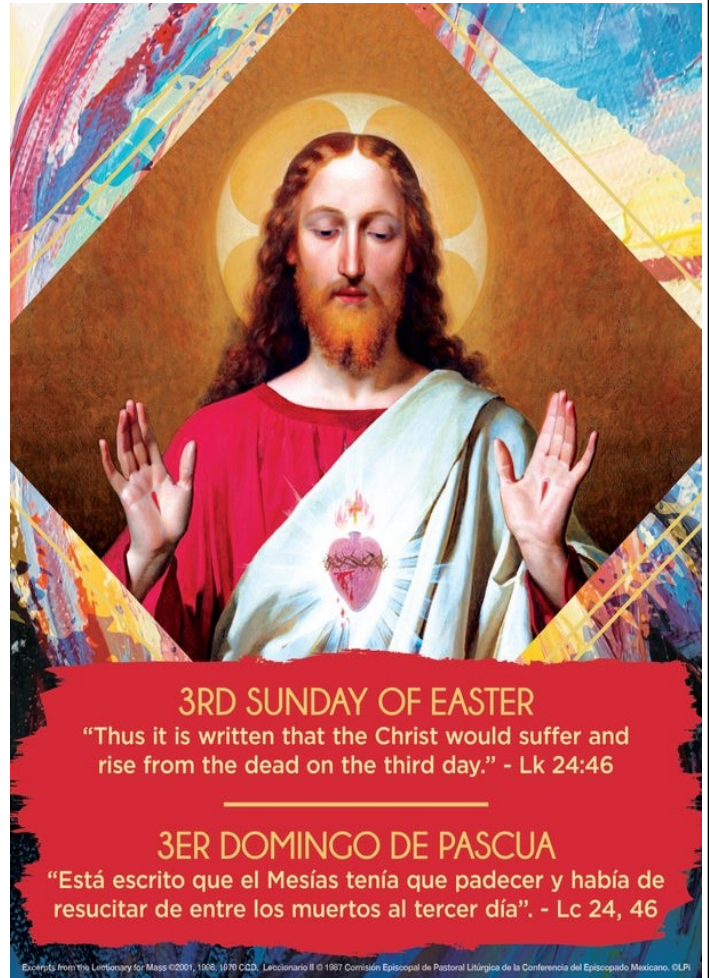

**PASTORS PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

The Gospel Reading asks us to reflect one more time on the Apostles' message of the reality of the Resurrection.

While details could be pushed to the side, it is clear that the Apostles wished to communicate to us their descendants that Jesus really did rise from the dead.

Responding to questions posed it at the time that the Evangelists were putting down the Gospels to paper, it seems that the early Christian community wanted to eliminate doubt about what they were proclaiming: That Jesus really did rise from the dead.

We of course live 2000 years later in a very different time and culture. And we can't just force people to believe what we believe anymore. The temptation to do so perhaps remains, but most of us would be conflicted about this.

So what to do?

I do believe that Jesus does show us the path: Above all, he spent the entire time of his ministry with average people, even perhaps with problematic people. And his presence to them expressed care.

Noting his style of ministry, perhaps we can gain new insight into the purpose and meaning of his Resurrection:

Jesus' Resurrection offers us assurance that Jesus isn't going away, that the care that he offered is Eternal.

I often tell parents of adult children that their role is now to simply pray for their children and to offer then good example by our lives. Arguments no longer are helpful, but good example and prayer (care from a distance) are remembered.

And people do change. We're not the same at 40 as we were at 20, or the same at 60 as we were at 40, and our parents become smarter as we grow older.

So we don't have to pound people's heads with our faith. Jesus' eternal presence will eventually whittle opposition down. And in the end as the writer of Amazing Grace himself came to experience; "When we're there 10,000 years / bright shining like the sun / we have no less days to sing God's praise / as when we first begun."

So let us not be afraid. God in Jesus is with us, and so thing else can really hurt us, certainly in the context of Eternity. So happy continued Easter to you all!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos feligreses,

La lectura del Evangelio nos pide reflexionar una vez más sobre el mensaje de los Apóstoles sobre la realidad de la Resurrección.

Si bien los detalles podrían dejarse de lado, está claro que los Apóstoles deseaban comunicarnos a sus descendientes que Jesús realmente resucitó de entre los muertos.

Respondiendo a las preguntas puesta a ella en el tiempo en que los Evangelistas estaban poniendo los Evangelios en papel, parece que la primera comunidad cristiana quería eliminar las dudas sobre lo que estaban proclamando: que Jesús realmente resucitó de entre los muertos.

Pero vivimos 2000 años después en una época y una cultura muy diferente. Y ya no podemos simplemente forzar a la gente a creer lo que creemos. Quizás persista la tentación de hacerlo, pero la mayoría de nosotros estaríamos en conflicto con esa táctica.

¿Entonces que hay que hacer?

Creo que Jesús nos muestra el camino: "Él pasó todo el tiempo de su ministerio con personas regulares, incluso quizás con personas problemáticas. Y su presencia para ellos les expresó cariño hacia ellos.

Al observar su estilo de ministerio, tal vez podamos obtener una nueva visión del propósito y significado de su Resurrección:

Por su Resurrección, Jesús nos ofrece la seguridad no desaparecerá, que el cuidado que él ofreció es Eterno.

A menudo les digo a los padres de hijos adultos que su papel ahora es simplemente a orar por sus hijos y ofrecer a ellos un buen ejemplo con sus vidas. Ya no sirven las discusiones, pero se recuerda el buen ejemplo que den y su oración (cuidado a distancia).

Y la gente cambia. No somos los mismos a los 40 que a los 20, ni a los 60 como a los 40, y nuestros padres se vuelven más inteligentes a medida que nos hacemos mayores.

Así que no tenemos que golpear la cabeza de la gente con nuestra fe. La presencia eterna de Jesús eventualmente reducirá la oposición. Y al final, como llegó a experimentar el escritor del himno Amazing Grace; "Cuando llevemos allí 10.000 años / brillando como el sol / no tendremos menos días para cantar alabanzas a Dios / como cuando empezamos".

Así que no tengamos miedo. Dios en Jesús está con nosotros, pues no hay nada que realmente puede dañarnos, ciertamente en el contexto de la Eternidad. Pues que sigamos brindando ¡Feliz Pascua a todos!
