**PASTORS PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

As we approach Holy Week, Palm Sunday is next Sunday, today's Gospel Reading talks to of Jesus' commitment to his Mission.

Two Sundays ago, we heard him "getting our attention" by knocking over the tables outside the Temple.

Last Sunday, we heard Jesus explaining to the goodly Temple Priest Nicodemus who came out to visit him after that incident, that his mission wasn't to condemn the world but rather to save it through him.

This Sunday, we hear Jesus articulating the mission ahead of him, telling his people that he must die, but just as a grain of wheat must die in order to bear fruit, so must he.

So a Mission that started with an eye-opening act of power, became at the end a singular act of self-giving love.

In our time when we certainly are tempted to worship power, and prefer to think of ourselves as "nobody's fools," we need to see Jesus as someone who's been formed by God the Father to do what is necessary, to sacrifice himself as necessary, for our sake. Can we learn to do this as well?

In other parts of the Gospel, Jesus reminds us that whoever tries to save his or her life will lose it but whoever sacrifices his or her life for his sake and that of the Gospel will save it.

Let's be willing to extend a hand to those who need us even if it's a bit scary to do so.

And let us appreciate then the commitment that Jesus displayed for our sake even though we know well that we didn't really deserve it.

Even if we do fail, let us remember that for our sake, Jesus did not.

God bless you all and have a happy and blessed rest of Lent,

Y apreciemos entonces el compromiso que Jesús mostró por nosotros aunque sabemos bien que realmente no lo merecíamos.
