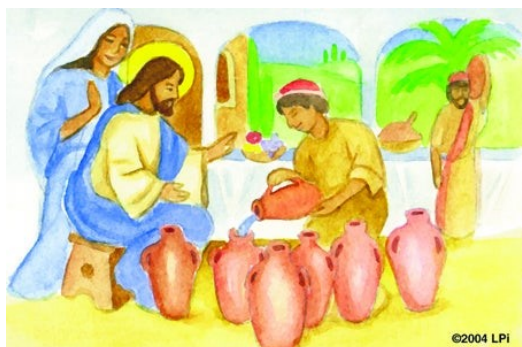

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

We find ourselves now after the celebration of the Christmas Season, looking forward toward the unfolding of this year, designated a Jubilee Year by our Pope Francis as a Year of Hope.

And we have begun discussing various hopeful means of expressing this virtue in our parish life in our various committees. Your input will be more than appreciated as well.

And it is certainly a blessing that our Pope asks us to focus on hope at a time when there are any number of reasons to despair.

Fires have raged around us in recent weeks, people continue to fall ill, seemingly intractable wars are being fought across the globe as well, without much indication that “the good guys” will win or justice / right will be vindicated any time soon.

That said, this is the world in which we live and into which Jesus came some 2000 years ago.

And the miracle we hear proclaimed today – one of our favorites across the centuries – is one that does not proclaim the resolution to any great problem, but precisely to a very small, yet, important one:

Jesus and his mother Mary found themselves at a wedding where the hosts had run out of wine.

And rather than force the family to confront this potential embarrassment, the two conspired to make it an occasion to Jesus’ first miracle, in John’s Gospel anyway.

At Mary’s request Jesus converted water into wine, indeed a lot of water into a lot of wine.

If one does the math, Jesus took water filling 6 jars each containing 25 gallons of water, so at about 4 liters per gallon, 600 liters of water in total, and converted all that water into wine. At 750 mL per average wine bottle that’s 800 bottles of wine.

Assuming a wedding of 200 people, that’s 4 bottles of wine for every man woman and child at that wedding. That’s a lot of wine.

So don’t worry. There is hope. Jesus promises that all will turn out well! Happy beginning of the Year of Hope!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses,

Ahora, después de la celebración de Navidad, nos encontramos al comienzo de este año, designado un Año Jubilar por nuestro Papa Francisco como el Año de Esperanza.

Y hemos empezado a discutir en nuestros varios comités, varios medios esperanzadores de expresar esta virtud en nuestra vida parroquial. Sus aportes también serán más que apreciados.

Y es ciertamente una bendición que nuestro Papa nos pida que nos enfoquemos en la esperanza en un tiempo en el que hay muchas razones para desesperar.

Los incendios han asolado nuestro entorno en las últimas semanas, nuestros feligreses siguen cayendo en varias clases de enfermedad, hay guerras aparentemente insolubles por todo el mundo también, sin mucha indicación de que “los buenos” van a ganar o que la justicia / el derecho van a vencer en un futuro próximo.

Dicho esto, este es el mundo en el que vivimos y al que Jesús llegó hace unos 2000 años.

Y el milagro que hoy oímos proclamado –uno de nuestros favoritos a lo largo de los siglos – no proclama la resolución de ningún gran problema, sino precisamente de uno muy pequeño, pero bien importante:

Jesús y su madre María se encontraban a una boda en la que la familia se había quedado sin vino para sus huéspedes.

Y en lugar de obligar a la familia a afrontar esta posible vergüenza, los dos conspiraron para convertirla en una ocasión para el primer milagro de Jesús (en el Evangelio de Juan, al menos).

A petición de María, Jesús convirtió el agua en vino, de hecho, mucha agua en mucho vino.

Si uno hace los cálculos, Jesús tomó agua que llenaba 6 jarras que contenían cada una de 100 litros pues 600 litros de agua en total, y convirtió toda esa agua en vino. A 750 ml por botella de vino, se habla de 800 botellas de vino.

Suponiendo una boda de 200 personas, eso viene a 4 botellas de vino para cada hombre, mujer y niño en esa boda. Eso es mucho vino!

Así que no se preocupen. Hay esperanza. Jesús promete que todo saldrá bien. Y pues ¡Feliz comienzo del Año de la Esperanza!

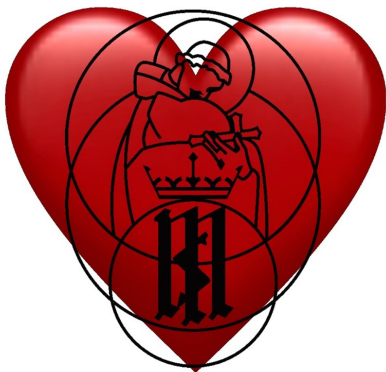

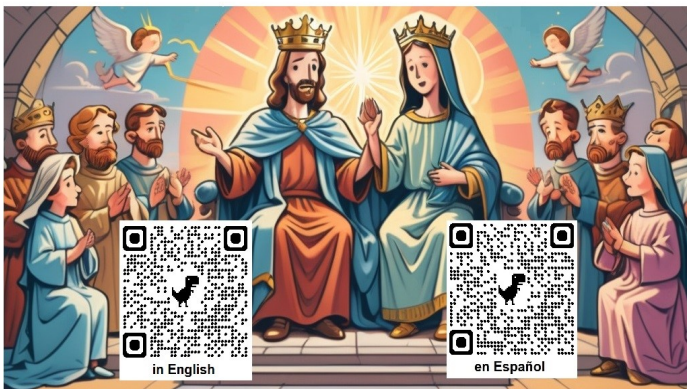
