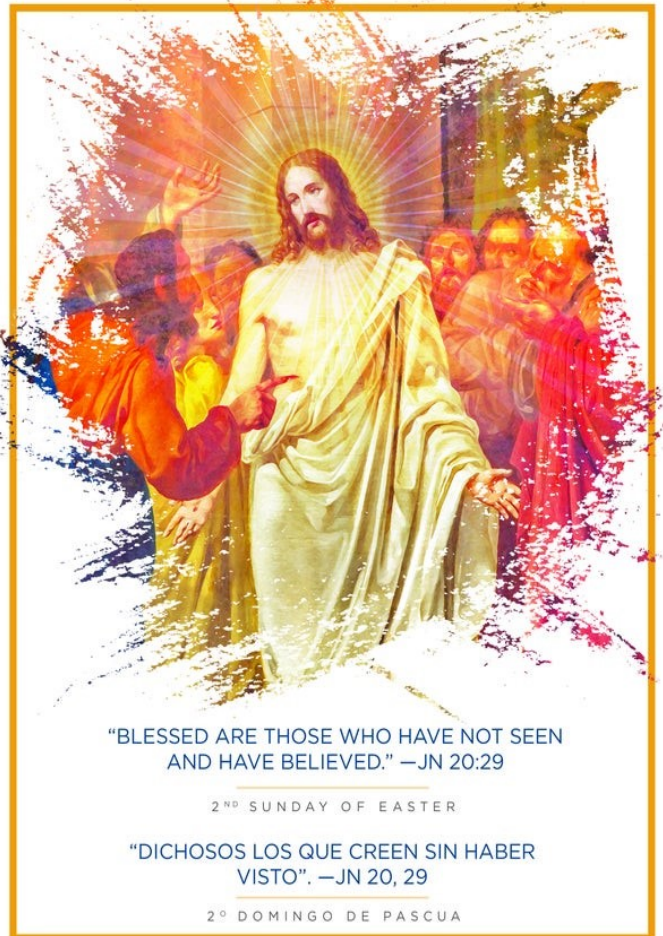

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we end the Octave of Easter and since the time of St. John Paul II it has come to be called Divine Mercy Sunday.

I've long appreciated the renaming of this Sunday because it helps explain the "why" of Jesus' coming and even his Death / Resurrection as a manifestation of God's love / mercy toward us.

I've seen that Divine Mercy expressed in the Gospel Reading, not only toward St. Thomas who initially had trouble believing that Jesus had risen (or toward St. Peter who had denied even knowing Jesus after Jesus had been arrested), but also toward St. John from whose Gospel we hear today. St. John seemed to repeatedly paint himself as being somewhat better than the other Apostles – something that no one particularly likes – and Jesus clearly showed mercy toward him despite his apparent arrogance.

Jesus' mercy toward these humble individuals who he had called to be his first Apostles helps express beautifully God's Merciful attitude towards us.

Yet we have then an annual invitation to reflect on how God's Mercy can be expressed in our world today.

This week accepting an invitation from Fullerton's Muslim Community, a number of us – myself, Fr. Sebastian, Fr Chinnu and Deacon Richard Doubledee – attended one of their community's "Break the Fast" evenings during Ramadan. Accepting an invitation by Fullerton's Temple Beth Tikvah, Deacon John and his wife Maggie as well as Joe Rubio and his wife Carmela as well as one other parishioner represented us at a similar joint Sabbath / Ramadan "Break the Fast" event that TBT sponsored along with a local Turkish Islamic Group. Recently we also hosted a group of Egyptian nuns selling their religious items to support their efforts to remain a peaceful presence in the Middle East / Holy Land.

In a time of War and consequent heartache, these invitations of kindness and mercy need to be supported. We can all find reasons to divide and hurt each other. Yet we need to find ways to express the mercy that we all believe that God has toward us all.

Happy Divine Mercy Sunday!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos feligreses,

Este domingo damos por finalizada la Octava de Pascua y desde tiempos de San Juan Pablo II se le ha dado el nombre de Domingo de la Divina Misericordia.

Ya por mucho tiempo he apreciado el cambio de nombre de este domingo porque ayuda a explicar el "por qué" de la venida de Jesús y su Muerte y Resurrección como una manifestación del amor/misericordia de Dios hacia nosotros.

He visto la Misericordia Divina expresada en la lectura del Evangelio, no sólo hacia Santo Tomás, quien inicialmente tuvo problemas para creer que Jesús había resucitado (o hacia San Pedro, que había negado incluso conocer a Jesús después de que Jesús había sido arrestado), sino también hacia San Juan de cuyo evangelio escuchamos hoy. A veces San Juan parecía presentarse a sí mismo como "mejor" que los otros Apóstoles – algo que a nadie le gusta particularmente – y Jesús claramente mostró misericordia hacia él a pesar de su arrogancia.

La misericordia de Jesús hacia estos humildes individuos que habían sido llamados a ser sus primeros Apóstoles ayuda a expresar bellamente la actitud misericordiosa de Dios hacia nosotros.

Sin embargo, tenemos una invitación anual a reflexionar sobre cómo la Misericordia de Dios puede expresarse en nuestro mundo de hoy.

Esta semana, al aceptar una invitación de la comunidad Musulmana de Fullerton, varios de nosotros (yo mismo, el p. Sebastian, el padre Chinnu y el diácono Richard Doubledee) asistimos a una de las noches de "Romper el ayuno" de su comunidad durante el Ramadán. Al aceptar una invitación del Templo Beth Tikvah de Fullerton, el Diácono John y su esposa Maggie, así como Joe Rubio y su esposa Carmela, así como otro feligrés, nos representaron en un evento similar conjunto de Sabbat y "Romper el Ayuno" de Ramadán que TBT patrocinó junto con un Grupo Islámico Turco local. Y recientemente recibimos a un grupo de monjas Egipcias que vendieron sus artículos religiosos para apoyarles a mantener su presencia pacífica en Medio Oriente y Tierra Santa.

En tiempos de guerra y la consiguiente tristeza, es necesario apoyar estas invitaciones de bondad y misericordia. Todos podemos encontrar razones para dividirnos y herirnos unos a otros. Pero debemos buscar maneras de expresar la misericordia que todos creemos que Dios tiene hacia todos nosotros.
