PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

If Lent is generally seen as a 40 day journey, Advent is a telescopic one, beginning simply with the Prophets looking to the heavens “out there” asking for the arrival of an anointed one to set things right.

The subsequent Sundays bring us ever closer to earth, with the second Sunday introducing St. John the Baptist as “a voice crying out in the desert,” and the Third Sunday, planting us in his presence, hearing some of his preaching.

The Fourth Sunday of Advent brings us even closer to earth, into the context of the Holy Family.

The Holy Family, can be immediately recognized from our own experience as being “among us.” Yes, we believe that Mary was sinless and St. Joseph just. However, in every other respect, the Holy Family is like our good neighbors down the street, who we can put our confidence. The Liturgy presents them to us in this way, every year.

And so this year, we hear of Mary after the Annunciation running to her Aunt Elizabeth to share with her the good news.

There is of course a lot present in the story:

Mary was still only betrothed to the future St. Joseph. Elizabeth was an aunt who had trouble having children.

Yet above all the message here is that God wished to enter into our lives at their most intimate, a relation here between a young niece and an older, approaching elderly aunt.

This all prepares us for the Christmas Message that “In a (random) year of the Reign of Ceasar Augustus, when so and so was governor of so and so, and this and that seemingly important at the time happened, God, the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity entered into the world through a lovely, indeed, holy but otherwise utterly non-descript family, in a stable outside an utterly insignificant town outside a provincial capital whose best days had by all indications long past.

Yet this how, when and where God decided to enter into our world. And what we prepare for on this day.

And it needs to be said that the people in this story today are no kings or princes, or otherwise “important people.” Instead they were two people who could very well have been us.

Happy “almost Christmas”!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

Si la Cuaresma es considerada generalmente como un camino de 40 días, el Adviento es un viaje telescópico, que comienza simplemente con los profetas mirando hacia “los cielos” pidiendo la llegada de un ungido para arreglar las cosas.

Los Domingos siguientes nos acercan cada vez más a la tierra, con el segundo domingo presentando a San Juan Bautista como “una voz que clama en el desierto,” y el tercer domingo, colocándonos en su presencia, escuchando un poco de su predicación.

El cuarto domingo de Adviento nos acerca aún más a la tierra, al contexto de la Sagrada Familia.

La Sagrada Familia, puede ser reconocida inmediatamente por nuestra propia experiencia como estando “entre nosotros”. Ciertamente creemos que María no tenía pecado y San José era justo. Sin embargo, en todos los demás aspectos, la Sagrada Familia fue como nuestros buenos vecinos, en quienes podemos confiar. La Liturgia les presenta nos así, todos los años.

Y así, este año, escuchamos que María, después de la Anunciación, corrió hacia su tía Isabel para compartir con ella la buena noticia.

Por supuesto, hay mucho adentro de la historia:

María todavía estaba comprometida con el futuro San José. Isabel era una tía que tenía problemas para tener hijos.

Sin embargo, el mensaje aquí es que Dios deseaba entrar en nuestras vidas en su forma más íntima, una relación aquí entre una sobrina joven y una tía mayor, que se acercaba a la vejez.

Todo esto nos prepara para el Mensaje de Navidad que dice: “En un fulano año del reinado de César Augusto, cuando fulano era gobernador de tal y tal, y esto y aquello aparentemente importante en ese momento sucedió, Dios, la Segunda Persona de la Santísima Trinidad entró en el mundo a través de una familia bonita, de hecho, santa pero por lo demás absolutamente anodina, en un establo fuera de una ciudad absolutamente insignificante fuera de una capital provincial de que según todas indicaciones sus días más grandes han pasado siglos atrás.

Sin embargo, así es cómo, cuándo y dónde Dios decidió entrar en nuestro mundo. Y para lo que nos preparamos en este día.

Y es necesario decir que las personas que aparecen en esta historia de hoy no son reyes ni príncipes ni “personas importantes” de ninguna otra manera. En cambio, fueron dos personas que muy bien podrían ser nosotros.

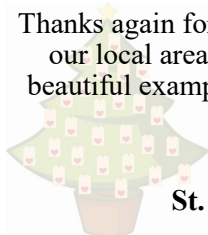
ST VINCENT DE PAUL
