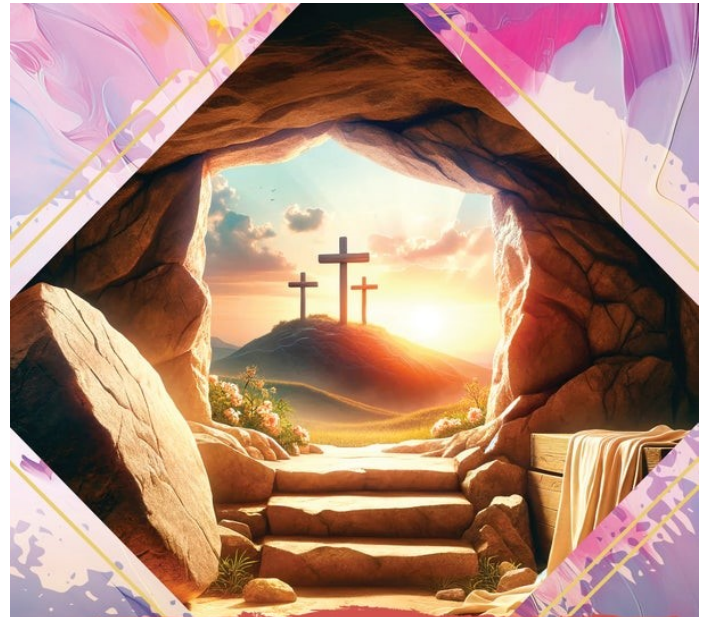

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

As I wrote last week, each year since the time of Constantine (318 AD) or certainly pope St. Gregory the Great (c. 600 AD), we have been commemorating the events of Holy Week beginning with Palm Sunday (recalling Jesus' messianic entry into Jerusalem, continuing on through the evening of Holy Thursday (recalling his Last Supper), Good Friday (recalling his Passion along with a special Veneration of the Cross) and finally the Easter Vigil where we celebrate the whole of God's action in this world from its Creation through to Jesus' Resurrection proclaimed in the Gospel of the Evening. And if we went back in time, we would find the various commemorations recognizable to us.

And the end of this week-long journey played out on the plane of the Liturgy, we find ourselves at the Empty Tomb.

Like with some of the Marvel Comics movies of today, there is actually a Liturgical "bonus scene" for "the most faithful disciples" which can be heard on Easter Sunday at Masses in the afternoon or evening in which we recall the story two of Jesus' disciples who encounter the risen Jesus on their way home from Jerusalem in Emaus.

So for those stay for that epilogue to the Easter story, there we are given the added assurance that soon after Jesus' resurrection, his disciples started to encounter him all over the place, and what was left to do was to proclaim that not even death has the final say in the story, our stories, that the final word belongs to God, and a God who loves us.

The message of Easter Sunday is one of enormous hope, lifting those downtrodden by illness, injustice or even simple accident, that nothing, nor no one can, in the future St. Paul's words: "Can separate us from the love of God that is found in Christ Jesus." (Rom. 8:39)

It's a message that's available to all of us. There may be times in our lives when we don't necessarily need it, but there are definitely times when it is incredibly helpful to carry in our hearts.

So wherever you are in your lives, in good times and in more difficult ones, please appreciate what is offered here. And remember that we've been celebrating these days in a special way for some 1800 years. And we will be celebrating them for hundreds upon hundreds more.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses:

Como escribí la semana pasada, cada año, desde la época de Constantino (318 d. C.) o, seguramente, de San Gregorio Magno (c. 600 d. C.), conmemoramos los acontecimientos de la Semana Santa, comenzando con el Domingo de Ramos (que recuerda la entrada mesiánica de Jesús en Jerusalén), continuando con la noche del Jueves Santo (que recuerda su Última Cena), el Viernes Santo (que recuerda su Pasión junto con una veneración especial de la Cruz) y, finalmente, la Vigilia Pascual, donde celebramos toda la acción de Dios en este mundo desde su Creación hasta la Resurrección de Jesús, proclamada en el Evangelio de la tarde. Si retrocediéramos en el tiempo, encontraríamos las diversas conmemoraciones reconocibles.

Y al final de este camino de una semana, que se desarrolla en el plano de la Liturgia, nos encontramos frente de la Tumba Vacía.

Y como en algunas películas de los Marvel Comics, hay una aun escena litúrgica extra para los discípulos más fieles que se puede escuchar en el Domingo de Pascua en las misas de la tarde o noche, donde recordamos la historia de dos discípulos de Jesús que se encuentran con Jesús resucitado camino a casa desde Jerusalén en Emaús.

Así que, para quienes se quedan para este epílogo de la historia de Pascua, se nos da la seguridad adicional de que, poco después de la resurrección de Jesús, sus discípulos comenzaron a encontrar a Jesús por todas partes, y lo que quedaba por hacer era proclamar que ni siquiera la muerte tiene la última palabra en la historia, en nuestras historias; que la última palabra pertenece a Dios, a un Dios que nos ama.

El mensaje del Domingo de Pascua es de enorme esperanza, y anima a quienes sufren por la enfermedad, la injusticia o incluso un simple accidente, a que nada ni nadie pueda, en el futuro, recordar las palabras de San Pablo: «Nos podrá separar del amor de Dios, que se encuentra en Cristo Jesús» (Rom. 8:39).

Es un mensaje disponible para todos. Puede que haya momentos en nuestras vidas en los que no necesariamente lo necesitemos, pero sin duda hay momentos en los que es increíblemente útil llevarlo en nuestros corazones.

Así que, dondequiera que se encuentren en sus vidas, tanto en los buenos como en los difíciles, favor, aprecien lo que aquí se ofrece. Y recuerden que hemos estado celebrando estos días de una manera especial durante unos 1800 años. Y los seguiremos celebrando siglos y siglos más.

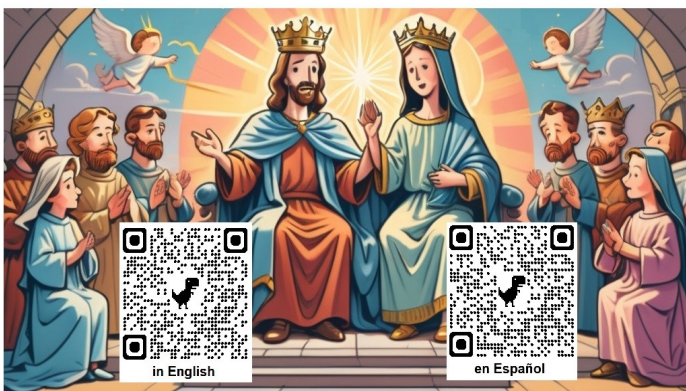
