PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

We gather this day to celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family, with tomorrow the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, following.

From a calendar perspective it is a strange year, one which occurs only once every 7-8 years!

However, though the date of our celebration of the Feast of the Holy Family changes from year to year, it always finds itself bounded by the two other Solemn celebrations of this first Octave of Christmas – the Nativity of the Lord (Christmas, Dec 25th) and Mary, the other of God (January 1st).

All three of these feasts invite us to reflect on the Human Nature of Christ – that just like all of us, he entered the world as a baby (Nativity), in the context of a family (Holy Family), with a human mother (Mother of God).

Later we will celebrate a second Octave of Christmas (from the Feast of the Epiphany to the Baptism of the Lord), which focuses on the Divine Nature of Christ and how even if he was like us, he was also more than us, that is, Divine.

But today we focus on Jesus' family, and recall that last week, the trajectory of Jesus' arrival into the world, entered Mary's home (and thus family) as well.

It has often been said that much else in the outside world can seem to fall apart, but if one's family is strong, one can keep one's bearings and peace.

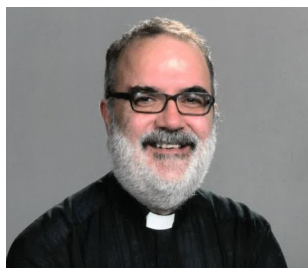
Conversely, the Scriptures show us, from the story of the First Couple (Adam and Eve) and their family, including Cain and Abel onwards, how problems within one's family can have real impacts on the world outside.

So, it is important to note that when Jesus came, he did not merely come into this world. Instead, he came into a family, the Holy Family, with all its challenges.

So, my friends, Family Life is important, and it is important here to find a way to live together, love one another, help each other to grow, and at times to forgive one another.

And if we need help in this, then let us remember that Jesus came into the world precisely here, to help us. May God bless us and at times help us all!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos feligreses,

Nos reunimos hoy para celebrar la Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia, a la que seguirá mañana la Solemnidad de María, la Madre de Dios.

Desde el punto de vista del calendario, se trata de un año extraño, que sólo se celebra una vez cada 7 u 8 años.

Sin embargo, aunque la fecha de nuestra celebración de la Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia cambia de año en año, siempre se encuentra delimitada por las otras dos celebraciones solemnes de esta primera Octava de Navidad: la Natividad del Señor (Navidad, 25 de diciembre) y María, la otra de Dios (1 de enero).

Las tres fiestas nos invitan a reflexionar sobre la naturaleza humana de Cristo: que, al igual que todos nosotros, vino al mundo como un bebé (Natividad), en el contexto de una familia (Sagrada Familia), con una madre humana (Madre de Dios).

Más adelante celebraremos una segunda Octava de Navidad (desde la Fiesta de la Epifanía hasta el Bautismo del Señor), que se centra en la Naturaleza Divina de Cristo y en cómo, aun siendo como nosotros, también era más que nosotros, es decir, Divino.

Pero hoy nos centramos en la familia de Jesús, y recordamos que la semana pasada, la trayectoria de la llegada de Jesús al mundo, entró también en la casa (y, por tanto, en la familia) de María.

A menudo se ha dicho que muchas otras cosas en el mundo exterior pueden parecer desmoronarse, pero si la familia de uno es fuerte, uno puede mantener su orientación y su paz.

A la inversa, las Escrituras nos muestran, a partir de la historia de la Primera Pareja (Adán y Eva) y su familia, incluidos Caín y Abel, cómo los problemas en el seno de la familia pueden tener repercusiones reales en el mundo exterior.

Así pues, es importante señalar que cuando Jesús vino, no vino simplemente a este mundo. Vino a una familia, la Sagrada Familia, con todos sus desafíos.

Por eso, amigos míos, la vida familiar es importante, y aquí es importante encontrar la manera de vivir juntos, de amarnos, de ayudarnos a crecer y, a veces, de perdonarnos.

Y si necesitamos ayuda en esto, entonces recordemos que Jesús vino al mundo precisamente aquí, para ayudarnos. ¡Que Dios nos bendiga y a veces nos ayude a todos!
