PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners:

The Sunday Readings remind us of a number of things: (1) Life / History wasn't intended to be static, change does come, and indeed is ordained to come, (2) at Pentecost the Church received the Holy Spirit which gives the power to respond both respond to unexpected changes and to even (inspired by it, in the context of the Signs of the Times) to initiate it, and (3) God has confidence in us to be able to make the responses and at times initiate the changes necessary to allow the Church to continue on its mission in this world to orient said world ever more and more according to God's plan.

The words above carry with them a lot of implications. And yet we hear the implications of the arrival of the Holy Spirit play out in the First Reading.

In that First Reading we hear the Church being asked to respond to a situation that none of its members would have expected: A Church whose membership was increasingly coming from people who had never been Jewish. What to do?

There were those who were saying: "Look, these new members need to become Jewish before they become Christian, it's important."

But the Church ended up taking a different path, it accepted the new members without need for them to accept all the practices of the Jewish community out of which the Church originally came.

That was a huge change, and it took place because the Church came to see that it was being prompted by the Holy Spirit to do so.

We believe that the same Holy Spirit lives in our Church today. There is no crisis that we can not resolve, nothing "new" that can keep us from responding, even creatively, in face of the "new" circumstances. As Church, we have been given the power.

Now let's be clear, the ones who have authority to make changes are our leaders, the Bishops. But let us not doubt that together as the Apostles did (and in communion with St. Peter) at the first Council of Jerusalem did, that they have the power to do so.

Further let us appreciate that God trusts us, trusts our leadership with this power. Let us not be afraid to use it, and then see the Church grow. Continued good Easter Tidings to all!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

Las lecturas de este Domingo nos recuerdan varias cosas: (1) La vida/historia no fue concebida para ser estática; el cambio llega, y de hecho está destinado a llegar; (2) en Pentecostés la Iglesia recibió el Espíritu Santo, que le da el poder de responder tanto a cambios inesperados como incluso (inspirados por él, en el contexto de los Signos de los Tiempos) de iniciarlos; y (3) Dios confía en nosotros para que podamos responder y, en ocasiones, iniciar los cambios necesarios para que la Iglesia continúe su misión en este mundo y lo oriente cada vez más según el plan de Dios.

Las palabras anteriores tienen muchas implicaciones. Sin embargo, las implicaciones de la llegada del Espíritu Santo se manifiestan en la Primera Lectura.

En esa Primera Lectura, escuchamos cómo se le pidió a la Iglesia que responda a una situación que ninguno de sus miembros habría esperado: una Iglesia cuyos miembros provenían cada vez más de personas que nunca habían sido judías. ¿Qué hacer?

Algunos decían: "Miren, estos nuevos miembros deben convertirse al Judaísmo antes de convertirse al Cristianismo, es importante".

Pero la Iglesia tomó un camino diferente: aceptó a los nuevos miembros sin necesidad de que aceptaran todas las prácticas de la comunidad judía de la que la Iglesia nació originalmente.

Ese fue un cambio enorme, y se produjo porque la Iglesia comprendió que el Espíritu Santo la impulsaba a hacerlo.

Creemos que el mismo Espíritu Santo vive en nuestra Iglesia hoy. No hay crisis que no podamos resolver, nada "nuevo" que nos impida responder, incluso con creatividad, ante las "nuevas" circunstancias. Como Iglesia, se nos ha dado el poder.

Seamos claros: quienes tienen la autoridad para hacer cambios son nuestros líderes, los obispos. Pero no dudemos de que, juntos, como lo hicieron los apóstoles (en comunión con el primer papa, San Pedro) en el primer Concilio de Jerusalén, ellos tienen el poder para hacerlo.

Además, apreciemos que Dios confía en nosotros, en nuestros líderes, con este poder. No tengamos miedo de usarlo y así veremos crecer a la Iglesia. ¡Que Dios nos bendiga a todos con la Buena Nueva de Pascua!

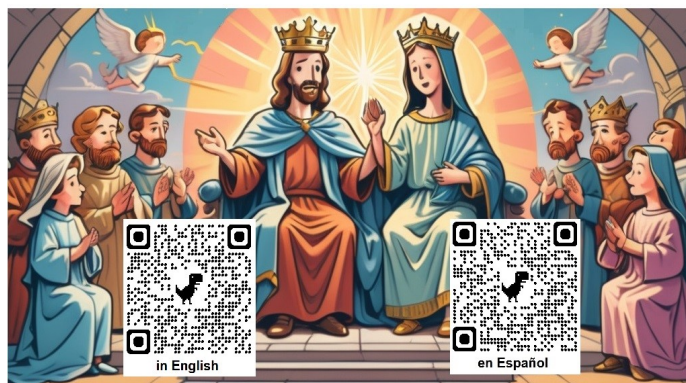
