

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

After 40 days of Preparation during Lent, and our commemoration of the events of Holy Week, we come to this day, Easter Sunday, be it at the Vigil, be it in the morning, be it later in the day / evening.

And we're asked to reflect on what it all means.

Over the years all of us run into cases of all kinds of friends and families who find themselves facing their own or their family's own Calvaries, sometimes even during Holy Week.

Dig even a little into the events of this world and one can quickly discover that it isn't what it ought to be.

And yet this is why then these events that we've commemorated so solemnly this week can offer us so much Hope as we look toward the challenges that we all face in this world.

Fundamentally our Faith is about "the Word" -- all our world's words, aspirations, categories, concepts, means of trying to make sense of the world -- "becoming Flesh" and "dwelling among us" (John 1:14).

We then solemnly remembered this past week, that this Incarnate Word (the sum of all our words, aspirations, concepts "made flesh") decided at an appointed time (during the governorship of Pontius Pilate) to go up to "the most important city" (Jerusalem) during its most important time of the year (Passover, a feast already evocative of much Hope), to take upon himself the worst that this world can offer -- betrayal, arrest, condemnation, torture, death -- and then, "three days later, rose from the dead."

The "Incarnate Word" of all our aspirations, murdered in front of our eyes, "rose from dead," and, "ascended" "(back) into the Heavens," and is seated "at the right hand of the Father (God)."

There is a lot of Hope present in this message, beginning that our best aspirations, are both valid and real, and that a realm exists (Heaven) where they live and will be realized.

And, of course, that Beyond all our best Hopes and Aspirations there exists a Being, God, who blesses those Hopes of ours and that one day, just like the Day that Jesus entered into Jerusalem, will make them come to be.

Honestly folks, take some time to reflect on what this Great Day which we celebrate today means, and Happy Easter to you all!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos feligreses,

Después de 40 días de Preparación durante la Cuaresma, y nuestra conmemoración de los eventos de la Semana Santa, llegamos a este día, el Domingo de Pascua, ya sea en la Vigilia, o en la mañana, o más tarde en el día o en la noche.

Y se nos pide que reflexionemos sobre lo que significa todo esto.

A lo largo de los años, todos encontramos casos de amigos y familiares que se encuentran ante sus propios Calvarios o los de sus familiares, a veces incluso durante la Semana Santa.

Busque aun sea un poco en los acontecimientos de este mundo y rápidamente descubriremos que el mundo no es lo que debería ser.

Pero es por eso que estos eventos que hemos conmemorado en manera muy solemne esta semana pueden ofrecernos tanta esperanza al mirar hacia los desafíos que todos enfrentamos en este mundo.

Fundamentalmente nuestra Fe se trata de "la Palabra" -- todas las palabras, aspiraciones, categorías, conceptos y medios de este mundo para tratar de darle sentido al mundo -- que "se hecho Carne" y "habitó entre nosotros" (Juan 1: 14).

Y hemos recordado solemnemente la semana pasada, que este Verbo Encarnado (la suma de todas nuestras palabras, aspiraciones, conceptos, "hecha carne") decidió en un momento preciso (durante el gobierno de Poncio Pilato) subir a "la ciudad más importante " (Jerusalén) durante su temporada más importante del año (la Pascua Judía, una fiesta que ya evoca mucha Esperanza), para asumir lo peor que este mundo puede ofrecer - traición, arresto, condena, tortura, muerte - y " tres días después, resucitó de entre los muertos".

El "Verbo Encarnado" de todas nuestras aspiraciones, matado frente nuestros ojos, "resucitó de los muertos" y "ascendió (de nuevo) a los Cielos" y ya "está sentado a la diestra del Padre (Dios)."

Hay mucha Esperanza presente en este mensaje, empezando por que nuestras mejores aspiraciones son válidas y verdaderas, y que existe un reino (el Cielo) donde viven y van a ser realizadas.

Y, por supuesto, que más allá de todas nuestras mejores esperanzas y aspiraciones existe un Ser, Dios, que bendice esas Esperanzas nuestras y que un día, como el Día en que Jesús entró en Jerusalén, las hará realidad.

Honestamente amigos, tomen tiempo para reflexionar sobre el significado de este Gran Día y ¡felices Pascuas para todos!
