PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we complete the second part of the Lenten Season. Next Sunday, we will be beginning our annual celebration of Holy Week with Palm Sunday.

In the Second Part of Lent – from the 3rd to 5th Sundays – the astounding dimensions of Jesus' redemptive mission are progressively revealed.

If in the 3rd Sunday of Lent we encounter a Jesus seeking to bring back the perhaps good if somewhat confused or unfortunate people who've fallen astray. In Year A cycle, we hear of Jesus searching out and bringing back the Samaritan Woman into the fold, and in Year C, we hear in the first reading of God signaling and bringing back Moses after his 40 years of exile in the Desert through the burning bush

The reconciling / redemptive mission expands in the following weeks. Last week in Year A, we heard of Jesus reaching out (and healing) a beggar who had been born blind and in Year C, we heard Jesus tell the story of a Father bringing back a random wayward son who had been problematic.

This Sunday, the dimensions of Jesus' redemptive mission explode. In Year A, we hear of Jesus even bringing back, including, even a person like Lazarus (who was dead!). In the Year C cycle we hear of Jesus' redemptive mission extending to even a couple caught in the very act of adultery, that there is no sin, no matter how obvious or great that can not be overcome and forgive through Christ Jesus.

So we are presented with a Vision of the Kingdom of God which is limitless in its inclusion or redemptive power, one in which truly ALL ARE WELCOME and especially those who need the assurance the most.

So enjoy then our remaining time of Lent!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

Este Domingo llegamos al final de la segunda parte de Cuaresma. El próximo Domingo, comenzaremos nuestra celebración anual de la Semana Santa con el Domingo de Ramos.

En la Segunda Parte de la Cuaresma, del tercer al quinto Domingo, progresivamente se revelan las asombrosas dimensiones de la misión redentora de Jesús.

En el tercer Domingo de Cuaresma nos encontramos con un Jesús que busca rescatar a las personas, quizás buenas, aunque un poco confundidas o desafortunadas, que se han extraviado. En el ciclo del Año A, escuchamos cómo Jesús busca y rescata a la Samaritana, y en el Año C, en la primera lectura, escuchamos cómo Dios invita y rescata a Moisés tras sus 40 años de exilio en el desierto por la zarza ardiente.

La misión reconciliadora/redentora se expande en las siguientes semanas. La semana pasada, en el Año A, escuchamos cómo Jesús ayudó (y sanó) a un mendigo ciego de nacimiento. En el Año C, escuchamos la historia de un padre que trajo de vuelta a un hijo descarriado que había sido problemático.

Este Domingo, la misión redentora de Jesús se expande a una dimensión extraordinaria. En el Año A, escuchamos que Jesús trajo de vuelta a una persona como Lázaro (¡quien estaba muerto!). En el ciclo del Año C, escuchamos que la misión redentora de Jesús se extiende hasta (y más allá) a una pareja sorprendida en el acto mismo de adulterio, demostrando que no hay pecado, por obvio o grave que sea, que no pueda ser superado y perdonado por medio de Cristo Jesús.

Así, se nos presenta una visión del Reino de Dios, ilimitado en su inclusión y poder redentor, donde TODOS SON BIENVENIDOS, especialmente aquellos que más necesitan esta seguridad.

Pues ¡Disfruten del tiempo restante de Cuaresma!

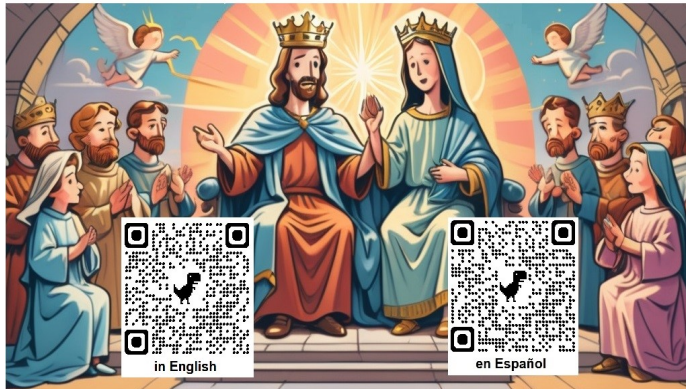
