PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

The fourth Sunday of Lent, like the third Sunday of Advent holds a special place in the Liturgy. This special place was created at a time where those two seasons of preparation were lived primarily in a Penitential Context and it was needed to cheer up the faithful and remind them even at this time of God's goodness and fundamental love for us.

Hence the colors of the Church are different this Sunday – rose – rather than purple, and in as much as we have given-up something for Lent, we are allowed to partake of it on this day.

One supposes that even in times when fasting or “giving up” of anything is not particularly favored in the culture, the reminder that God still loves us is important to underline anyway.

In the first reading today we are reminded that “Early and often” the Lord through his prophets warned the people of their transgressions. And even though these transgressions were followed by inevitable consequences, we are reminded that even then God did relent and allowed a new power to come on the scene, the Persians, who allowed the Israelites to come home – after 70 years of exile – and begin their lives and faith anew.

It is God's kindness and mercy, not punishment, that endures forever.

In the Gospel Reading today we are reminded similarly, that even if God does act at times to shake us up – as last Sunday we heard of Jesus cleansing the Temple – nevertheless it was God's will to save everyone who came to follow him.

This is something for us to remember even as we use this time of lent to bring ourselves closer to God. We may not be able to escape the consequences of our failings, but God loves us anyway, and is able to convert even our hardest moments into something life-giving and new.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

El cuarto domingo de Cuaresma, al igual que el tercer domingo de Adviento, ocupa un lugar especial en la liturgia. Este lugar especial fue creado en un tiempo en el que esos dos tiempos de preparación se vivían principalmente en un contexto penitencial y era necesario para animar a los fieles y recordarles, incluso en ese momento, la bondad y el amor fundamental de Dios por nosotros.

Por lo tanto, los colores de la Iglesia son diferentes este domingo – rosado en lugar de púrpura -- y en la medida en que hayamos renunciado a algo durante la Cuaresma, se nos permite participar de ello en este día.

Se supone que incluso en épocas en los que el ayuno o el “renunciar” a algo no es particularmente favorecido en la cultura, es importante subrayar de todos modos el recordatorio de que Dios todavía nos ama.

En la primera lectura de hoy se nos recuerda que “temprano y con frecuencia” el Señor, a través de sus profetas, advirtió al pueblo de sus transgresiones. Y aunque estas transgresiones fueron seguidas por consecuencias inevitables, se nos recuerda que incluso entonces Dios cedió y permitió que un nuevo poder entrara en escena, los persas, quienes permitieron a los israelitas regresar a casa – después de 70 años de exilio – y comenzar sus vidas y su fe de nuevo.

Es la bondad y la misericordia de Dios, no el castigo, lo que perdura para siempre.

En la lectura del Evangelio de hoy se nos recuerda de manera similar, que incluso si Dios actúa a veces para sacudirnos – como el domingo pasado escuchamos que Jesús limpió el Templo – sin embargo, era la voluntad de Dios salvar a todos los que vinieron a seguirlo.

Esto es algo que debemos recordar incluso cuando usamos este tiempo de cuaresma para acercarnos más a Dios. Puede que no seamos capaces de escapar de las consecuencias de nuestros fracasos, pero Dios nos ama de todos modos y es capaz de convertir incluso nuestros momentos más difíciles en algo nuevo y vivificante.

A través del trabajar con los materiales basados en citas bíblicas, la vida de la Iglesia y el atrio, los estudiantes reflejan un mayor entendimiento de la profundidad de su relación con Dios.


