anointed one who would set things right, both the vision and the challenge become increasingly focused with each succeeding Sunday.

Today, on the 4th Sunday, we brought thoroughly down to earth with the story taking us to the home of Mary with her encounter, there, in prayer, with an Angel.

The project of Salvation, of fixing what is wrong with the world, descended from "far away" in both time and distance into one's home, Mary's home, into her most intimate thoughts, in prayer.

In a few hours' time, we will begin our celebration of Christmas, remembering that God, in the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity, entered then into the world by means of Mary, as ... a baby.

And we are invited to contemplate the Most Awesome (God) seeking to redeem, fix, the most intimate (what takes place in our hearts) by means of the most mundane (a baby).

Enjoy! And Merry - at 4 PM on December 24th - Christmas!
