PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

After 40 days of preparation during the Season of Lent we come today to Palm Sunday to begin our annual celebration of Holy Week.

We will be commemorating that in the fullness of time, Jesus the Son of God, Son of Mary / man will have entered the Holy City of Jerusalem (Jeru-Salem, the City of Peace) to definitively set our world and our human race on the path of redemption.

It took thousands of years, to put into place, slowly but surely, that which was necessary to reset our world on a proper direction. And we recall during Holy Week, ending next Sunday with Easter that all that is necessary has then been done and no matter how long it takes, no matter how many sufferings still remain to endure, all will turn out well.

And we've been celebrating this Week, in the way that we do, every year for at least 1500-1600-1700 years, since at least Christianity was legalized by Constantine. Sure some of the Rites and the Prayers that we use still had to be written in the centuries that followed. However, if we were to come to the world of St. Gregory the Great, who was pope around 600 AD, we would recognize the liturgies that we celebrate today.

I say this because we've been celebrating Holy Week in this way over the course of those 1600 years, in good times and in bad, at times when Barbarians, Vandals, Huns, Mongols were at the gates, when plagues hit the streets and wiped out a 1/3 of Europe's population at a time, when great conflicts raged like the 30 Year War which ended up dividing Europe north and south for centuries and three centuries later World War II divided Europe again, east and west, for decades.

During all those portentous times we celebrated Holy Week each year – recalling the one year, when all these conflicts, both before and after were brought together and definitively resolved at the Cross and then Empty Tomb.

It may be surprising that all these conflicts were actually settled then. But they were. And again, all will turn out well!

Happy and Blessed Holy Week to all!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

Después de 40 días de preparación durante la Cuaresma, hoy llegamos al Domingo de Ramos para dar inicio a nuestra celebración anual de la Semana Santa.

Conmemoraremos que, en la plenitud de los tiempos, Jesús, el Hijo de Dios, Hijo de María/ hombre, entró en la Ciudad Santa de Jerusalén (Jeru-salén, la Ciudad de la Paz) para encaminar definitivamente a nuestro mundo y a la humanidad hacia la redención.

Se necesitaron miles de años para establecer, lentamente pero seguramente, lo necesario para encaminar nuestro mundo hacia el camino correcto. Y recordamos durante la Semana Santa, que culmina el próximo Domingo con la Pascua, que todo lo necesario ya se ha hecho y que, sin importar cuánto tiempo lleve, sin importar cuantos sufrimientos queden por soportar, todo saldrá bien.

Y hemos estado celebrando esta Semana, como lo hacemos cada año, durante al menos 1500, 1600 o 1700 años, desde que Constantino legalizó el Cristianismo. Claro que algunos de los ritos y oraciones que usamos tuvieron que escribirse en los siglos posteriores. Sin embargo, si volviéramos al mundo de San Gregorio Magno, quien fue papa alrededor del año 600 d. C., reconoceríamos las liturgias que celebramos hoy.

Digo esto porque hemos celebrado la Semana Santa de esta manera a lo largo de esos 1600 años, en tiempos buenos y malos, cuando Bárbaros, Vándalos, Hunos y Mongoles estaban a las puertas, cuando las plagas azotaban las calles y exterminaban a un tercio de la población de Europa a su vez, cuando grandes conflictos se desataron como la Guerra de los Treinta Años, que terminó dividiendo Europa del norte y del sur por siglos, y tres siglos después, la Segunda Guerra Mundial volvió a dividir Europa, del este al oeste, por décadas.

Durante todos esos tiempos tormentosos, celebrábamos la Semana Santa cada año, recordando el año en que todos estos conflictos, tanto anteriores como posteriores, se unieron y se resolvieron definitivamente en la Cruz y luego en la Tumba Vacía.

Puede resultar sorprendente que todos estos conflictos se resolvieran entonces. Pero así fue. Y, una vez más, ¡todo saldrá bien!

Que tengan todos una Feliz y bendecida Semana Santa!

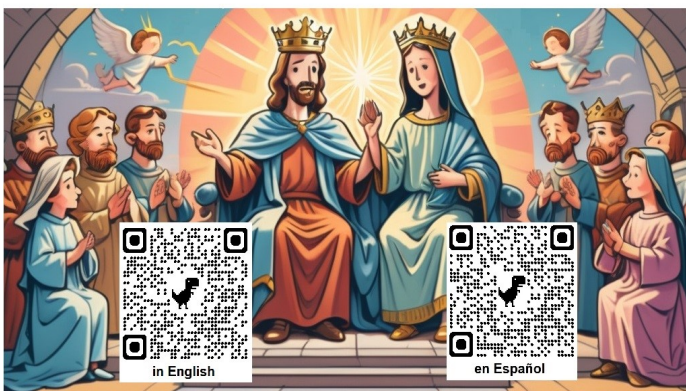
