PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday, with Palm Sunday we begin our annual commemoration of Holy Week.

The theme of our preparation this year was about the Greatness of Jesus' commitment to his redemptive Mission.

He was willing to make himself controversial to get our attention by knocking over those tables in the courtyard of the temple. (4th Sunday of Lent)

Lest we think that he was doing so to just show off his power, we were then reminded that he came here not to scare us or to condemn us but rather that we be saved through him (5th Sunday of Lent).

Finally, we are reminded that far from making a show of himself, he came to fully understand that his Mission involved dying for us, so that we might live and bear much fruit (6th Sunday of Lent).

Today we remember Jesus' solemn entry into Jerusalem so that his Mission would come to pass.

We may wonder at times where is God, and indeed why God doesn't intervene more often in our affairs.

Yet, in this week we remember:

That Jesus did in fact come into this world, indeed come onto the stage of this world (Palm Sunday),

That he did seek to teach what we need to do, and indeed how to remember him and his teaching (Holy Thursday)

That he did in fact surrender himself and die for us (Good Friday)

And in the end, in fulfillment of a redemptive project that began from the Fall of our first parents, he rose from the dead (Holy Saturday / Easter Sunday) showing us that nothing, not even our falls or our deaths can separate us from the God who created us, loves us, and has our destiny with him prepared for us.

On behalf of everyone at St. Philip Benizi, have a lovely and blessed Holy Week!

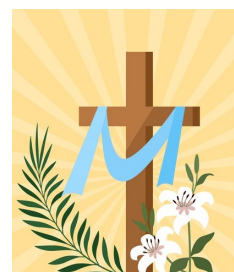
