PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

If the Liturgy always takes us to the same places for the First and Second Sundays of Lent – to the Desert and Mountain Top respectfully – the Third through Fifth Sundays of Lent depend on the Liturgical Cycle being used.

We find ourselves in Cycle B, so unless you were attending our 10:30 AM Mass today where because we were celebrating the first of three Scrutinies with our Elect (and the Readings were necessarily taken from Cycle A and the Gospel Reading was about Jesus talking to the Samaritan Woman at the Well), the Gospel Reading that you will have heard today was of Jesus Cleansing the Temple.

Why the difference in theme?

Cycle A seeks to present the radical Grandness of Jesus' Mission, that he truly came for everybody: for the Outcast (Third Sunday and the Samaritan Woman), for the Sick or Uneducated (Fourth Sunday and the Man Born Blind) and finally for even for the already Dead (Fifth Sunday and the Raising of Lazarus from the Dead).

Cycle B, in contrast, focus' on Jesus' understanding and commitment to this Mission.

And today we hear that Jesus pulls no punches. Known by many up until that point to be simply a charismatic and perhaps even healing figure from the hill country of Galilee, he came into the Temple and drove out the merchants selling their wares there, knocking over their tables and causing a general ruckus.

Why would he do that? The passage explained it was to fulfill the words of the Old Testament scripture that "Zeal for the Lord consumed him." But it seemed above all to indicate to everyone that He meant business, that He wasn't going to be bought off, marginalized, neutralized by pious praise: "Oh he's such a good man, great speaker, even miracle worker." Instead, he went into the Temple and declared in no uncertain terms: "Look here! I'm here for a purpose!"

That purpose gets again fleshed-out over the following Sundays. What is clear however already this Sunday is that Jesus was aware of his Mission and was not going to politeness get in the way of fulfilling it.

Sometimes we're called to knock over some tables too for our Faith.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

Si la Liturgia siempre nos lleva a los mismos lugares durante el Primer y Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma – al Desierto y a la Cima de la Montaña respetuosamente – el Tercer al Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma depende del Ciclo Litúrgico utilizado.

Nos encontramos en el Ciclo B, así que, a menos que estuvieras asistiendo a nuestra Misa de las 10:30 a. m. hoy, porque allí hemos celebrado el primero de los tres Escrutinios con nuestros Elegidos (y las Lecturas fueron necesariamente tomadas del Ciclo A y la Lectura del Evangelio allí fue sobre Jesús hablando a la Samaritana junto al pozo), la lectura del Evangelio que habrán escuchado hoy fue la de Jesús Limpiando el Templo.

¿Por qué la diferencia de tema?

El Ciclo A busca presentar la radical Grandeza de la Misión de Jesús, que realmente vino para todos: para los Marginados (Tercer Domingo y la Samaritana), para los Enfermos o Incultos (Cuarto Domingo y el Ciego de Nacimiento) y finalmente para incluso para los ya Difuntos (Quinto Domingo y la Resurrección de Lázaro de entre los Muertos).

El ciclo B, por el contrario, se centra en la comprensión y el compromiso de Jesús con esta Misión.

Y hoy escuchamos que Jesús no se anda con rodeos. Conocido por muchos hasta ese momento como simplemente un predicador carismático y tal vez incluso sanador de la región de Galilea, entró en el Templo y expulsó a los comerciantes que vendían allí sus productos, derribando sus mesas y provocando un alboroto general.

¿Por qué tendría que hacer eso? El pasaje explica que fue para cumplir las palabras de las Escrituras del Antiguo Testamento que "el celo por el Señor lo consumió". Pero, sobre todo, parecía indicar a todos que hablaba en serio, que no iba a dejarse comprar, marginar, neutralizar mediante elogios piadosos: "Oh, es un hombre tan bueno, un gran orador e incluso hace milagros". En cambio, entró en el templo y declaró en términos muy claros: "¡Miran aquí! ¡Estoy aquí con un propósito!"

Ese propósito se volverá a desarrollar durante los domingos siguientes. Sin embargo, lo que está claro ya este domingo es que Jesús era consciente de su Misión y no iba a impedir que la cortesía la cumpliera.

A veces también nosotros somos llamados a derribar algunas mesas por nuestra Fe.
