PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we close the Octave of Easter.

In the Ancient Near East the truly important festivals were celebrated as Octaves – a full week and then one day more.

The biggest celebration that we have in our Christian faith is Easter. So we celebrate it for those eight days, in good part as if time stands still for those eight days.

Yes, parts of the Liturgy change during those days. For example, during those eight days, each day, the Gospel Reading recounts a different episode in which Jesus, risen from the dead, appears to one or another, or group of his disciples. Yet, other parts of the Liturgy, notably in the Liturgy of the Hours, are kept exactly the same throughout the whole Octave.

Twenty-five years ago, at the canonization of St. Faustina Kowalska, the future St. John Paul II, declared the Second Sunday of Easter, which closes the Octave to be “Divine Mercy Sunday,” which caused something of a stir:

The future St. John Paul II noted that of all the major celebrations in the liturgical year, only the Octave of Easter didn't have a specific Feast that closed its celebration. Christmas (the Feast of the Nativity of the Lord) closes with the Sol. of Mary the Mother of God. The Feast of the Epiphany closes with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Even eight days after our celebration of Pentecost Sunday (the Descending of the Holy Spirit) we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. Only Easter seemed to be the exception.

That was okay for a lot of Liturgists because then the celebration of the Octave Easter was allowed to “spill over” into the rest of the 50 day celebration of the Easter Season.

However, the future John Paul II wished that the Octave of Easter have its end as well.

And its closing with the celebration of God's Mercy seems appropriate because it recalls the “why” of the Pascal Mystery: Why did Jesus die and rise for us? It wasn't simply to prove that he was better than us. Rather, God sent his only begotten son here to die and rise for us, precisely out of his love, his mercy towards us. Without recalling that “why”, Jesus' dying and rising would be cheapened into something of a magic trick. No, God had a purpose, and that purpose was to show that he love us.

Happy Divine Mercy Sunday!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

Este Domingo cerramos la Octava de Pascua.

En el antiguo Medio Oriente, las festividades más grandes se celebraban como Octavas: una semana completa y un día más.

La mayor celebración de nuestra fe Cristiana es la Pascua. Por eso la celebramos por esos ocho días, en gran parte como si el tiempo se hubiera detenido.

Sí, partes de la Liturgia cambian durante esos días. Por ejemplo, cada día, el Evangelio relata un episodio diferente en el que Jesús, resucitado de entre los muertos, se aparece a uno u otro grupo de sus discípulos. Pero otras partes de la Liturgia, en particular la Liturgia de las Horas, se mantienen exactamente iguales durante toda la Octava.

Hace veinticinco años, en la canonización de Santa Faustina Kowalska, el futuro San Juan Pablo II declaró el Segundo Domingo de Pascua, que cierra la Octava, como el "Domingo de la Divina Misericordia", lo que causó cierto revuelo:

El futuro San Juan Pablo II señaló que, de todas las celebraciones principales del año litúrgico, solo la Octava de Pascua no tenía una fiesta específica que la cerrara. La Navidad (Fiesta de la Natividad del Señor) concluye con el Sol. de María, Madre de Dios. La Fiesta de la Epifanía concluye con la Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor. Incluso ocho días después de nuestra celebración del Domingo de Pentecostés (la Venida del Espíritu Santo), celebramos la Fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad. Solo la Pascua parecía ser la excepción.

Esto no presentó problema para muchos liturgistas, ya que entonces se permitió que la celebración de la Octava de Pascua se extendiera al resto de los 50 días de celebración del Tiempo Pascual.

Sin embargo, el futuro Juan Pablo II deseaba que la Octava de Pascua también tuviera su fin.

Y su clausura con la celebración de la Divina Misericordia parece apropiada porque recuerda el "por qué" del Misterio Pascual: ¿Por qué Jesús murió y resucitó por nosotros? No fue simplemente para demostrar que era más grande que nosotros. Más bien, Dios envió a su Hijo Unigénito aquí para morir y resucitar por nosotros, precisamente por su amor, su misericordia hacia nosotros. Sin recordar ese "por qué", la muerte y resurrección de Jesús se reduciría a un simple truco de magia. No, Dios tenía un propósito, y ese propósito era demostrar que nos ama.

¡Feliz Domingo de la Divina Misericordia!

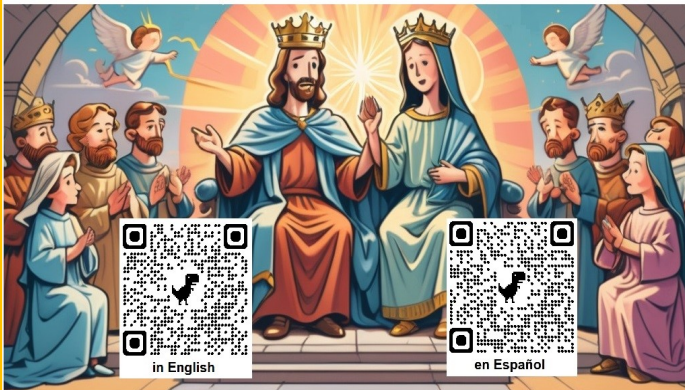
