**PASTORS PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

The first part of our Lenten Journey is always more or less the same: We start out on Ash Wednesday, told that we are “dust and to dust we shall return“ and that we are to “repent and believe in the Gospel.“ Then on the First Sunday of Lent we are always sent out into the Desert to recall Jesus’ 40 days in the Desert prior to the beginning of his Ministry. Finally on the Second Sunday of Lent we are taken up to the Mountain Top to catch a glimpse of the Glory in which would be part if we only continue on our journey with Jesus.

However, the second part of Journey, from the 3rd to the 5th Sundays of Lent, differs from year to year: This year we find ourselves in Cycle C of our Sunday Readings, so our Sunday Gospel Readings are generally taken from Luke, and the over all theme of these three Sundays of Lent is that of Redemption – God’s desire to Redeem us.

Last Sunday, this theme was perhaps best expressed in the 1st Reading, where we heard of Moses, after seeing for some time the burning bush out in the desert, decided to go investigate it. And it was at the Burning Bush that he found God, who in fact told him that largely right about the situation of the people of Israel in Egypt, and sent him back, at 80, with now with his blessing to “finish the job“ of setting them free: God did not want to let Moses’ perhaps overly aggressive reaction to the oppression of the Israelites go without resolution. Instead, God wanted to redeem Moses’ insight ... and as a result the world was forever changed.

This Sunday, we hear Jesus’ famous parable of the Prodigal Son. And here again, the Father didn’t want to let his prodigal son just die for his sins, especially after he had recognized that he had indeed been selfish and sinned against both heaven and earth and against him. So he redeemed him and brought him back.

Next week, we’re going to hear the story repeat itself in the even more drastic case of the woman caught in adultery.

The message in all of this is that God understands us, understands our temptations, our failings and our sufferings and is eager to welcome us home, no matter what we do, no matter how guilty we are.

So please, no matter how long we may have been “off the Reservation“ let us never fear to come home to our God!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses:

La primera parte de nuestro Camino Cuaresmal es siempre más o menos la misma: Comenzamos el Miércoles de Ceniza, donde se nos dice que somos «polvo y al polvo volveremos» y que debemos «arrepentimos y creer en el Evangelio». Luego, el Primer Domingo de Cuaresma, siempre somos enviados al desierto para recordar los 40 días que Jesús pasó allí antes del inicio de su ministerio. Finalmente, el Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma, subimos a la cima de la montaña para vislumbrar la gloria que formaría parte si tan solo continuáramos nuestro camino con Jesús.

Pero la segunda parte del Camino, del tercer al quinto Domingo de Cuaresma, difiere cada año: Este año nos encontramos en el Ciclo C de nuestras Lecturas Dominicales, por lo que las lecturas del Evangelio Dominical generalmente se toman de San Lucas, y el tema principal de estos tres Domingos de Cuaresma es la Redención: el deseo de Dios de redimirnos.

El Domingo pasado, este tema se expresó quizás mejor en la primera lectura, donde escuchamos cómo Moisés, tras ver durante un tiempo la zarza ardiente en el desierto, decidió ir a investigarla. Y cuando llegó allí, encontró a Dios. Y Dios lo le dijo que, en gran medida, tenía razón sobre la situación del pueblo de Israel en Egipto, y lo envió de regreso, a los 80 años, pero ahora con su bendición para "terminar la obra" de liberarlos: Dios no quería dejar sin resolver la reacción, quizás demasiado agresiva, de Moisés ante la opresión de los Israelitas. En cambio, Dios quería redimir la intuición de Moisés ... y a causa de esto, se cambió el mundo para siempre.

Este Domingo, escuchamos la famosa parábola de Jesús del Hijo Pródigo. Y aquí, de nuevo, el Padre no quería que su hijo simplemente muriera por sus pecados, especialmente después de reconocer que, en efecto, había sido egoísta y había pecado contra el cielo, la tierra y contra sí mismo. Así que lo redimió y lo trajo de vuelta.

La semana que viene, escucharemos cómo la historia se repite en el caso aún más drástico de la mujer sorprendida en adulterio.

El mensaje de todo esto es que Dios nos comprende, comprende nuestras tentaciones, nuestras fallas y nuestros sufrimientos, y desea que simplemente volvamos a su casa, sin importar lo que hagamos, o cuán culpables seamos.

Así que, no importa cuánto tiempo hayamos estado "alejados de la casa", ¡nunca temamos volver a casa con nuestro Dios!

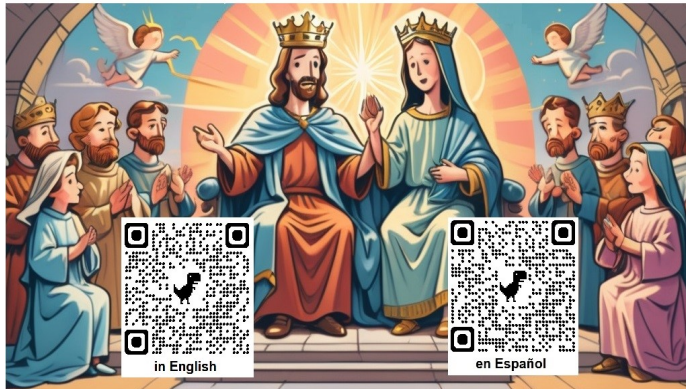
